Tonight: It's Marvel's Defenders of the Diamond Night! Lugnuts assemble! Lansing will wear special super-charged Luggie uniforms on the field. LAFUC Fireworks will follow the game. The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth game in a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

Starting Matchup: Lugnuts right-hander **Jack Perkins**, drafted in the 5th round last year from from Indiana, has been the most consistent starter for Lansing. Perkins has a sharp 2.88 ERA through seven starts. Opponents are swatting just .193 against him, while he's grabbed 38 K in 40 2/3 IP. On the other side, left-hander **Christian MacLeod**, drafted by Minnesota in the 5th round in 2021, out of Mississippi State, is expected to make his second start at High-A. Last week in his initial start with the Kernels, he only lasted one inning, giving up two hits and three runs.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, Kernels 2. A night after allowing the most runs (24) in franchise history, Lansing's three pitchers of **Jacob Watters**, **Mac Lardner** and **Tyler Baum** held Cedar Rapids to just four hits and two runs. Offensively, Euribiel Angeles and Daniel Susac each provided the offense with home runs and that was enough to snap the three-game skid.

Han Solo No More! The Lugnuts are one of four teams in the MWL to not have 30 home runs yet through two months, however, they have hit seven home runs this week against Cedar Rapids (four games). Until Daniel Susac's two-run shot yesterday, the Lugs had hit six solo HR's in this series. In contrast, the Kernels have hit eight this week, only three solo shots. They have two grand slams and a three-run shot.

Brisk Baseball: 13 of the last 16 Lugs games have been completed in 150 minutes or less, including ten games completed under two hours and 20 minutes. Wednesday's series opener took just 2:09 to finish, while last night's game was even faster at 2:08.

Among the MWL Leaders: Outfielder **Jonny Butler** is second in the Midwest League with five triples. Starting pitcher **Jack Perkins** is fourth in the league with a .193 batting average allowed, fifth with a 2.88 ERA, seventh with a 1.08 WHIP and tenth with 40 2/3 innings pitched. Catcher **Daniel Susac** is tied for fifth with 46 base hits and sixth with a .289 batting average.

Slim Finishes: Three of the first four games of this series has been decided by one run, with the Kernels prevailing twice. The Lugnuts are 10-6 in one-run games this season. Last night, Lansing held Cedar Rapids scoreless over the final eight innings and picked up their first win of the series, 3-2.

May Day: After finishing April with an 11-9 record, the Nuts finished May with a 10-17 won-lost record. The ballclub's best players during the month: **Daniel Susac** (led the Lugnuts with a .306 batting average, .392 OBP, an .804 OPS, 26 hits, 35 total bases, and 12 walks), **Junior Pérez** (team-leading 13 runs scored, five home runs and .438 slugging), **Danny Bautista, Jr.** (team-leading 13 RBIs) and **Jonny Butler** (team-leading seven stolen bases).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2006: The Lugnuts won a 17-inning marathon for the second time in 2006, pulling out a 5-3 victory at the South Bend Silver Hawks. The score was tied at 2-2 through seven innings, with both teams scoring a run in the 15th. Nuts manager Ken Joyce was ejected in the 11th and center fielder Luke Hetherington was ejected in the 17th. The game took four hours and 36 minutes to complete, decided by a two-out, two-run triple from Jacob Butler.

2017: 19-year-old Bo Bichette went 4-for-5 with two singles, a double and a triple, to raise his batting average to .390 in a 7-3 loss at West Michigan.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2022 draftees on the roster, joining Daniel Susac, Clark Elliott, Jacob Watters and Jake Garland... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado), Jack Weisenburger and Nuts teammate OF Clark Elliott... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother... has 17 family members and friends attending today's game.

Prospecting: Moved into the No. 30 slot on the A's MLB Pipeline Top 30 Prospects list; fastball 60, curve 50, cutter 50, control 40, overall 40... the summation: "After a solid high school career in Indiana and being taken late in the 2018 Draft by the Braves, Perkins first went to Louisville to continue his amateur pitching career. After two years of flashes of stuff without command, he moved to Indiana for the 2022 season. Better feel for the strike zone improved his stock and landed him in the fifth round with the A's. He had a brief summer debut and went to High-A Lansing, getting off to a strong start, as he began his pro career in earnest in 2023."

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildcats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by Atlanta, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to under-going Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
