ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Aberdeen turned around a 1-0 deficit, scoring four runs in the top of the seventh inning to knock RHP **Luis Moreno** out of the game and win 4-2. Moreno had been cruising, having tossed six scoreless before the big frame. C **Nic Gaddis** led Brooklyn's bats at the plate, going 3-for-3 with a home run and two RBIs. OF **Alex Ramirez** added a triple, collecting his third extra-base hit in the past three games. Aberdeen reliever RHP **Jean Pinto**, Baltimore's No. 29 prospect, struck out eight in five innings of relief.

THE ONE WHERE WE PLAY ABERDEEN: It's Friends Night at Maimonides Park and the first 2,000 fans in attendance will receive a Turkey Head Bobblehead. Fans will enjoy contests like Eat Ross' Sandwich, Smelly Cat "Name that Smell," and It's a Moo Point Race. Tonight is also an All You Can Drink in The Backyard with special guest Jimmy Kenney Band. Following the game, Everyone Runs the Bases.

STOP! HAMEL TIME: RHP **Dominic Hamel**, the Mets No. 9 prospect makes his High-A Brooklyn debut tonight. The righthander, who was promoted from Low-A St. Lucie on the Fourth of July, ranks as the Mets' second-best pitching prospect behind No. 6 RHP **Matt Allan**. Hamel was drafted by New York in the Third Round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past nine games -- the best home run stretch of his career. Over the nine-game stretch, Gaddis has been on base in 40% of his plate appearances with a 1.005 OPS.

STAR-STUDED MOVES: Mets No. 4 prospect, OF **Alex Ramirez**, has been promoted from Low-A St. Lucie to High-A Brooklyn. Ramirez ranks fourth in the

vs. ABERDEEN: The Baltimore Orioles affiliate, who clinched the first half title in the North Division, comes to Coney Island for the Fourth of July. Aberdeen promoted several of its key players from the first half, including OF Colton Cowser, INF Coby Mayo, and INF Connor Norby. However, the 'Birds still have No. 21 OF John Rhodes, No 28 SS Darell Hernaiz, and No. 29 RHP Jean Pinto who make up the only Top 30 Baltimore prospects on the roster.

system behind No. 1 C **Francisco Alvarez**, No. 2 3B **Brett Baty**, and No. 3 SS **Ronny Mauricio**. Ramirez, who is just 19 years old, spent the past two seasons at St. Lucie. He is joined by OF **Stanley Consuegra** who earns his first promotion to High-A.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 36 home runs in the past 45 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms posted a 3.49 earned run average in 29 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

DOM DEBUT: Dominic Hamel makes his Brooklyn High-A debut today, facing the Aberdeen IronBirds.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 9 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
