### LANGFORD HOMERS IN THREE-HIT DAY, FRISCO CLAIMS COME BACK WIN:

**Wyatt Langford** homered while going 3-for-4, **Josh Hatcher** scored the game-winning run in the ninth inning after his RBI triple, and the Frisco RoughRiders pulled out a 4-3 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Saturday from HODGETOWN. Langford homered to right field to tie the game in the sixth inning, his fourth home run of the series. Langford now has multiple hits in seven-consecutive games, with his three hits on Saturday setting a new best at Double-A. He singled in the third inning and in the eighth, and his one out was a flyout to the warning track in the first inning. **Jack Leiter** allowed just three hits and two runs in five innings. In his 19th and final start for Frisco this year, Leiter struck out nine while walking just one. After **Kellen Strahm**'s single to open the top of the ninth inning, Hatcher tripled off the wall in center field to tie the game at 3-3. He scored on a wild pitch to put Frisco in front. **Triston Polley** (4-3) went 1-2-3 on the mound in the bottom of the ninth, earning the win with two strong innings. He struck out five batters in a row and finished with a pop out to conclude the game. **Aidan Anderson** pitched two innings, allowing an unearned, go-ahead run that scored after he exited in the eighth inning. The Riders struck first in the second inning when Strahm walked and was pushed to third on **Aaron Zavala**'s double. Hatcher scored Strahm on a sacrifice fly. Hatcher also singled in the eighth inning and went 2-for-3 with two runs batted in. Frisco pitchers stymied the top two batters in Amarillo's order, Cam Duzenack and Tim Tawa, with eight strikeouts in eight plate appearances. None of the top four hitters collected a hit.

### WELCOME, WYATT:

**Wyatt Langford**, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco last Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday against Northwest Arkansas, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday. On Wednesday, he had his first two-homer game. On Saturday, he became the first player for the RoughRiders to have multiple hits in seven games in a row. During this stretch, he is hitting .545 (15-for-26) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBIs, six walks and six runs scored.

### BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.6 runs per game, a .236 batting average, 25 home runs and a .705 OPS over their 41 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 18-22. The 25 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A and **Wyatt Langford** has accounted for the only four in the last five games. **Keyber Rodriguez** (two homer runs) is the only other RoughRiders hitter to have more than one home run in September. In those 14 games in the month, Frisco has hit just eight long balls with a .662 OPS while averaging 4.2 runs per game.

### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in eight of the last 20 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 98 over their 135 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .271/.370/.429/.799 in the first inning with 15 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 677 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .354 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Kellen Strahm** (74, 5th), **Aaron Zavala** (72, 7th) and **Trevor Hauver** (71, 8th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 139. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 50 games, Hicks is batting .293 (49-for-167)/.431/.377/.808 with nine doubles, a triple, a home run, 23 RBIs, 31 walks and 21 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.
