### FROM THE CROWS NEST

> AN AMERICAN TRADITION: Bradenton enters Thursday having won their last two Independence Day contests. Bradenton's last loss on July 4 came at the hands of the Mussels in 2021 when the Marauders fell 6-5 in 10-innings at Hammond Śtadium. All-Time, Bradenton is 8-4 on America's Birthday and are playing Fort Myers for just the second time. Fort Myers and Bradenton did play a series at Hammond Stadium on 7/3/13 and 7/5/13.

> HIT PARADE: In the Marauders' 10-5 victory over Fort Myers on Wednesday night at LECOM Park, Bradenton tallied 14 hits, a season-high. Last season, Bradenton mashed 18 hits against Lakeland on 5/10/23. Their second-highest tally last year (17) came against Fort Myers on 7/21/23.

LIGHT TOWER POWER: Axiel Plaz mashed a game-tying solo-home run in the third inning against Fort Myers on Wednesday to bring his season-total to 10. Since his promotion on May 17, Plaz's 10 bombs are the most in Single-A. Fellow Pirates Minor League catchers Nick Cimillo (GBO) has 13 and Shawn Ross (GBO) has 11 in that same time frame.

NO BREAKS: The Bradenton Marauders are currently in the middle of their longest stretch of the 2024 season without a day off. After having an off-day on Monday, June 24, the Marauders will play 12-straight games against the Clearwater Threshers and the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. The Marauders will then have back-to-back off days on July 7 and July 8.

**AMERICA'S BIRTHDAY:** Monday is the start of a mini three-game home & home series with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. Fort Myers enters the week with 1.5 game lead for first place in the second half of the Florida State League West Division.

BACK BETTER THAN EVER: LHP Inmer Lobo tossed two more scoreless innings on Wednesday night against Fort Myers. Lobo has given up one unearned run in 9.1 innings over his last five outings

**HERE COMES THE POWER:** The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. In June, Bradenton hit 31 home runs in 26 games, which was the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 19 of their last 22 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023. Bradenton needed to hit three on Sunday in Clearwater to tie the record. In July, Bradenton has hit five in their first three games with Axiel Plaz accounting for three of the five.

JAVVY'S MASHIN: In June, Javier Rivas slashed .341/.400/.646 with five doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBIs, three walks, and 13 runs scored in 25 games. His seven home runs on the season are also a new career-high with his six in June tied for the most in Single-A. Rivas finished first in the Florida State League during the month of June in total bases (53), tied for first in home runs (six), second in batting (.341), slugging (.646) and OPS (1.046), tied for second in hits (28) and extra base hits (12) and sixth in OBP (.400).

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30 last Tuesday night. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. RHP Mike Burrows, the No. 10 prospect is also rehabbing with Bradenton to bring the total to nine.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday's win against Clearwater marked the Marauders' 27th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 16-11 record in those games with 53 of their first 78 (67.9%) games having been decided by three runs or less

**LAST TIME OUT:** In his first rehab start with Bradenton last Thursday in Clearwater, tossed a scoreless second inning after allowing an unearned run in the first. In the third, three straight batters reached with one out to drive home a run. Shortridge departed with two runners on, both of which scored to complete his outing.

- Finished tied for the Eastern League lead in wins (11), starts (27) and complete games, second in innings pitched and eighth in winning percentage (.579).

   In 29 games (27 starts) for Double-A Altoona, struck out 118 batters in 138.1 innings while logging a 5.01 ERA.
- Finished the season strong, going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA in August...best start of the season came on 8/11 vs Erie (9 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 7 K)
- At end of the Double-A season, promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis on Sept. 19. In start versus Rochester, allowed just one run and one hit in five innings earning a win.
