**YESTERDAY:** Raynel Delgado hit a pinch-hit, two-run, go-ahead homer in the eighth inning to propel Lake County to an 8-6 win over the Beloit Snappers. Lake County took a 6-0 lead with three runs in each of the first two innings, including a two-run homer by Jhonkensy Noel. Beloit, however, scored six unanswered runs, capped by Ricky Aracena's game-tying solo homer in the eighth. The Snappers threatened in the ninth, but Nick Gallagher stranded runners on second and third to end the game.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** After the Captains beat Beloit yesterday afternoon, the Great Lakes Loons and Cedar Rapids Kernels both lost. Great Lakes lost to the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, 4-2. Cedar Rapids fell to the Peoria Chiefs, 2-1. Those results propelled the Captains into the second playoff position with four games remaining. The Captains have won three straight, while Cedar Rapids has lost three straight and Great Lakes has lost two in a row. Lake County entered Sunday three games out of a playoff spot, but has made up the gap in just three games.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE:** The Captains hold the second playoff position entering today's game. The Captains are tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, but own the tiebreaker (best winning percentage over the final 20 games). Lake County is also one game ahead of the Great Lakes Loons. The Captains would not own the tiebreaker against Great Lakes (head-to-head record). All three teams are separated by 1.0 game. The Quad Cities River Bandits have clinched the top seed.

**RUNNERS STRANDED:** The Captains have struggled with runners in scoring position recently. Over the last eight games, Lake County has batted .157 (11-for-70) with men in scoring position and left 49 runners aboard (6.125 per game).

**SLUMPING:** The Captains' offense has the league's lowest team batting average (.196) in September. Five Captains hitters with 25+ plate appearances this month have batting averages under .200.

### TRENDS

**Jhonkensy Noel:** Slashing .295/.361/.602 (.963 OPS) in his first 23 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in batting average (.348), wRC+ (167), OPS (1.031), slugging percentage (.636), and ISO (.289).

**Micah Pries:** Is 8-for-22 (.364) over a six-game hitting streak with a homer and a double, as well as three walks against four strikeouts. This comes after a 10-game stretch when Pries was 5-for-29 (.172) with two homers and a double, but also 14 strikeouts against two walks. Pries is also the only Captain hitting above .235 over their last five games (.389).

**Quentin Holmes:** While Holmes is only hitting .190 in nine September games, he also has an .917 OPS in that span. Holmes is slashing .190/.393/.524 in that stretch with seven walks and five steals. Last Friday, Holmes hit his first home run since June 11.

**José Tena:** Tena is hitting .186 (8-for-43) over his last 12 games with 17 strikeouts and three walks.

**Joe Donovan:** Donovan is 3-for-28 (.107) over his last 10 games. Two of his three hits are home runs.

**Raynel Delgado:** Delgado is 4-for-30 (.133) in his last nine games, but hit a go-ahead homer on Wednesday in an eighth-inning pinch-hitting appearance to propel the Captains to victory.

**SUPERLATIVES:** *Baseball America* recently released its annual list of the best tools among minor league prospects in each league, as voted on by minor league managers. Several Captains made the cut. **Daniel Espino** was tabbed for the best breaking ball in the High-A Central League. **Joe Naranjo** was named best defensive first baseman. **José Tena** was awarded both best defensive shortstop and best infield arm. **Greg DiCenzo** was named best manager prospect.

**NEW BLOOD:** 3B **Jhonkensy Noel** joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF **Christian Cairo** and OF **Jonathan Rodriguez** joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodriguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

**THIS DAY IN CAPTAINS HISTORY:** On this date in 2010, the Captains played an 18-inning game in Clinton, IA in game two of the Midwest League Championship Series. The Captains erased a four-run deficit, eventually tying the game in the ninth on a two-run homer by **Delvi Cid**. **Roberto Pérez** gave Lake County the lead in the 12<sup>th</sup> on a solo homer, but Clinton tied the score in the bottom half and the LumberKings won the game in the 18<sup>th</sup> on an error by Captains third baseman **Adam Abraham**. Captains reliever **Owen Dew**, who became the team's pitching coach in 2019, held Clinton to one run over six innings from the 11<sup>th</sup> through the 17<sup>th</sup> innings.

LAST WEEK: Draper shut out West Michigan over 5.1 innings, piggybacking behind starter Tanner Burns last Thursday. The lefty limited the Whitecaps to three hits, struck out five and walked one. He earned the win, as the Captains held on for a 5-3 victory at Classic Park.

BACK IN THE ROTATION: Draper makes his first start today since August 3. After three starts with Lake County, he went to the bullpen for the next eight appearances, which included the first two saves of his professional career (September 7 vs. Dayton and September 12 vs. Dayton). As a starter, Draper has a career 3.70 ERA compared to 3.85 out of the bullpen.

2021: Assigned to Triple-A Columbus on May 23 and made four appearances out of the Clippers' bullpen, posting an 8.31 ERA. Transferred to Double-A Akron on June 11. Made three starts and four relief appearances for the RubberDucks, posting a 6.43 ERA. Transferred to Lake County on July 21.

COLLEGE OF IDAHO HISTORY: Draper was drafted in the same year as his College of Idaho teammate, Riley O'Brien, a right-handed pitcher who the Tampa Bay Rays selected in the eighth round in 2017. It was the first time two C of I Yotes were drafted in the same year since 1996, when the Montreal Expos selected Kurt Alderman in the 15th round and the St. Louis Cardinals picked Tim Onofrei in the 28th round.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Draper earned All-NAIA West honors in both of his seasons at the College of Idaho (2016 & 2017).

WEST COAST LEAGUE: Draper was named the WCL Pitcher of the Year in 2016 after posting an 8-0 record with a 0.72 ERA. He did not allow an earned run in July, tossing 35 shutout innings.

COLLEGE TRANSFER: Transferred to the College of Idaho after two seasons at the College of Southern Idaho. He was initially signed to play at the University of Central Florida.

COLLEGE TEAMMATE LINEAGE: Draper's college teammate, Tampa Bay Rays pitching prospect Riley O'Brien, is the grandson of former Pittsburgh Pirates infielder Johnny O'Brien. Johnny and his twin brother Eddie O'Brien played together on the Pirates in the 1950's and even formed the Bucs' double play combo (one of four pairs of brothers to play together up the middle in MLB history) in their rookie season of 1953 (Eddie at shortstop and Johnny at second). Johnny was mostly a second baseman during his six-year career, but also pitched 25 times, including 16 appearances (one start) in 1957. Eddie also pitched five times (one start) during his career with Pittsburgh, though he was primarily a shortstop and centerfielder. In addition, the pair played basketball at Seattle University where they upset the Harlem Globetrotters and were both drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, though neither signed. In basketball, Johnny earned the distinction as the first player in NCAA history to score 1,000 points in a season and was the shortest player to be named an All-American (5'9") until 2016.
