ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians used a stellar start from Adam Kloffenstein and a three-run fifth to beat the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) 5-2 on Thursday night at Funko Field.

Vancouver broke a scoreless tie to plate that trio of runs in inning number five. Phil Clarke bunted for a base hit then a walk and a hit batter loaded the bases before Zac Cook was plunked to force home the first run of the night. Tanner Morris followed with a sacrifice fly RBI then Spencer Horwitz made it 21 games with a hit by singling to right field to bring home a run and make it 3-0 C's.

The C's added a run in the sixth with a Clarke double, a wild pitch and a dropped pop fly in right field that scored Clarke to put Vancouver ahead 4-0.

Everett spoiled the shutout with two runs in the bottom of the sixth, but starter Adam Kloffenstein (W, 7-6) turned in one of his best starts of the year. He went five and two-thirds, allowed two runs on two hits, walked three and K'd five.

A run in the seventh padded the C's lead and Justin Maese, Roither Hernandez and Hagen Danner (S, 3) handled business the rest of the way to secure Vancouver's second win in the last three games and the sixth in their last nine games against the Frogs.

Morris and Horwitz both extended their hitting streaks to 21 consecutive games. The former went 2-for-4 with an RBI while the latter finished 1-for-3 with two RBI. Phil Clarke led the way with three hits and now has nine knocks over the first three games of this series.

FEELING FUNKO-Y: The C's dock in Everett for their third and final visit to Funko Field. They are 12-18 against the Frogs but beat them in a series for the first time when they last met August 10-15.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

PLAY SPOILER: The next nine games for the Canadians are against teams vying for a playoff berth. Once they wrap this series with Everett, they'll take on Spokane for six games.

TAMPED DOWN: Vancouver matched a season low by limiting the Frogs to four hits for the fourth time this year and first since May when they did it three times in the same series.

OUCH! Trevor Schwewe, Zac Cook (2) and Spencer Horwitz were all hit by pitches last night, the most in a single game for the Canadians this season.

SUN GODS: The C's are 9-6 in day games this year.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 21 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 35-for-83 (.422) with eight doubles, six homers, 18 runs scored, 25 RBI and 17 walks while Morris is 30-for-90 (.333) with six doubles, a triple, a homer, 13 runs scored, 15 RBI and nine walks. The league record is 26, established in 1962 by Gary Johnson of Tri-City.

ACE OF ON BASE: Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 30 consecutive games since July 25. He's 41-for-124 (.331) with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 15 runs scored, 19 RBI and 13 walks. In an even greater accomplishment, he's reach in 47 of his last 49 starts.

ON THE HILL: Andrew Bash goes for Vancouver to make first High-A start and the third of his career this afternoon. His last turn as a starter was on July 10 for Low-A Dunedin in a game against the Tampa Tarpons (NY). That day, the right-hander went five innings and allowed one run on two hits - one of which was a homer - with five walks and six strikeouts to earn the win. Bash, 25, signed with Toronto in June of this year after he as released by the Angels in May of 2020. Los Angeles drafted him in the 30th round (901st overall) in 2019 out of Cal Baptist, where he played infield and pitched for the Lancers. He's from Palm Desert, CA
