TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque lost game five to Sugar Land last night, 6-2, and need a win in today's contest to salvage a series split ... A rematch of game one starters is scheduled: lefty Jack O'Loughlin for the Isotopes and right-hander Miguel Ullola for the Space Cowboys.

SERIES WIN?: Albuquerque has yet to win a series against the Space Cowboys since Sugar Land joined the PCL in 2021. In 17 all-time complete series, the Isotopes have lost 10 and split seven.

HOUSTON AFFILIATE: Additionally, the Isotopes have not taken a series of any kind against Houston's Triple-A affiliate since sweeping the Fresno Grizzlies in a four-game set in the Duke City from Aug. 20-23, 2016. There have been 27 series that have taken place since (against Fresno, Round Rock and Sugar Land).

HOMER STREAK: The Isotopes saw their streak of nine consecutive games with a home run come to an end last night (21 total). They belted multiple long balls in the final six contests of the stretch.

**BY WAY OF THE K**: The Isotopes pitching staff registered 10 strikeouts last night, the fifth-straight contest with double-digit punchouts, the longest streak since June 25-29, 2024, also a string of five-straight

KEEP IT CLEAN: The Isotopes' seven miscues on the year are the fewest in the Pacific Coast League and tied for the fourthfewest in Triple-A.

**DINGERS**: Albuquerque has homered in 11 of their first 14 games to begin the season ... The club has 23 homers on the year, the most in MiLB.

RUNS: The Isotopes were held to two or fewer runs for the sixth time this year and second of the series (April 9).

HITS: Albuquerque finished with four hits last night, tying a season-low (also: March 29 at Sacramento, April 1 vs. Salt Lake).

ASSIST: Jordan Beck threw out Brice Matthews attempting to score from second base on a single in the first lining, Albuquerque's fifth outfield assist of the campaign and second-straight game with an assist (Sam Hilliard).

CI: Austin Nola was called for catcher's interference last night, the first time an Isotopes backstop committed the infraction since

FULFORD: Braxton Fulford registered a single last night and has a six-game hit-streak. During stretch is slashing .571/.640/.1.238 with two doubles, four homers and nine RBI ... Has reached base safely in 16 of his last 25 plate appearances

RELATIONS

**ON-BASE STREAK:** Braxton Fulford has reached base in 10-straight games, slashing .438/.526/.1.000 with three doubles, five homers, five walks and 10 RBI.

THE VET: Austin Nola went 2-for-4 last night in his second start with Albuquerque, after recording just six multi-hit games in 55 contests last season for Omaha.

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel collected an RBI double last night, his third extra-base hit in his last five games (two doubles and one homer)

AMADOR: Adael Amador belted his second homer of the year Friday to extend his hit streak to eight games. During the stretch, he is slashing .281/.439/.500 with one double, two homers and four RBI. Has a hit in nine of the 10 games he's played.

RITTER: Ryan Ritter registered his third homer of the year Friday (last: April 2 (six games), a three-run shot ... Tallied a season-high three RBI ... Tallied fourth multi-hit contest of the season.

**SAM I AM**: Sam Hilliard has reached base in eight-straight contests. During stretch, slashing .250/.371/.571 with one double, one triple, one homer, five RBI and six walks.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 78 home runs in an Isotopes uniform across five seasons (2019, 21, 22, 24 and 25). He is one blast away from tying Mike Busch (1993-96) for most among all Albuquerque Triple-A players.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 219 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

JH: Jaden Hill pitched a perfect eighth inning last night, striking out the side in order. Hill has fanned 13 of 21 batters to step in against him this season without issuing a walk or hit by pitch.

SUGAR LAND TIES: Veteran right-hander Miguel Castro pitched in a total of 27 games with Albuquerque during the 2015 and 2016 seasons ... Space Cowboys outfielder Quincy Hamilton lived in Alamogordo for a decade and played one season of baseball at Alamogordo High School.

SNIFFER. Peoro Lopez enters nis 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID**: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

**CHRIS MICHALAK**: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

**MICHAEL RYAN**: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
