### CAPTAINS LOG

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Captains extended their win streak to 5 games with an 8-1 victory versus Dayton on Wednesday afternoon at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake.

RHP **Carter Spivey** (2-1) earned his 2nd Minor League victory and 3<sup>rd</sup> straight quality start. He went a career-high 6 innings in his 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive start, allowing 1 earned run on 5 hits, and striking out a career high 6 (tied) in 89 pitches (49 strikes).

The Captains scored on a 2-run double by SS **Jose Devers**, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, an RBI single by LF **Guy Lipscomb** and home runs from 1B **C.J. Kayfus** (3-run) and 2B **Alex Mooney** (solo), MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** **Kayfus's** 3-run home run in Lake County's 4-run 4<sup>th</sup> inning marked his first time homering in back-to-back games since 4/25/23 vs. Florida Atlantic and 4/27/23 at Louisville while at Miami (FL). He joins OF **Jake Fox**, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, as the only Captains to homer in consecutive games this year.

**2-OUT HITTING:** In 2 games versus Dayton, 9 of Lake County's 14 runs have been scored with 2 outs, including home runs by **Kayfus** and **Mooney** on Wednesday. The Captains lead the Midwest League with a .272 batting average with 2 outs this season.

**21<sup>ST</sup> SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL:** 2024 marks the 21<sup>st</sup> season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,763 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,391-1,372 (.503).

**WINNING WAVES:** The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

### TRENDS & NOTABLES

**THAT'S A WINNING STREAK:** The Captains have won 5 straight games, which is the longest active winning streak in the Midwest League. Lake County has won 8 of its last 10 games, which is tied for the MWL's best mark during that stretch with Cedar Rapids.

**AN OFFENSIVE RENAISSANCE:** Lake County's 141 runs through 29 games are its most since 2011, when they scored 160. The 2011 Captains had future MLB players **Gio Urshela**, **Jesús Aguilar**, **Danny Salazar**, and Cleveland all-time saves leader **Cody Allen**.

**THAT'S OUR GUY:** Since April 30 vs. Fort Wayne, OF **Guy Lipscomb** is batting .464 (13-for-28) in 7 games, which is tied for the best mark in the Midwest League (min. 8 AB). **Lipscomb** is riding a 7-game hit streak, which is tied for the 3<sup>rd</sup>-longest active streak in the Midwest League.

**TOP QUALITY:** Through 29 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 9 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the most in High-A. RHPs **Carter Spivey** and **Austin Peterson** have each recorded 3 straight.

**BASH BROS 2.0:** Captains INF **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus** have been the MWL's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 33.1% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 11 of the team's 23 home runs.

**STRONG STARTING PITCHING:** Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in fewest walks (33, 1<sup>st</sup>), wins (11, 1<sup>st</sup>), strikeouts (142, T-2<sup>nd</sup>), WHIP (1.16, 2<sup>nd</sup>) innings pitched (140.0, 2<sup>nd</sup>), and ERA (3.28, 4<sup>th</sup>).

**COLLADO ON BASE:** With a single on Wednesday, INF **Maick Collado** has extended his on-base streak to 17, the longest by a Captain this year. His 17-game stretch is the 2<sup>nd</sup>-longest active streak in the Midwest League, trailing only South Bend's Yohendrick Pinango (23). **Collado's** streak is the longest by a Captain since **Dayan Frias** reached base in 19 straight games from 7/7/2023 to 8/1/2023.

**PLENTY OF '23 IN LC:** 6 players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus** was drafted in Round 3, C **Cooper Ingle** in Round 4, INF **Alex Mooney** in Round 7, OF **Jonah Advincula** in Round 8, RHP **Jay Driver** in Round 9, and RHP **Zane Morehouse** in Round 14.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Trenton Denholm (ND) made his fifth start of the season on May 3 vs. Fort Wayne, and did not record a decision in the 6-4 win. Denholm went 4 innings, allowing a season-high of 4 runs (season-high 3 earned) on 5 hits, striking out 5 and walking 1 in 83 pitches (58 strikes). His runs were allowed on a 2-run double and a 2-run home run.

**MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS:** Denholm leads the Midwest League and ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in Minor League Baseball with a 13.5 strikeout-to-walk ratio. He also ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Midwest League in opposing batting average (.218), and 4<sup>th</sup> in the Midwest League in WHIP (0.95).

**AGAINST DAYTON IN '23:** Denholm went 1-1 in two relief appearances on 4/27/2023 and 6/23/2023 against the Dragons, allowing a combined 3 earned runs, fanning 5, and walking 1.

**LAST 11 STARTS:** Denholm has posted a 2.29 ERA (13 earned runs in 51 innings) in his last 11 starts dating back to April 13, 2023.

**CAPTAIN ON THE MOUND:** In 2023, Denholm played a versatile role in his first season with Lake County's pitching staff. The right-hander made 23 appearances (six starts), recording 3 wins and 3 saves in 5 opportunities out of the Captains' bullpen. He was also very efficient on the mound last year, tallying 67 strikeouts to just 18 walks, and compiling a 1.14 WHIP.

**HILLCAT ON THE HILL:** Denholm pitched his first professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

**AWESOME ANTEATER:** Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper 3<sup>rd</sup> Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in Denholm being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

**OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS:** 3-time MLB All-Star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

**BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY:** Denholm is related to former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, with 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Steve Hajjar (ND) made his second relief appearance of the season, and first in 18 days, back on May 5 vs. Fort Wayne. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing 2 walks and throwing 2 strikeouts in the 6-0 win.

**TRAVELIN' MAN:** Hajjar was the player to be named later in the trade that sent former Captain Will Benson to Cincinnati and current Captains OF Justin Boyd to Cleveland on February 8, 2023. Hajjar was officially traded to Cleveland on March 26, 2023. Also, after being drafted by the Minnesota Twins in 2021, Hajjar was traded to the Cincinnati Reds on August 2, 2022 as part of the trade that sent RHP Tyler Mahle to Minnesota.

**FORMER DAYTON DRAGON:** Hajjar made 2 starts for the Dayton Dragons in 2022, finishing with 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA and 10 strikeouts in 7 innings pitched. In his Minor League career, the left-hander has also pitched for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels (Single-A, MIN) and the Florida Complex League Twins.

**AGAINST DAYTON IN '23:** Hajjar made 2 starts against his former Dragons on June 23 and July 14. In those starts, he went 0-0, allowing 1 earned run and striking out 8 in 8 innings of work. In his first start at Dayton on June 23, Hajjar spun 5 no-hit innings in the 3-1 Captains loss.

**CAPTAIN STEVE RETURNS:** Hajjar returns to Lake County after making 14 starts for the Captains last year. The left-hander went 3-4 with a 3.61 ERA and 58 strikeouts in 57.1 innings of work. His 9 walks against Beloit on August 22, 2023 set a franchise record for the most walks issued by a Lake County pitcher in a single game.

**BACK FROM INJURY IN '23:** Hajjar began the 2023 season on the 7-day injured list. The left-hander made two rehab appearances (one start) with the Arizona Complex League Guardians, pitching 7 innings, allowing 6 hits, 3 earned runs, and 6 walks, and throwing 7 strikeouts. He was then activated from the 7-day injured list on June 13, 2023.

**WONDERFUL WOLVERINE:** Despite being drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2018 MLB Draft, Hajjar elected to play college baseball at the University of Michigan, where he was teammates with former Captains C Joe Donovan for 2 seasons. After being redshirted as a freshman in 2019, Hajjar made 4 starts in 2020, finishing 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 24 strikeouts, and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice. Then, as a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Hajjar was named 1<sup>st</sup> Team All-Big Ten after finishing 4-2 with a 3.09 ERA and a Big Ten-leading 110 strikeouts in 14 starts. He was also named 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Region by both ABCA and Rawlings.
