**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) begin a long 12-game homestand tonight, first hosting the Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A, Orioles) for six straight through this Sunday. Fayetteville and Delmarva met recently, splitting a six-game series 3-3 in Salisbury Maryland. Tonight's game is the seventh in the 24-game head-to-head season series. Fayetteville's projected starter his RHP Twine Palmer and Delmarva will counter with fourth-round pick RHP Chase Allsup.

**ABOUT THE SHOREBIRDS:** The Delmarva Shorebirds, founded in 1991, begin their 35th season of operation in 2025. Having joined the Carolina League in 2021 following the post-COVID-19 pandemic alongside the Augusta GreenJackets, Charleston RiverDogs, Columbia Fireflies, and Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, they are in the midst of their fifth season in the league. Collin Woody returns to manage the club for his second season after serving as the Fundamentals Coach for the FCL Orioles in 2022 and 2023. Although the Shorebirds have never won a Carolina League title, they were twice crowned champions of the Class A South Atlantic League in 1997 and 2000. Before moving to Salisbury, they were established as the Sumter (S.C.) Flyers in 1991 as an Atlanta Braves affiliate before moving to Albany (Ga.) and being re-branded as the Albany (Ga.) Polecats, affiliating with the Orioles (1993-1994) and Montreal Expos (1992, 1995). They kept their affiliation with the Expos upon moving to Maryland in 1996, but they re-affiliated with the Orioles in 1997 and have stayed in their organization ever since

**(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES:** This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the start of the 2025 season. In May of 2024, it was announced that the Down East Wood Ducks would re-locate to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers decided to swap them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Shorebirds, Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A Cleveland Guardians), Carolina Mud-cats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers), Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, Washington Nationals), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

**ON THE ROAD TO H-TOWN:** The Woodpeckers current roster features three players listed in the top 30 of the Houston Prospect Rankings according to MLB.com. Cole Hertzler is the highest ranked of the trio at No. 27 overall (No. 13 pitcher), Jancel Villarroel is the lone position player in the group at No. 29 overall (No. 2 catcher), and Bryce Mayer rounds out the list at No. 30 overall (No. 15 pitcher).

**THE NEW MAN IN THE DUGOUT:** The Woodpeckers feature a brand new coaching staff from top to bottom in 2025. With former manager Ricky Rivera earning a promotion to Double-A to lead the Corpus Christi Hooks, Carlos Lugo takes over for his first season in full-season baseball. However, Lugo is no stranger to the Houston Astros organization. This season marks his 12th with the club having started as a catching specialist in the Dominican Summer League in 2014. Most recently, he spent four seasons managing in the Florida Complex League, the first of which with Rivera, helping develop some of the Astros' youngest professional players. As he gets his first taste of Single-A, he teams up with three members of his staff from last year in Palm Beach including James Wiseman (Pitching Coach), Kyle Brennan (Hitting Coach), and Alfredo Granier (Development Coach).

**THE 'PECKERS CAN PITCH:** Through the first 21 games of the season, the Woodpeckers have established themselves as one of the top teams on the mound in the Carolina League. They enter this series leading the league in ERA (3.34), while also ranking fourth in strikeouts (207), first in earned runs (66) and second in opponent batting average (.205). Cole Hertzler has emerged as the ace of the staff, placing fourth in the league in ERA (0.66) and strikeouts (19), fifth in innings pitched (13.2), and tied for 12th in WHIP (1.17).

**LATE LEADS DONT LAST:** The Woodpeckers have had trouble over the first two weeks of the season hanging on to late leads at home. The club has a 7-4 record when leading after seven innings, and if every game in last week's series against Fredericksburg consisted of seven-inning games, Fayetteville would have gone 5-1. They also lost consecutive games at home on Opening Weekend in which they led during the final three innings.

**THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY:** April 29, 2022 - Three years ago, the Woodpeckers inch out a 2-1 win over the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers behind strong pitching from Bryant Salgado and Franny Cobos. Cobos, the Cuban born righty, dominated from the bullpen. Pitching 4.0 hitless innings while striking out nine to earn the winning decision.
