### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Welcome Aboard:** Right-hander Kyle Virbitsky and southpaw Jack Owen joined the Lugnuts today, becoming the 50th and 51st different Lugnuts to suit up this season and the 854th and 855th Lugnuts all-time. Virbitsky was drafted in the 17th round in July from Penn State University, joining third baseman Brett Harris (7th round, Gonzaga) and shortstop Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State) as 2021 draft picks on the Lugnuts' roster. Owen was signed as an undrafted free agent in July from Auburn University. Both Virbitsky and Owen are expected to make their Lugnuts debuts tomorrow afternoon in the series finale.

**Moving On Up:** In addition to the additions of Virbitsky and Owen, Lugnuts left-hander Dalton Sawyer and infielder/outfielder Elvis Peralta, Jr., were each promoted to Double-A Midland before today's game.

**Streak Extended:** William Simoneit went 0-for-4 with a walk yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 15 games.

**Tough Acton:** Reliever Garrett Acton pitched a perfect 9th on Thursday night, striking out two Dragons. In his last three outings, batters are 0-for-11 against him with seven strikeouts. Acton has only allowed one run with Lansing after getting called up from Low-A Stockton, a Micah Pries homer on August 3.

**2021 Alumni Report:** 2021 Lugnuts outfielder Jake Suddleson is currently riding a 15-game on-base streak for the Double-A Midland RockHounds.

**Hoya Saxa:** The Lugnuts have won all seven games in which Jack Cushing has pitched, including both games the Georgetown right-hander pitched at Lake County, Tuesday's opener and Sunday's finale. In just seven appearances, six starts, in the High-A Central, Cushing is already tied for the league lead with six victories. Cushing is scheduled to start again tomorrow night against Dayton.

**All You Need is Glove:** Brett Harris was named the 2021 West Coast Conference Defensive Player (in addition to being honored as First Team All-Conference, leading the Bulldogs with a .355 average, 1.027 OPS, 52 runs, 70 hits and 18 extra-base hits in 52 games, committing only two errors) and Drew Swift was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, the first Sun Devil so honored, and received the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove as the nation's top defensive shortstop. Both were added to the Lugnuts roster yesterday and debuted in the loss.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2016:** It was, unofficially, Canada Day! From catcher Justin Atkinson to pitchers Jordan Romano, Tom Robson and Andrew Case, Canadians played key roles in lifting the Lugnuts to a 4-2 Sunday afternoon victory at West Michigan. The lineup card for the game was delivered to the Canadian Baseball Hall of Fame. Atkinson supplied a two-run single, Lane Thomas had an RBI single and a solo homer, Romano pitched six impressive innings (0 runs, 2 walks, 2 singles, 5 K's), Robson pitched 2 1/3 innings (allowing two runs in the ninth before leaving) and Andrew Case recorded the final two outs in the ninth. The Lugnuts finished the season series with an 11-4 record vs. West Michigan.

**Root, Root, Root for the Home Team:** July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting:** Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 (Baltimore) and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

**Star of Stars:** The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed:** On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs:** On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**International Appeal:** Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Goldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

**So Many Starters:** The Nuts have used 16 different starting pitchers this season, **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Charlie Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

**Three Nuts Go to Washington:** On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**.

**Last Appearance: Started August 8 series finale at LC...** earned the victory with five innings, allowing four 3rd-inning runs, including back-to-back home runs to George Valera and Micah Pries... earned second win in the series... Lugnuts won in a rout, 12-4.

**2021 in Lansing: The Lugnuts have won all seven games in which Cushing has pitched.**

- Debuted in the High-A Central against the Dayton Dragons, July 2, with a dominating performance: 6 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 6 K... allowed only one hit through five scoreless innings before giving up a run in final frame... Lugnuts cruised to 10-3 victory over Dayton.
- Started Game 2 of doubleheader, July 9 at Great Lakes: tossed 7-inning CG, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 9 K on 84 pitches (57 strikes) in Lugnuts' 2-1 win... came four outs from throwing a no-hitter, broken up by Leonel Valera's two-out single in the 6th.
- July 15 vs. Lake County, pitched in relief, piggybacking Shohei Tomioka (4 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and firing the final five innings scorelessly to complete a five-hit 4-0 shutout of the Captains... result was even more impressive considering Captains scored 48 runs in the other four games of the series.
- July 22 at West Michigan: dominated the Whitecaps through five scoreless innings before tiring and allowing two runs in 6th and final inning... fanned eight batters in Nuts' 5-2 victory.
- July 29 vs. Fort Wayne: gave up eight hits and two walks in 5 2/3 innings, with runners constantly on base, yet allowed only three fourth-inning runs while striking out seven... Lugnuts rallied from 3-1 deficit with one in the 7th and four in the 8th against Austin Smith for 6-3 win.

**2021 in the Low-A West:**

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.
- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average.
- Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and one run.
- In June, posted a 4.71 ERA in four starts, with 11 ER in 21 IP, 3 BB, 20 K, .321 avg., though of the four starts, two were poor (4 HR in 5 IP vs. San Jose, June 10; 7 R/4 ER in 4 1/3 IP at Fresno, June 17) and two were outstanding (5.2 IP, 2 R, 8 K vs. Lake Elsinore, June 3; and 6 IP, 1 UER, 0 BB, 4 K at Inland Empire, June 24).
- Handled right-handers: .221/.292/.379... lefties hit .281/.288/.421... of 10 BB, nine were to right-handers.
- Opposing base-stealers were 5-for-7 in success rate.

**Going Pro:** Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Tripp Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' DJ Lee, Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr., and was the scout for 2021 Oakland Athletics draft picks Zack Gelof (2nd round) and Aaron Holiday (13th round).

**2019 Pro Debut:** Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

**Personal:** Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles northwest of Dallas, when he was seven... parents were pilots in the Air Force, and then later pilots for Delta, hence the moves... grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring... Flower Mound is located 28 miles northwest of Dallas, on Grapevine Lake... in his spare time, enjoys hunting, fishing, hiking and going to the beach... currently resides in Jupiter, Florida, where he worked on a golf course during the 2020 hiatus.

**Glory Days:** Attended Marcus High School... named team captain as a senior, going 6-2 with a 0.73 ERA to earn the honor of District 6-6A Pitcher of the Year... was named to the Texas Sports Writer's Association Class 6-A All-State Team and Dallas Morning News All-Area Team... set Marcus H.S. career records in no-hitters and shutouts, ranking second all-time in wins and innings and third in complete games.. played two years on the Marcus H.S. varsity football team.

**Legend in the Family:** Sister Lexi ended her softball career at Middle Tennessee State University (2017-2020) as the Blue Raiders' all-time record holder in home runs (50), RBIs (145), total bases (371), putouts (1500) and sacrifice flies (T-1, 7).

**Hoya Saxa:** Attended Georgetown University, where he set the program's career strikeout record (236) with 11 K's in his final college appearance, 5/17/19 vs. Butler at Shirley Povich Field... set Georgetown's single-game strikeout record with 16 K's vs. Mount St. Mary's, 3/5/19... notched 87 strikeouts total in 79 1/3 innings as a senior in 15 games, 12 starts, leading the Hoyas with a 3.06 ERA... Named All-Big East Second Team, Big East Honor Roll, and Big East All-Academic Team... baseball greats from Georgetown include legendary scout Clyde Sukeforth, Doc White, speedster Art Devlin, and Del Bissonette... the only Hoyas to reach the Majors in the last 50 years: Sean Maloney (1997-98) and Tim Adelman (2016-17).

**Lansing Connection:** Played for 2018 Lugnuts hitting coach (and current Dunedin Blue Jays hitting coach) Matt Young on the Dallas Mustangs... teammates with Zac Cook, currently playing for the Dunedin Blue Jays.
