LAST ONE: After punching their playoff ticket with an electric walk-off grand slam from Jorgelys Mota Friday night, the FredNats got another shutout victory last night to guarantee a winning season. Today, in the final game of the regular season, RHP Brayan Romero starts for the second time this week. Today is the final game in the 35-year history of the Carolina Mudcats. Next year, the Wilson Warbirds will begin play as the Brewers affiliate in the North Division. Carolina finishes a 35-year run with two Southern League Championships in 1995 and 2003 as a Pirates and Marlins affiliate. Carolina has been in the Carolina League since 2012.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Angel Feliz hit a two-run home run in the 2nd inning to the right field bullpen, and the FredNats never looked back in a 5-0 shutout of the Mudcats to take this final series of the regular season. R.J. Sales struck out eight in five scoreless innings, and four relievers - Bryan Olson, Andy Luis, Ryan Minckler and Tucker Biven - combined for the shutout. Brenner Cox also had an RBI single for FBG.

FREDNAT MAINSTAYS: Jorgelys Mota and Randal Diaz have been with the FredNats since opening day, and both have had a major impact in this series. On Wednesday, Diaz had the first four-hit game of the year for a FredNat and also hit his first pro home run. He had three of the four RBIs in the game. Mota hit the walk-off grand slam last night to punch the playoff ticket, and has home runs of 418 and 424 feet in the last two games.

GOOD JOB BAZ: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 93, eight ahead of Fayetteville, who is in second place. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB with 59 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 38% of would-be base stealers. In addition to the phenomenal defense Bazzell has played all season, he's now enjoying his best stretch of the year with the bat too, finishing up a month of August in which he hit .333. In his last 10 games, Bazzell is hitting .375 with an .862 OPS.

WOWED BY WILLITS: 17-year-old Eli Willits - the number one overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft - made his professional debut last home stand and has hits in 10 of the first 13 professional games he's played. Overall, Willits is 14-for-47 (.298) with seven walks, five RBI and two stolen bases. Willits, Washington's No. 1 prospect and the 18th best in all of baseball, won't turn 18 until December. He became the youngest FredNat ever, the youngest player in the Carolina League this season, and is currently the second youngest active player in full-season Minor League Baseball. Andrew Salas of the Jupiter Hammerheads is four months younger than Willits. Eli comes from a baseball family, his father Reggie played six seasons in the Major Leagues and is currently the Associate Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma, where his older brother Jaxon is the starting shortshop.

INSTANT IMPACT: The other members of Washington's draft class that are also with Fredericksburg have had exceptional starts to their professional careers. Second-rounder Ethan Petry (South Carolina) has played 23 games with Fredericksburg, and is hitting .291 with an .828 OPS. He hit his second pro home run in last night's game, and he's drawn 13 walks in 22 games as well. Nick Hollifield (UAB) has been a clutch force with the bat for the FredNats. On the last home stand alone, Hollifield had five game-tying RBIs in the 6th inning or later, plus a walk-off single on Sunday against Salem.

START EARLY, HOLD ON LATE: The FredNats are 65-63 overall this season, but are 17 games over .500 (37-20) when scoring first in 2025. The FredNats have also been exceptional at holding on to late-game leads this year. The team is 45-2 when leading after seven innings, and 37-2 when leading after eight.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

MEET HIM: Brayan David Romero...(pronounced: Bryan) was activated from the injured list and returned to Fredericksburg on 6/7 after completing a rehab assignment with the FCL Nationals.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero got ambushed on Tuesday, giving up five runs in an inning and two-thirds. He allowed four hits and walked four in what was his shortest start of the season.

A GUST OF DOMINANCE: After a shaky July, Romero turned in arguably the best month of his career in August. He went 1-0 across four starts with a 2.33 ERA and 19 strikeouts in 19.1 IP. In his first two starts, he did not allow a run over 10 combined innings.

WALK WATCH: Over his last nine starts dating back to 7/6, Romero has walked 37 batters and has walked three or more in each of the nine. The 37 walks in that span are the most by any MiLB pitcher by four over the next highest total.

FIRESTARTER: Romero started game one of the Carolina League Championship series in 2024 at Kannapolis. In an eventual FredNat win, he threw 4.1 innings, giving up three earned runs to the Cannon Ballers.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.

While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.
