TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City get set for game three of the series on Thursday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Cole Winn is scheduled to start up against Dodgers RHP Bobby Miller. First pitch is slated for 7:05 p.m. CT.

BROADCAST INFORMATION

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone or on 91.1 FM from inside Dell Diamond. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.iheart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MiLB.tv login or on the Bally Live app. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former 12-year MLB veteran, RHP Ross Ohlendorf, provides color commentary.

SEVENTH INNING STRUGGLES

The Express dropped game two of the series on Wednesday by a final of 6-4. Oklahoma City struck first with two runs in the second. LF Steven Dugger scored on a Patrick Mazeika single before RF Bradley Zimmer scored 2B Devin Mann with a single. The Express tied the game at 2-2 in the third when C Jordan Procyshen hit a one-out double then moved to third as CF Rafael Ortega singled and scored on a Jonathan Ornelas groundout. 2B Justin Foscoe then knocked a single to score Ortega. Round Rock LF Josh Sale broke the tie in the fourth with a two-run home run that soared 445 feet over the right field berm. The dinger scored RF Elier Hernandez, who had reached on a single. A four-run inning for the Dodgers pushed the visitors ahead, 6-4. Three singles, one double, one walk, one wild pitch and one groundout combined to plate the four Oklahoma City runs.

LET'S GET A WINN

Express RHP Cole Winn will make his eighth appearance and seventh start on Thursday. He has allowed at least three earned run in six of his seven appearances and has tossed at least 5.0 innings in three starts this year. Winn has a 7.53 ERA (24 ER/28.2 IP) with 22 walks and 31 strikeouts.

FOSCOE TO THE RESCUE

Express INF Justin Foscoe went 2-for-4 with a RBI and a walk on Wednesday. The righty is 4-for-6 in the first two games of the series. Foscoe leads the Express in hits (34) and doubles (9). In May, Foscoe is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four RBI, three runs scored, six walks and two strikeouts.

HIT STREAK CLOSES FOR CRIM

INF Blaine Crim had his 12-game hitting streak snapped yesterday. His streak is tied for the third longest in the Pacific Coast League this season. During those 12 games, Crim went 14-for-43 with four doubles, two triples, one home run, three RBI, nine walks and seven strikeouts.

BREAKING UP THE BULLPEN

After LHP John King was recalled to the Texas Rangers, he became the fourth member of the Express bullpen to depart since April 29. RHP Dominic Leone (Released), RHP Zack Littell (Traded to BOS) and RHP Yerry Rodriguez (Recalled) were the three others. Those four pitchers had a combined 1.98 ERA (11 ER/50.0 IP).

MEAN MAY

The Express are off to a 3-5 start to May. After posting a 3.42 ERA (85 ER/224.0 IP) in April, Round Rock owns a 5.40 ERA (39 ER/65.0 IP) this month. They issued only 103 walks last month and have already handed out 45 free passes this month.

ORTEGA ON FIRE

Express CF Rafael Ortega posted his fourth multi-hit game this month. He's hitting .417 (10-for-24) in his last six games. With his third-inning single yesterday, Ortega reached 1,250 hits in the minors.

A SURGE OF SOUTHPAWS

The Texas Rangers recalled Express LHP John King on Thursday. LHP Grant Wolfram and LHP Josh Dye joined the E-Train. Wolfram comes from Double-A Frisco where he was just named the Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for April. Dye signed a minor league contract with the Rangers after he was released by the Kansas City Royals on May 2.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
