THIS IS GOING GREAT: After outscoring the Hillcats 14-1 and winning the first two games of the series going away, the FredNats can earn at least a split of this six-game set with Lynchburg on Thirsty Thursday and Tasty Thursday at Virginia Credit Union Stadium, presented by Biliken's smokehouse. RHP Alexander Meckley gets the start for Fredericksburg, and will look to build on a nice bounce back start last week against Salem in which he pitched five innings of one earned run ball for Fredericksburg. Walks have been a bit of an issue for Meckley, he's issued 11 of them in 19.0 total innings this year as an exclusive starter for the FredNats. He faces Lynchburg lefty Melkis Hernandez, who is coming off 5.1 hitless innings in his last start. Fredericksburg is a perfect 3-0 against left-handed starters this season.

ABOUT LAST GAME: The FredNats got the longest start of the season from Bryan Polanco, going six innings and allowing just two hits and a run with no walks and three strikeouts. Polanco earned his second straight win leading this rotation. Jackson Ross hit two solo home runs to lead off the 4th and 6th innings, and Kelvin Diaz and Kevin Made drove in the other two runs for the FredNats in a 4-1 win. Merritt Beeker and Adam Bloebaum covered the final three innings scoreless, with Bloebaum earning his second professional save. Fredericksburg improved to 11-3 at home this year, which is tied for the second-best home record in the Carolina League.

STARTING PITCHER IMPROVEMENT: The FredNat starting rotation is currently enjoying its best stretch of the season. After six more innings of one-run ball from Bryan Polanco, the starting rotation's ERA in the last seven games is 1.41, which is the best mark in all of Minor League Baseball in that time frame, one hundreth of a run better than Rancho Cucamonga. On the season, the starting group has lowered its season ERA to 4.28, which is a major improvement from some of the struggles of early to mid April.

HE'S A SLUGGER: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross took the Carolina League lead with his fifth and sixth homers in yesterday's game, and he continues to lead the circuit in slugging percentage. Ross is slugging .623 on the season to lead the circuit, and his .979 OPS ranks second in the league and is sixth in all of MiLB. He also leads the FredNat team with seven doubles on the year, which is tied for 6th in the league.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 40% of base runners this year which is first in all of Minor League Baseball among qualified catchers, and he ranks seventh in Single-A with 12 caught stealings. Rombach is right behind Bazzell, throwing out 35.7% of potential base stealers, and he's tied for 10th in Single-A with 10 caught stealings. Fredericksburg's 22 total caught stealings from the catchers ranks third in Single-A behind Charleston and Fayetteville.

STREAKY: Nate Ochoa's double in the 6th inning Tuesday night extended his hitting streak to eight games, which is the longest hitting streak of the season for a FredNat. Ochoa blasted his first home run of the season on Sunday in Salem, an opposite field three-run shot off the scoreboard in right center field.

THIS BULLPEN, MAN: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After three more scoreless innings last night, the bullpen ERA stands at 3.44, which is the best in the Carolina League and the second best in all of Single-A baseball. If you take out bullpen innings from normal starting pitcher Angel Roman, the bullpen ERA is 2.97, which would be the best in Single-A and fourthbest in all of Minor League Baseball.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

START IT UP: Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career. At Coastal Carolina last year, he started nine times in 21 appearances for the Chanticleers.

LAST TIME OUT: Meckley had one of his best starts of the season last week, tossing five innings @ SAL and allowing just one earned run. He got a no-decision but hit the five inning mark for the second time this year.

BACK IN SCHOOL: Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
