MCINVALE, RYAN EXCEL ON MOUND BUT SEA DOGS WIN IT LATE: After starting pitcher Elvis Luciano was removed from the game after just six pitches due to injury, relievers Andrew McInvale and Sam Ryan combined for six and two-thirds innings of work, giving up just one run and three hits in that timespan. The Sea Dogs scored three runs in the eighth and ninth innings to come away with the win and the series victory, four games to two.

SEA DOG DAYS ARE OVER, FOR NOW: Last series, the Fisher Cats faced the Sea Dogs for the 12th time in their first 18 games, and hold a record of just three wins and nine losses against their New England rivals. The Sea Dogs and Fisher Cats will meet for a whopping 24 more games over the course of this season.

THE STREAKS: Otto López was rested on Sunday, meaning his hit streak still stands at a Double-A Northeast-leading fifteen games....Gabriel Moreno, recently added to *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list, has now reached base in a career-best 13 straight games. Moreno hit his third home run of the season on Sunday to keep the streak alive.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 25, 2014—the Fisher Cats blanked the Sea Dogs 1-0 at Delta Dental Stadium. Kenny Wilson drove in the run with a sixth inning single. Richard Bleier tossed five innings of scoreless relief to earn the win.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Four of the five teams in the Blue Jays organization will be facing the affiliates of the Yankees this week. The Blue Jays open up a series with the Bronx Bombers on Tuesday night after a four-game stretch against the Rays. Dunedin will battle Tampa in a six game home series despite playing at George M. Steinbrenner field, the normal home of the Tarpons. The Bisons will travel to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre without star pitcher Alek Manoah, who has been called up to Toronto to make his first start in the majors against the Yankees. Vancouver will take on the Everett AguaSox (Seattle) in a matchup of two teams with identical 12-6 records.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will close out the season series this week against Somerset, before returning home for their first look at the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets).
