### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**THE TRIFECTA:** The Marauders launched three home runs in last night's win, a season-high. **Daniel Lopez** and **Will Matthiessen** hit their first homers of the year in the second and ninth innings, respectively, while **Endy Rodriguez** hit his second of the year in the fifth inning, sharing the team lead with **Alexander Mojica**. Matthiessen's and Rodriguez's home runs were Bradenton's first three-run shots of the season.

**NIGHT AND DAY:** Entering Sunday's game, the Marauders owned the Low-A Southeast's fourth-lowest team batting average (.205) and were batting .145 (8-for-55) with runners in scoring position. Over the past two games, the Marauders are hitting .400 (14-for-35) with men in scoring position and own a .259 team average.

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** In a combined four appearances, right-handers **Nick Garcia** and **Logan Hofmann** have held opponents to one run on two hits, walking just two and striking out 12 over a cumulative 10 innings of work out of the bullpen. Both were selected within the first five rounds of last year's draft and are in their first professional seasons.

**WELCOME ABOARD:** **Alexander Mojica** currently owns both the longest on-base streak (six games) and the longest hitting streak (four games) among Marauders hitters. The 18-year-old Dominican Republic native is batting .304 (5-for-18) with two home runs and five RBI.

**SUNDAY SPLURGE:** The Marauders racked up season-highs in runs (18) and hits (16) in Sunday's 18-9 win over Fort Myers. The nine-run outburst in the first inning was the team's first nine-run inning since June 20, 2018, when Bradenton plated nine runs in the second inning against Clearwater. Additionally, the 18 runs were the Marauders' first game of 15 or more runs scored since 2017, when they pulled out a 20-2 win over Palm Beach on May 20.

**TOP PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently boasts six prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the organization: **Hudson Head** (#6), **Eddy Yean** (#13), **Sammy Siani** (#19), **Nick Garcia** (#21), **Endy Rodriguez** (#27), and **Alexander Mojica** (#30). Three of the six (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, while Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

**UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:** New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** takes the helm in Bradenton for his first season in the Pirates organization. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020 (he was originally slated to manage the short-season West Virginia Black Bears), he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

**THE OPPONENT:** The Dunedin Blue Jays pitching staff was ravaged in the opening series, surrendering 78 runs on 73 hits to the Tampa Tarpons over the six-game set. Dunedin dropped each of the first five games of the series before salvaging Sunday's series finale, 4-1. The five-game skid was the D-Jays' longest losing streak to open a season since 2011, when Dunedin lost its first six games.

**HEAD TO HEAD:** The Marauders struggled against Dunedin in 2019, going 5-8 against the D-Jays despite outscoring them in their 13 matchups, 63-57.
