Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (3-7) at Durham Bulls (4-6)

FORTES, ASTUDILLO POWER JUMBO SHRIMP

Nick Fortes finished a triple shy of the cycle while driving in four and Willians Astudillo homered and reached base four times Friday to push Jacksonville to an 8-3 victory over Durham. Fortes launched a three-run bomb in the first inning, but the Bulls got one in their half of the first before Isaac Paredes tied the score with a two-run shot in the third. JJ Bleday launched his first Triple-A long ball to begin the fifth, with Fortes adding an RBI double later in the frame. Astudillo chipped in an RBI single in the sixth before homering in the ninth inning. Lorenzo Quintana's sacrifice fly put the final margin at 8-3. Jake Fishman earned the win with 2.1 hitless innings of relief and four strikeouts.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 13 home runs thus far in 2022, tied for fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Entering play on Saturday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in four consecutive games, already their second such streak just 10 games into the season.

SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE

The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for sixth in the International League in runs per game at 5.4 runs per game,

accomplishing that feat despite ranking in the middle of the pack of the circuit in most offensive categories. The biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting just .226/.327/.371, producing a .698 OPS that ranks 14th in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .269/.344/.481, with the resulting .825 OPS placing fourth in the circuit. Perhaps the club's true talent level is somewhere in the middle of these two ends; Jumbo Shrimp hitters have totaled a .285 BABIP with the bases empty but .314 with runners on base. Both figures are far from the baseball-wide .300 batting average on balls in play.

ERROR 404: NOT FOUND

While the Jumbo Shrimp have hit well to start 2022, the club's run prevention has struggled, with Jacksonville yielding 59 runs through 10 games, the fourth-most in the International League. The Jumbo Shrimp's run prevention struggles, though, are of little fault of the club's defense; Jacksonville's defense has turned 71.2 percent of balls put in play into outs, above the 70.0-percent average and a figure that would rank in the top 10 of MLB the last several seasons. Additionally, the Jumbo Shrimp's five errors are tied for the fifth-fewest in the circuit. Entering play on Saturday, Jacksonville has gone four games in a row without an error, totaling 38 straight miscue-free innings.

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 11-for-38 to begin the campaign, slashing .289/.378/.474/.852 with a double, two home runs, nine RBIs and seven runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, is 11-for-38, slashing .289/.400/.553/.953 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 14 runs. Thus, of the 54 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks tied for sixth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 31 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs by the pair), a ratio of 57.4 percent.

AND ISN'T IT IRONIC, DON'T YOU THINK?

Despite getting outscored during the 2021 season, the Jumbo Shrimp finished with a 75-55 (.577) record in large part due to the club's success in close games. Jacksonville went a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins, including a 27-18 (.600) mark in one-run affairs. Thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have been unable to equalize their success in narrowly-decided contests in 2022, with the club posting an 0-3 record in one-run games.

-Originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 16th round of the 2009 draft, Mitchell bypassed on a commitment to play at the University of North Carolina to begin his professional career.

-Mitchell made his major league debut for the Yankees on August 10, 2014 by tossing 2.0 scoreless innings of relief against Cleveland at Yankee Stadium.

-The Yankees traded Mitchell along with infielder Chase Headley on December 12, 2017 to the San Diego Padres in exchange for outfielder Jabari Blash. The Padres designated Mitchell for assignment on March 28, 2019, and after spending the entirety of that season with Triple-A El Paso and the AZL Padres, he elected free agency on October 1, 2019.

-On January 16, 2020, Mitchell signed a minor league contract with the Chicago White Sox. He was part of their player pool at the team's Alternate Training Site before being released on August 24, 2020.

-After signing with the Marlins on July 28, Mitchell's first three appearances with Jacksonville were all hitless, spanning a total of 8.0 innings (0 R, 3 BB, 9 K)

-Mitchell had his contract selected by the Marlins on August 19 and made a pair of appearances for them before being designated for assignment on August 25 and then outrighted to Jacksonville on August 27.

2019 SEASON

-Of Mitchell's 11 starts with El Paso, only four went for at least 5.0 innings of work..

2018 SEASON

-After posting an 0-3 record and 7.08 ERA in 12 games, seven starts, before the All-Star Break with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-1 with a 2.19 ERA in four starts in the season's second-half with the Padres.

-In 11 starts with San Diego, Mitchell went 2-4 with a 4.61 ERA over 56.2 innings (60 H, 34 BB, 31 K). However, in five relief appearances with the Padres, the right-hander was 0-0 with an 8.27 ERA in 16.1 innings (25 H, 9 BB, 7 K).
