RIDERS DOMINATE IN ALL FACETS TO DROP HOOKS:

The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Corpus Christi Hooks 8-1 from Whataburger Field on Saturday night. Frisco (24-26, 62-56) wasted no time, putting up four runs in the first inning against Corpus Christi (19-31, 40-78) starting pitcher Nic Swanson (2-3). **Luis** Mieses clubbed an RBI double before a balk and a Keith Jones II two-run double added on to make it 4-0. That score held until the fourth when **Aaron Zavala** banged an RBI double off the right-field wall to push the lead to 5-0. The Riders then added on again in the seventh on a Mieses RBI groundout, a wild pitch and an **Elih Marrero** RBI single, padding the lead at 8-0. The Hooks plated a run in the eighth on a sacrifice fly, but Frisco pitching dominated overall. **Daniel Missaki** threw 4.0 shutout innings in his start with six strikeouts while **Ryan Lobus** (5-3) took home the win with 2.2 runless frames from the bullpen. **Gerardo Carrillo** turned in 1.1 perfect innings to finish the game.

CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT:
The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from Cam Cauley against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742. He was placed on the 7-Day Injued List, retroactive to August 22nd.

WIN, WIN AND WIN SOME MORE:

The Riders have won nine of their last 12 games and 12 of their last 16 games. During their last 12 games, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 3.71 ERA as a staff allowing just four home runs. In the 16-game stretch, they are first in the league with a 2.86

Aaron Zavala walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on Friday night for his first walk-off homer with the Riders and second walk-off hit. In a season-best 15-game on-base streak, he is hitting .268 (15-for-56)/.344/.500/.844 with seven doubles, two home runs, 13 RBIs, five walks, 10 runs scored and two steals.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In 20 games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.73 ERA while they are 8-for-12 in save opportunities.

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of Trey Supak and Ben Anderson and the trade of Mitch Bratt, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (Josh Stephan). In 20 August games, Frisco has a 3.11 ERA for starters which is second in the league. Jose Corniell (15.2 IP, 0 ER), Leandro Lopez (18.2 IP, 5 ER) and David Davalillo (43.0 IP, 11 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (71). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .985 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They snapped a string of 10-straight games without an error on Friday (they were 8-2 in those games), the longest such streak in the Texas League this season.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 30 steals over 123 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
