APILLION, NEB. – Despite a first inning home run from Nick Pratto, Omaha fell for e fifth straight game to Gwinnett, 5-2, and find themselves in danger of being swept. With two outs in the first and Samad Taylor on second base, Pratto pulled a home run to right field, at the time putting Omaha up 2-0 ... those were the only runs the Storm Chasers could put on the board Saturday afternoon, adding three more hits over the next two innings, before being held silent in the second half of the game. Gwinnett pitching combined to face the minimum from the final out of the third through the end of the game, retiring 18 of the last 19 Omaha batters, allowing just a walk to Maikel Garcia.

- The Chasers' best chance came in the third, as a Taylor double, Garcia single and **Tyler Gentry** walk loaded the bases with one out, but Pratto grounded into a double play to end the inning and Garcia's sixth inning was the only baserunner Omaha had the đ rest of the game

- rest of the game. Starter **Drew Parrish** pitched his longest start of the season, holding the Stripers to two runs (one earned) over 5.0 innings and 89 pitches, while striking out a pair. Just like Friday, Gwinnett jumped ahead when Omaha turned to the bullpen ... **Andrés Núñez** entered the game tied at 2-2 in the sixth and allowed a go-ahead two-run single in the sixth inning that put the Stripers ahead for the rest of the afternoon. Left-hander **Marcelo Martinez** followed Núñez and fired two scoreless innings, including a 1-2-3 seventh, but **Brooks Kriske** allowed a solo homer in the ninth that was the dagger in the day for Omaha as the Chasers went quietly in the bottom of the ninth.

NOTES AND NUGGETS PICK A NICK

The Nick's in the lineup for Omaha this week have had vastly different results at the plate, with **Nick Pratto** leading the run production and **Nick Loftin** struggling mightily.

- Pratic is the only Storm Chasers hitter that has more than one RBI this week, with five runs batted in ... Pratto has hit safely in all four games this week, going 4-for-19 (.211) with one double, his first two homers of the season and a pair of sacrifice flies.
 After being the standout in last week's series in Des Moines, Loftin has gone just
 - 1-for-19 (.053) at the plate this week, with six strikeouts ... his only time on base in the series was a single in the 8th inning Friday, after opening the series 0-for-15. SUPPORTING STARTERS

A lack of run support has been a common theme for Omaha starting pitchers this year, who are receiving an average of 2.22 runs of support per game. ^o Omaha hitters have provided multiple runs of support to their starter in 9 of 18 games this season and won the first 5 of those games but lost have lost the last four

- games, giving their last four starts at least two runs of support. When providing no support or just one run of support, the team is 2-7 ... the team
- has not won a game when providing their starter with 0 runs of support. This week, Omaha starters have combined to allow 10 earned runs in 28.0 innings (3.21 ERA), including quality starts from **Mike Mayers** and **Jonathan Heasley**.

HOMER HAPPY

Omaha's 28 home runs through the first 18 games of this season have combined to account for 45 runs, or 43.3% of the team's total scoring (104 runs scored). Ø 28 homers are tied for the 5th-most of any International League team and tied for

- the 8th-most in all of the Minor Leagues. Logan Porter's 5 home runs lead the team ... his 5 homers in 12 games give him a ø
 - .762 slugging percentage ranks <u>3rd</u> among International League qualified hitters and a 1.150 OPS that ranks <u>6th</u> ... among all Triple-A hitters, he ranks <u>4th</u> in slugging and 10th in OPS
- After not homering on Opening Day (3/31 @ Indianapolis), Omaha hit at least one đ home run in 11 straight games (4/1 to 4/13), the longest streak in the league this year ... the team has homered in 13 of 17 games this season, but 3 of the last 6 games.

SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor has led off all 18 games this season for the Omaha Storm Chasers and gone 24-for-77 at the plate, with 7 extra-base hits and 15 runs batted in.

- He has collected multiple hits in 8 different games this season, including each of the first 4, with hits in 15 of the 18 games, Omaha's longest on-base streak this year. His 24 hits rank <u>7th</u> in the International League, while he ranks <u>tied 3rd</u> with 8 steals and just outside the top 10 in runs batted in (15, T-15th) and total bases (37, T-12th) ... 8 steals are <u>tied 4th</u> in Triple-A as well.

CHARLES IN CHARGE

Facing his former organization, CJ Alexander has made the most of his starts this week.
 Alexander has gone 3-for-10 (.300) at the plate this week with two doubles and a homer, with one double and the homer coming Friday night.

MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
 He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
 Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held
- managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).

- g Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
 - Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
 - Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • #52

- Bijan Rademacher (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
 Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.

- David Noworyta (Nova-REE-tah) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.






