SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

FOUR FOR THE PLAYOFFS: To qualify for the playoffs the Shuckers need to win four of their final six games of the season against the Montgomery Biscuits... If the Shuckers win at least four games, they'll reach the playoffs for the first time since 2019, when they reached the Southern League Championship Series for the second straight year... The Shuckers would host game one of the Southern League Divisional Series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at MGM Park on Tuesday, September 19.

FINISHING OUT THE ROAD SLATE: With a win on Sunday, the Shuckers tied the franchise record with their 40th road win of the year... Since August 7, the Shuckers win 16 of their final 18 road games, including a sweep of the Tennessee Smokies. 📚 In the final 18 road games, the Shuckers averaged 6.4 runs per game, a .273/.346/.434 slash line and a 2.64 ERA..

Solution Proceedings of the First 41 road games, Biloxi averaged 5.8 runs per game, a .254/.363/.424 slash line and a 5.42 ERA.

WELCOME TO THE AWARD CEREMONY!: INF Zavier Warren was named the Southern League Player of the Week on Monday, earning a weekly award for the first time since 2021 in the Midwest League... In five games during the Shuckers' series against the Birmingham Barons, Warren was 9-20 (.450) at the plate with a double, triple, home run and seven RBI... Warren's seven RBI were the second-most out of any player in the Southern League during last week's series.

Since the start of September, Warren is hitting .419 (13-31) with two doubles, a triple and two home runs. He also owns a .472 on-base percentage and a 1.214 OPS.

THE LEAGUE LEADER: Entering today, OF Carlos Rodriguez leads the Southern League with a .297 average, three points higher than 1B Troy Johnston (Pensacola) for the league lead... No Shuckers player has ever won the Southern League batting title... Only two players have hit at least .300 in a season, including INF Orlando Arcia (.307, 2015) and INF/OF **Patrick Leonard** (.301, 2019).

CROWING A NEW STRIKEOUT KING: RHP Tobias Myers set the Shuckers' new single-season strikeout record with a fourthinning strikeout of C Edgar Quero on Saturday, giving him 158 strikeouts on the year... He broke the previous record of 157, set by RHP Alec Bettinger in 2019... With nine strikeouts on Saturday, Myers is the first Southern League pitcher in 2023 to reach 160 strikeouts in the season.

SMASHING INTO THE LEAD: C/1B Wes Clarke hit his 24th home run of the year on Friday, putting himself atop the Southern League home run leader board... Clarke's 24 home runs are the most he's hit in any season of his college and professional career.

➡If the season ended today, Clarke's 24 home runs would be the second-most by a Shuckers' player in franchise history (since 2015)... The single-season franchise record is 27, set by **OF Corey Ray** in 2018.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP ADAM SEMINARIS [2-5, 6.07]: LHP Adam Semianris makes his 11th start of the year and his fourth since being activated from the Injured List... In his last start, on September 6 at Birmingham, Seminaris threw 71 pitches over five innings, both bests since being activated from the 60-Day IL.
