DES MOINES, IOWA – Despite trailing by four runs after the seventh inning, the Omaha Storm Chasers stirred up a comeback and scored four in the eighth and four in the ninth to come-from-behind and beat the Iowa Cubs, 11-8 on Friday at Principal Park.

- Omaha struck first, scoring two runs in the top of the 1st on a two-run single from **Nick Loftin**, who added one more run in the 5th on a sac fly, at the time for a 3-2 lead.
- Iowa tied the game in the bottom of the 1st inning with a pair of runs, then took a lead in the bottom of the 5th with a pair of RBI singles ... the Cubs added two more runs of insurance in the 6th and one in the 7th for a 7-3 lead heading to the 8th.
- In the top of the 8th, the Chasers immediately began to mount a comeback, as **Freddy Fermin** opened the inning with a double, then **Dairon Blanco** was hit by a pitch.
- Pinch-hitter **Tucker Bradley** came off the bench and drove a two-run double into the gap on the first pitch he saw, then scored from third on an RBI single from **Tyler Gentry** ... with two outs, Gentry scored from second base and tie the game on a dropped fly ball by I-Cubs right fielder **Brennen Davis** that put **Logan Porter** on second.
- Iowa took back the lead in the bottom of the eighth, as **Collin Snider** issued a bases-loaded walk to **Mike Tauchman** to move the score to 8-7.
- Chasers hitters got back to work in the ninth inning, as **CJ Alexander** walked, Fermin reached on another Cubs error and Blanco walked to load the bases for Bradley, who again came through in the clutch and singled home Alexander to tie the game at 8-8.
- Samad Taylor** immediately gave Omaha the lead with a groundout that scored Fermin from third and **Maikel Garcia** doubled in two runs of insurance.
- Nick Wittgren** took over in the bottom of the ninth and allowed a leadoff single, but proceeded to strike out the next three hitters he faced to lock down his first save of the year and finish off the thrilling come-from-behind win.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS

The Storm Chasers have not played a game since their 11-8 come-from-behind win on Friday against the I-Cubs.

- Saturday's game was postponed due to rain, with a doubleheader scheduled for Sunday but both games of Sunday's doubleheader were cancelled due to snow.
- 3 days without playing is the longest stretch (not including *All-Star breaks*) Omaha has gone without playing in modern franchise history (2005-present) ... April 11 and 12, 2019 was the last time Omaha had back-to-back games postponed or cancelled.

SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor has led off all 13 games this season for the Omaha Storm Chasers and gone 19-for-60 at the plate, with 7 extra-base hits and 14 runs batted in.

- Taylor has collected multiple hits in seven different games this season, including each of the first four, with hits in 11 of the 13 games he's played.
- His 19 hits rank tied 6th in the International League, while and 14 runs batted are tied 7th in the league and he ranks tied 11th with 31 total bases.

SLICK NICK

Few hitters for Omaha had a better series last week in Des Moines than third baseman **Nick Loftin**, who enters tonight on a 6-game hitting streak.

- Loftin went 8-for-17 at the plate in four games against the I-Cubs with 2 doubles and 2 home runs, for a team-best 16 total bases last week ... he had the most hits, total bases, homers and runs batted in (7) for an Omaha hitter in the series.
- After recording just three hits in his first four games of the season, Loftin has connected for 10 hits in his last 6 games, a six-game hitting streak since 4/5 ... in that streak, he's hitting .417 (10-for-24) with a 1.298 OPS.

HOMER HAPPY

Omaha's 24 home runs through the first 12 games of this season have combined to account for 40 runs, or 43.0% of the team's total scoring (93 runs scored).

- 24 homers are the 3rd-most of any International League team and tied for the 5th-most in all of the Minor Leagues.
- Logan Porter** and **Nick Loftin**'s 4 home runs lead the Storm Chasers, are tied 10th in the league.
- After not homering on Opening Day (3/31 @ Indianapolis), Omaha hit at least one home run in 11 straight games (4/1 to 4/13), the longest streak in the Minors this year.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Omaha Storm Chasers have consistently battled down the final moments of the game, with 3 comeback wins this season (trailing after the 7th inning).

- Yesterday, the Storm Chasers trailed by four runs at the end of the seventh, but scored 4 in the 8th and 4 in the 9th to win.
- Twice in the season-opening series at Indy (3/31 to 4/2), Omaha came back to win, overcoming a five-run deficit in the first on 3/31 and 3 runs after the 2nd on 4/2.

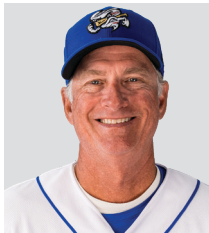

MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHLE • 23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Witheridge during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Witheridge's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • 59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • 52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • 33

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.



STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH: YANNICK PLANTE

- Yannick Plante is entering his third season as the Strength & Conditioning Coach for the Storm Chasers, after being slated to serve in that role with Northwest Arkansas in 2020.
- He began with the Kansas City Organization in 2019 as the athletic trainer for the Burlington Royals (Advanced Rookie, Appalachian League). He was then a staff member of the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League in the fall of 2019.
- Plante has a master's degree in kinesiology from the University of Calgary and a bachelor's degree in human kinetics with specialization in biophysics from the University of Ottawa. He currently lives in Ottawa, Ontario.
