FRES-NOTES

WALK-OFF AND ROLL: The Grizzlies have developed a flair for the dramatic in 2026, already collecting three walk-off wins through 52 games. Derek Bernard delivered a walk-off single on April 22 against Rancho Cucamonga, Jeremy Ciriaco reached on a game-ender on May 15 against Visalia, and Roldy Brito's RBI single completed a ninth-inning comeback Tuesday against Lake Elsinore. Fresno's three walk-off victories are already matching the type of total many clubs need an entire season to reach.

THACH TO THE FUTURE: Tanner Thach continues powering Fresno's offense one swing at a time. The first baseman enters play hitting .368 with 10 home runs and 57 RBI, leading the club in average, hits, multi-hit games (24), multi-RBI games (13) and RBI. His 23-game hitting streak from May 7-June 2nd is the longest by in the California League and two off the longest in Minor League Baseball this year.

GRAY EXPECTATIONS: When Clayton Gray reaches base, good things tend to follow. The Austin Peay product is slashing .313/.437/.445, ranking among Fresno's on-base leaders while providing versatility throughout the lineup. Gray enters the series riding a strong homestand, batting .412 with a homer and four RBI, and he added another big swing Tuesday night with a home run against the Storm. His three homers this season have come in the last three series with an inside the park homer in Rancho two weeks ago, and his first over the fence blast coming on Saturday.

EXTRA, EXTRA, BASE HITS: Fresno roped six extra-base hits on Tuesday as the Grizzlies continue to generate offense in bunches thanks to their ability to drive the baseball. The Grizzlies had 2 homers, 1 triple, and three doubles in the series opener. Fresno enters tonight with 130 extra-base hits on the season, including 55 home runs, both among the top totals in the California League. Tanner Thach, Roldy Brito, and Derek Bernard have helped fuel an offense that ranks near the top of the league in runs scored and OPS, giving Fresno one of the deepest power profiles in the circuit.
