HILLCATS OUTLAST SHOREBIRDS: The Delmarva Shorebirds fell to the Lynchburg Hillcats in a pitcher's duel on Wednesday night as Lynchburg won 2-1. The Hillcats took the lead in the first inning on a solo home run by **An**gel Genao to make it 1-0 after an inning. Delmarva would tie the game in the next inning with an RBI single by Angel Tejada as he scored Jalen Vasquez from second base to even the game at one. Lynchburg would reclaim the lead in the bottom of the fourth thanks to Manuel Mejias who singled home Jose Devers, to make it a 2-1 game. The pitching staffs for each club would lock-in after that, and despite the score remaining 2-1, Delmarva was unable to strike up a rally and would lose by one run on Wednesday as the Hillcats evened the series.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Juan De Los Santos gets the ball for the 22nd time this season on Thursday night and he'll pitch against **Jackson Humphries** who will be making his third start for the Hillcats. Humphries was moved up to Lynchburg after starting the season in the Arizona Complex League where he appeared 9 times, 8 as a starter. The left-hander was selected in 2022 in the 8th round by the Guardians and has allowed 4 runs in 6.2 innings in his first start as a Hillcat.

SPEED, I AM SPEED: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has made his presence felt since he's joined the Shorebirds as the 1st round pick from Vanderbilt has 13 steals in his starts as a Shorebird. He swiped 4 bases against the Carolina Mudcats on August 13 the most by a Delmarva player in a single game this season. More impressively, Bradfield has reached base at a .538 clip so far thanks to 15 walks he's drawn in his brief Single-A tenure. Bradfield has reached base 10 of 11 games as a Shorebird.

DRIVING THEM HOME IN BUNCHES: Anderson De Los Santos has gained steam as a key run producer for the Shorebirds as of late as drove home 6 runs in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox and is the current leader on the team in RBI amongst active members with 41.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 50 steals in the month of August, which is second most in the league in that span (Augusta).

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 280. They are top five in the league doubles (170), triples (31), and home runs (79). The Shorebirds produced 17 extra-base hits in the previous series against the Salem Red Sox.

MORE REINFORCEMENTS: Jake Cunningham (5th Round) and Cole Urman (16th Round) are the latest draft selections from the 2023 Orioles Draft class to join the Délmarva roster with 8 of the 19 signed draft selection now on the team.

FINAL ROAD TRIP OF THE SEASON: The Shorebirds embark on a 12 game road trip before returning home for the final series of the regular season. The first half of their two city trips is to Lynchburg against the Hillcats where the Shorebirds won four out of six from June 28 - July 3. Delmarva was won the first two series against Lynchburg and split their most previous one in Salisbury and currently hold an 12-8 record against the Guardians affiliate this season.
