TEEING OFF OPENING NIGHT FIREWORKS: Columbia spoiled Augusta's opening night as the GreenJackets 6-0 lead was lost in the final inning with two out as Erick Pena ended the game with a three-run homerun to complete the comeback for the Fireflies.

STARTING WITH DOMINANCE: Royber Salinas brought his A+ stuff on opening night as the right-hander fanned a professional career-high 11 batters in 4.1 innings pitched on the mound. Salinas now has 29 strikeouts across 4 career starts for the GreenJackets in 18.1 innings of work dating back to 2021.

CLUTCH HITTING: Despite a tough, opening night loss, Augusta came up with several timely hits as they scored all six of their runs with two outs. Three of the run-producing hits were of the extra base variety with two homeruns and a double.

GETTING IT DONE AT THE TOP: Cal Conley and Adam Zebrowski each produced strong nights to begin the season as each collected two hits each. Zebrowski played run producer early with his hits with a RBI-double and a solo homerun. Conley delivered two sharp singles with his second hit producing a run in the fourth inning.

CURRENT NOTES: Enters 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in the Atlanta Braves farm system according to MLB Pipeline.

2021: Made four, short starts for the FCL Braves in 2021. Pitched just 8.1 but showed elite strikeout ability in his brief action as he struck out 16 batters. Did show some command issues as he allowed 10 walks during that time and 8 earned runs on just 4 hits with 2 of those knocks being homeruns.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 7th round of the 2021 MLB Draft as a Pitcher. Assigned to GCL Braves following his selection.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played at Colleyville High School in Texas and was tremendous athlete on the baseball field as a pitcher and 3rd basemen. Longest outing was 3.1 innings on August 7, 2021 and did not allow an earned run in that outing. 13/22 appearances in 2021 were 1 inning or less. Had 4 outing where he covered 2 innings or more

2021: Pitched entire season with Augusta GreenJackets, made 20 appearances all out of the bullpen. Covered 23.1 innings and converted all 7 of his save chances to lead the team. Picked up 31 strikeouts and 9 walks with 21 hits allowed. Was put onto the injured list on May 13 and was not activated off until July 9. Assumed the role as the team's closer upon his return from the injured list as he converted 3 saves each in the months of August and September. Finished the season strong by not allowing any runs in his final 7 appearances and just once in his final 10.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Catawba College (NC). Started the 2019 after being drafted with the GCL Braves before being promoted to the Danville Braves (Rookie) for the rest of the season. Had an up-and-down first season in the Braves Organization as he posted a 6.23 ERA in 13 appearances with Danville. His first 4 outings were starts before transitioning to his more natural position as a bullpen arm where he settled in with a 3.55 ERA in 9 appearances and 15.2 innings. 2021: Was the team-leader in appearances with 31 total, 29 out of the bullpen and 2 as a starter. Was 3/3 on his save opportunities Was used as an opener as both of his starts as he pitched just 3 innings in his first start at Charleston on August 4 and 1 inning in his second start vs Columbia on September 12. Was one of the most dependable arms out of the bullpen for the GreenJackets as he allowed 1 or 0 runs in 25 of his 31 outings. Showed strong strikeout ability with 62 punch-outs in 47.2 innings of work to earn a K/9 of 11.8 Had 11 appearances with 3 strikeouts or more including a very impressive outing against Columbia on June 16 where he struck out 6 Fireflies in 2 innings.

2021: Assigned to Augusta at the beginning of the season where he entered as the Braves' No. 24 prospect according to MLB Pipeline but faced a mostly difficult season due to injury. He appeared in 6 total games with 4 starts and only covered 14 innings during that time. Owens finished the season with a 7.07 ERA and an 0-3 record with a small sample size as his season came to end after one month as he was placed on the injured list on June 10 and never returned after that.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 13th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Spent the ensuing season split between the GCL Braves and the Rookie affiliate Danville where he finished the season with a combined 0-3 record with a 4.23 ERA in 10 appearances and 9 starts that covered 27.1 innings. Collected 32 strikeouts throughout the course of the year with 12 walks while holding opponents to an impressive .184 batting average against him. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

All of his outings were out of the bullpen, covered 50.2 innings with 61 strikeouts and 50 walks Had a very strong start to the season as he dealt an ERA of 1.42 in the month of May in 14 innings and allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 10 outings. Ran into trouble following that by allowing multiple runs in 11 of his final 20 appearances as he finished the season with a 7.11 ERA.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 28th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. A native of New Zealand, he was the third player to be drafted from the country joining Scott Campbell and Dan Devonshire who both selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 2006 and 2012 draft respectively. Collected 6 strikeouts and 7 walks during that time with a .158 batting average against in the small sample size but saw great development once being selected by the Braves. His fastball velocity averaged 87-89 mph coming out of high school, he jumped that up significantly as he touched 95 mph during his time with the GCL Braves.

CURRENT NOTES:

2021: Promoted to Augusta fro GCL Braves following COVID year and saw his most work in any professional season. Pena pitched 50.2 innings, doubling his previous high of 25 from his first year in DSL. Was used almost exclusively as a reliever making 26 appearances with one of those being a short start against Myrtle Beach on July 10 where he dealt 3 innings to begin the game. Had a tough start to the season as he allowed earned runs in all 4 of his outings in May but started to settle-in towards the end of the season. Pena finished the year with a 3.35 ERA in the months of August and September combined and started to get a feel for his stuff during that stretch with 23 strikeouts in the two months in 16.1 innings, earning him a 12.8 K/9 during that run.

CAREER: Signed by the Braves as an international free agent in 2017 from the Dominican Republic. Following his signing, the Braves designated him to the Dominican Summer League where he pitched well with a 3.96 ERA in 15 appearances and 25 innings all out of the bullpen. Earned a promotion to the GCL Braves in the 2018 where he continued to work exclusively out of the bullpen. Pitched 23.2 innings in 14 outings with a 5.32 ERA. Pitched in the GCL again in 2019 and improved from the year prior as he dropped his ERA to 1.88. Did not pitch as much in 2018, but saw his strikeout numbers improve in 2019 in the small sample size as he averaged about a strikeout an inning. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

Was assigned to the GCL Twins following his selection and pitched well during his brief season there. Made 5 appearances with 2 starts and finished with a 2-0 record with both of wins coming in relief. Showed his potential in his best outing when he struck out 5 in 3 innings of relief against the Red Sox affiliate on August 11.
