SATURDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats, the Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, split the doubleheader to the Portland Sea Dogs on Saturday afternoon from Hadlock Field, losing the first game 5-4 in nine innings before winning the second game 11-1, snapping a four-game losing streak. In the first game, New Hampshire fell in walkoff style for the third time in the series on a game-winning RBI hit from Portland's Tyler McDonough. In the second game, New Hampshire broke out for eight runs in the second inning and hit three home runs in the contest en route to an 11-1 win. Miguel Hiraldo hit a grand slam, his fourth homer of the season, and Will Robertson hit a two-run homer, his fifth of the season, to account for six of the eight runs scored in the second inning. Damiano Palmegiani launched a two-run homer over the Maine Monster for his sixth home run of the season in the fifth to increase the Fisher Cats lead 11-0. Starting pitcher Paxton Schultz threw five shutout innings, allowing five hits, no walks and four strikeouts, picking up his second win of the season. It's the first time Schultz has thrown five shutout innings in a start this season.

PESKY PORTLAND: New Hampshire has lost eight of eleven in the season series so far to Portland in 2023 but they have all been close, competitive contests that have been decided by a play or a pitch. Nine of the eleven games played vs the Sea Dogs have been decided by two runs or less. The Fisher Cats have lost in walk-off fashion three times in the five games so far in this series.

WHOLE LOTTA TIROTTA: In his Fisher Cats debut on Saturday, Riley Tirotta went 2-for-4 in the doubleheader yesterday, including his first hit and RBI on one swing with a double off the Maine Monster in the fifth inning of the first game. Tirotta also scored four runs in the two games and drew a game-high four walks in the second game of the doubleheader. The corner infielder batted .303 with three homers and 16 RBIs in 27 games with High-A Vancouver to start the season before being promoted to Double-A.

MULTI-HITTERS: Damiano Palmegiani and Miguel Hiraldo lead the Fisher Cats in multi-hit games after strong performances in the second game of the doubleheader. After a pair of hits each by both infielders, Palmegiani now has a team-leading 10 multi-hit games on the season (all have been two-hit games). Hiraldo is second on the team in multi-hit games with nine on the year (also all have been two-hit games).

YOU GOT THE CALL: Two Fisher Cats this week have received promotions to Triple-A Buffalo. Left-handed pitcher Jimmy Burnette was promoted on Tuesday and infielder Trevor Schwecke was promoted on Thursday. They are the third and fourth Fisher Cats to be promoted to Buffalo this month, along with left-handed pitcher Sean Mellen and infielders Luis De Los Santos. Prior to their call ups, Burnette had not allowed a run in six May outings and Schwecke recorded his first five-RBI game of his career with his second career grand slam on Sunday in game two of the doubleheader.

WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: In corresponding moves, left-handed pitcher Mason Fluharty and infielder Riley Tirotta have both been received from High-A Vancouver. Fluharty, a 5th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Liberty in the 2022 Draft, posted a 0.59 ERA in 15.1 innings to start the season with 21 strikeouts over just five walks. Tirotta, a 12th round pick by the Blue Jays out of Dayton in the 2021 Draft, batted .303 with three home runs and 16 RBIs. This is both Fluharty and Tirotta's first stints at Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 28, 2017) - Michael De La Cruz homered with one-out in the bottom of the tenth inning to give the Fisher Cats a 5-4 win over the Fightin Phils. It was his first and only Fisher Cat home run. Sean Reid-Foley struck out nine in 6.2 innings for the Fisher Cats. New Hampshire gave up two in the ninth to fall behind 4-3, but tied the game with a two-out RBI single by Ryan McBroom.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (27-26) lost the second game of the series to Minnesota 9-7. Bo Bichette drove in a game-high four RBIs and Cavan Biggio homered but Minnesota hit four home runs and three off Chris Bassitt ... Triple-A Buffalo (24-26) won 14-9 at Lehigh Valley. LJ Talley drove in a game-high six RBIs, including two homers. Davis Schneider hit his team-leading 11th home run of the year and Rafael Lantigua and Spencer Horwitz homered ....High-A Vancouver (22-20) won 6-0 to Spokane in six innings. The second game of the doubleheader was postponed due to rain...Class A Dunedin (23-20) defeated Fort Myers 7-2.

**LAST TIME OUT**: Allowed one run in 6.0 IP here Tuesday night – gave up a fifth inning homer to Stephen Scott. Did not figure in decision. Struck out five.

**v. PORTLAND** – Makes his  $8^{th}$  career start vs. Portland, and fourth in 2023. He is still seeking first win vs. Sea Dogs.

**2023:** Struck out a season-high nine in a 3-1 win over Binghamton 5/17...quality start (0 ER- 6 IP) in 3-0 win over Harrisburg 5/5 with 8K. Went 7 innings for the first time at AA on 4/28 vs. HFD in a 2-0 loss....Earned a complete game victory 4/22 at Somerset in game shortened to five innings. Had eight strikeouts in a 3-1 win.

**2022:** Earned first Double-A win with 5.0 IP scoreless 8/16 at Hartford. Pitched season-high six innings in first quality start vs. Erie 8/10..Struck out 10 Sea Dogs in New Hampshire's 5-3 win July 23, but did not earn decision as Fisher Cats won the game late...Made Double-A debut in a relief outing in Erie May 21....Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

**2021**: Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

**2019:** Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against. **2018:** Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

**Obtained:** Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus. **Personal:** Was ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch. **Pronounced:** KLOFF-en-steen
