### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound today, looking to run the winning streak to three (6-1 in last 7G). The Mets will counter with RHP **Jonah Tong**. Columbus is 46-31 (.597) versus right handers this year. Tong has never pitched against Columbus in his career, as today will be his 21st career game in the International League.

### vs. the Mets

The Clippers have won the season series in five of the last seven years they have played the Mets (lost in 2023, split in 2019) and have triumphed in 35 of 54G (.648) dating to 6/11/15. They were 2-4 in Syracuse in 2024 (5-1 in the home slate) and 2-3 at Syracuse in 2023. Individually, **George Valera** has hit .333 (14x42) with 6HR and 14RBI against Syracuse in 12G of his career.

### Jump Start

Columbus has outscored the opposition 46-8 in the first four innings of the last 7G, taking a lead of at least three into the 5th of each one. Opponents have then outscored Columbus 30-14 from the 5th-9th, but have managed to complete only one comeback (Toledo on Saturday). Overall, Columbus is 58-23 when taking a lead this year (.716, 5th best in the IL) and 34-50 when trailing (.405, leads the IL).

### Getting Offensive

Over the last 7G, the Clippers have plated a total of 60 runs (most in the IL, 8.6 per game), after coming out of the All-Star Break with 35 runs in the first 9G (16th in the IL, 3.9 per). Columbus had 2HR in 288AB of those first 9G, but have shaken off the rust to the tune of an IL-best 17HR in the last 227AB. The last week plus has seen a collective OPS of 1.005 (Scranton/WB is 2nd at .965).

### Ingle is Back

In 19G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 34x80 (.425), drawing 11BB (.489OBP) with 14XBH (5HR, .725SLG). He is one of two in the IL, along with **BJ Murray** (Iowa), hitting .300/.400/.500 and he is currently riding an 11G hit streak (.479, 23x48 with 4HR and 15RBI since 7/23, multi-hit in eight straight). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.347OPS (14HR) in 38G (.691OPS and 3HR in 31G between DH and LF).

### Wavy Watson

It's been up and down for **Kahlil Watson** since getting optioned, starting with an 0x5, 5K night on 7/23 at St. Paul and most recently finishing with a 4x4 outing last night. Watson is hitting .250 (10x40) in his last 11G, but has scored only four times (twice last night). On 5/9, he ranked 2nd in the IL with 30BB (145PA, 21%), but he has just 12BB since (158PA, 8%; strikeouts rose from 27% to 30%).

### Take it on the Road

**Ralph Velazquez** had his 5G RBI streak snapped on Sunday, but finished the home stand 5x21 with a double, 3HR and 7RBI (6RBI in previous 13G). He was hitless over the last roadtrip (0x21 in St. Paul), but went 3x5 with a HR and 3RBI last night (first road HR since 7/8 at LHV). Velazquez owns a .641OPS in 26G on the road (3HR in 105AB), compared to .883 in 29G at home (5HR in 103AB).

### Out of a Slump

After doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** hit .111 (8x72) with a .139SLG in his next 20G (6/27-7/28). On 7/30, he was 2x3 with a HR (snapped 124AB homerless streak) and his 150th career RBI as a Clipper (38th most all-time), and he has hit safely in five straight (.389, 7x18, .833SLG). Valera has scored seven times in his last 4G, crossing the 150 threshold there (38th all-time).

### Serious Growth

**Kody Huff** clubbed his 16th HR of the season Friday night (all in last 272AB; had 15HR in previous 856AB, 6/28/23-4/5/26). Having already established career highs in runs, triples, RBI, walks, and steals, Huff is just five hits and four doubles from personal bests. He is 9x39 in his last 12G (4HR) and his .891OPS is 14th best in the IL (.682OPS in MiLB career prior; **Cooper Ingle** leads: 1.043).

### Rare Company

Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, **Milan Tolentino** is 27x93 (.290) in his last 30G, collecting 15XBH (.559SLG) and 19RBI (was 5x39, .128, in 13G prior). Over his last 23G, Tolentino has drawn 20BB to 19K (84PA; 8BB and 42K in previous 33G, 114PA). He is one of 12 in the IL with at least a dozen HR and SB, along with **Kahlil Watson** (Columbus, Omaha and Jacksonville have two).

## Columbus Clippers Game Information

Wednesday, August 5

### This Date in Clipper History

8/5/2016

Columbus pounded Louisville 17-4, slugging 3HR at Louisville Slugger Field. **Jesus Aguilar** was 3x5 with a pair of doubles, a HR and 5RBI, while **Yandy Diaz** and **Guillermo Quiroz** each went 2x5 with a HR and 4RBI. Both **Bradley Zimmer** and **Giovanny Urshela** recorded 4-hit games. For Aguilar, he would club 10HR and drive in 27 over his final 28 games, leading the IL in both categories for the year (30HR, 92BI).

### First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,469 to 1,414).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 156-124 (.557) in pitch reviews, with batters going 81-77 (.513) and pitchers/catchers going 75-47 (.615). They have run out of challenges in 43G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

### On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 822, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

### On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 126 through 107G (on pace for 174SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 35CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

### Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 159 runs while crafting a .903OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 98 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +61 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 250-155 from innings 5-7).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,976RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.34 through the first 108G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 197HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 6th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 60G this season (36-24, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Good Baseball

**CJ Kayfus** bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers have the 3rd most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 5th most games decided in the last at bat (26, Memphis has 30). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 100G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-52 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 444-456 (.493), 414-410 with Columbus (.502).
