**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn and Greenville split Thursday's doubleheader...The Drive took the opener, 1-0, while the Cyclones captured the nightcap, 7-4...Only run in Game 1 scored on a leadoff solo home run by CF **Roman Anthony**...LHP **Zach Penrod** tossed 6.0 innings of 2-hit shutout ball to extend his scoreless-inning streak to 17.0 and earn his 2nd win...RHP **Brock Bell** recorded the final 3 outs for his 3rd save...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** was credited with a complete game for Brooklyn, striking out 7 over 6.0 innings of 1-run, 2-hit ball...RF **Stanley Consuegra** propelled the 'Clones in Game 2...He tripled and scored in the 2nd, collected a 3-run double in the 5th, and reached on an infield single before crossing on a sacrifice fly in the 7th...2B **D'Andre Smith**, C **José Mena**, DH **Carlos Domínguez**, and LF **Omar De Los Santos** all tallied multi-hit games in the finale...RHP **Kolby Kubichek** entered with the tying run at the plate in the 7th and recorded the final 2 outs for his 2nd save.

**ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS:** Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance and has won 7 of their last 11 series since dropping 4-of-6 to Greenville on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 7-2-2 in their last 11 sets...Brooklyn is 33-24 in the second half and is tied with Jersey Shore (33-24) atop the North Division of the SAL with 9 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on August 24 and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS **Jett Williams** (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...Entering Friday, Consuegra is tied for 5th in the SAL in home runs (19), 4th in slugging percentage (.483), and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (38)...Over his last 13 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .294/.368/.706 with a 1.074 OPS, adding 14 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs, and 16 RBI...Since that date, Stanley leads the SAL in homers (5), RBI (16), slugging percentage (.706), triples (2), extra-base hits (9), and total bases (36), in addition to being tied for the lead in runs scored (14).

**JETT THE MET:** INFs **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .316/.478/.588 with a 1.066 OPS, 30 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 19 RBI, 41 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 40 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 175 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.478)...He is also 2nd in walks (41) and 4th in OPS (1.066)...On the season, Williams is tied for 4th in Minor League Baseball in walks (95)...Among teenagers, Williams leads MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 100 PA) in batting average (.301), on-base percentage (.458), OPS (1.006), and walks (26)...He is also tied for 1st in doubles (8) and stolen bases (10), 2nd in slugging percentage (.548), and tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (13) and hits (28)...Among SAL players with at least 120 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is leading the circuit in walk rate (21.7%), is 2nd in OBP (.458), and 5th in wRC+ (176), wOBA (.453), and OPS (1.007).

**CLIFF NOTES:** OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Friday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.488), tied for 3rd in home runs (20), and 6th in OPS (.831)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.246), and 8th in wOBA (.370) and wRC+ (124).

**LUGO LAND:** INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Despite having a 3-game multi-hit streak snapped on Tuesday, Lugo reached safely in 7 consecutive games and has a knock in 10 of his last 12...Over his 7-game on-base streak, the 21-year-old is 10-for-27 at the plate (.370) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, and 3 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .346/.397/.462 with a .859 OPS...Lugo has also scored 5 runs, picked up 4 doubles, a triple, and 13 RBI in 14 games...The Dominican native is tied for the league lead in hits (18) and is tied for 3rd in RBI (13) in that span.

**FEROCIOS FELIPE:** Despite taking the loss in Game 1 of Thursday's doubleheader, LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** continued the stellar start to his Cyclones' career...The 22-year-old hurled his second-straight quality start, hurling all 6 innings in the lid-lifter...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher in over 2 years...

**vs. GREENVILLE:** Brooklyn closes out a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive possess 6 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Roman Anthony** (2), C **Kyle Teel** (4), RHP **Luis Perales** (7), SS **Eddinson Paulino** (16), 2B **Mikey Romero** (19), and OF **Allan Castro** (27)...Romero is currently on the 7-day IL...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the second time in this season...The Drive took 4-of-6 from the Cyclones from June 6-11 at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn and Greenville have met once at Fluor Field from May 11-16, 2021...The Drive won 4-of-6 contests in that series.

RHP **José Butto** was the last to accomplish the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...Since making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz is tied for 2nd in the league in strikeouts (13).

**BEST IN SHOW:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.46 ERA (305 ER in 792.1 IP) over their last 91 games, holding a 50-41 record, which is 3rd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.37) leads MiLB...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 4th in MiLB — in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.646) and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.24) and batting average against (.218).

**DOMINANT DEBUTS:** OF **Carlos Domínguez** introduced himself to Cyclones fans in a grand way on Thursday...Over the course of the doubleheader, the 23-year-old went 3-for-7 at the plate with a run scored...Domínguez's Brooklyn debut set the tone for outstanding starts for several former Cyclones up and down the Mets' Minor League ladder...RHP **Joander Suárez** tossed 6.0 innings of shutout, no-hit ball to earn the win in his Double-A debut for Binghamton vs. Harrisburg...3B **Chase Estep** went 1-for-4 with a run scored, a double, a walk, and 3 RBI in his maiden voyage for Triple-A Syracuse at Lehigh Valley...LF **Jaylen Palmer** also made his first Triple-A appearance and finished the day 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI.

**THE AMAZING ALEX:** OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (119), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clasé** (118), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (118), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (114), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (113) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took the loss with Single-A St. Lucie in Game 1 of a doubleheader last Friday at Dunedin...Permitted only 1 run on 3 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 6...Surrendered his only tally on a solo home run by LF **Ángel Del Rosario** in the bottom of the 3rd...Plunked a batter...Tossed 78 pitches and 47 strikes (60.3%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the bottom of the 6th with the Mets trailing 1-0...St. Lucie went on to drop the lid-lifter, 6-0...Mets dropped the nightcap, 15-2.

**SWING AND A MISS:** Despite ranking 18th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (84) fewer pitchers created more swings and misses than Ovalles in 2023...Among FSL arms that tossed 80 or more innings, the 20-year-old ranked second in the circuit in swinging strike percentage (13.8%)...Only fellow Cyclone LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (15.4%) created more whiffs...Ovalles was also 4th in batting average against (.219) and 6th in strikeout rate (23.5%).

**2023:** Ovalles joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on August 31...Made 22 appearances (18 starts) with the Mets...Composed a 3-6 record with a 4.73 ERA (44 ER in 83.2 IP), 36 walks (10.1 BB%) and 84 strikeouts (23.5 K%)...Thrived in the month of June...Went 1-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP), 2 walks and 23 strikeouts in 5 appearances (4 starts).

**ON THE RIGHT FOOT:** Ovalles' numbers are much stronger as a starter than as a reliever in 2023...In 18 starts, Ovalles is 3-6 with a 4.33 ERA (35 ER in 72.2 IP) with 30 walks (10.0 BB%) and 72 strikeouts (23.9 K%)...The 20-year-old did not receive a decision, but held a 7.36 ERA (9 ER in 11.0 IP), plus 6 walks (10.5 BB%) and 12 strikeouts (21.1 K%).

**2022:** Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Accrued a 1-2 clip with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER in 29.1 IP) and 1 save in 11 appearances (1 start)...Walked only 5 (4.2 BB%) and punched out 44 (36.7 K%)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 9...Composed an 0-1 record and a 6.23 ERA (12 ER in 17.1 IP) with 1 save in 5 appearances (3 starts) for the Mets...Issued 12 walks (15.0 BB%) and struck out 22 (27.5 K%)...Made 1 start for St. Lucie in the Florida State League Playoffs...Started Game 1 of the FSL Championship Series at Dunedin on September 18...Surrendered 4 runs on 3 hits over 2-plus innings, walking 2 and striking out 3...Mets went on to win the game, 6-5, and take the series in 2 games.
