Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies, led by Mike Vasil and Matt Rudick, defeated the New Hampshire Fisher Cats 8-2 on Thursday night on the road. RHP Mike Vasil tossed seven scoreless frames with five strikeouts, while allowing just three hits and two walks. Outfielder Matt Rudick batted leadoff and drove in four runs in a game for the second time this season, highlighted by a three-run homer. Rudick made a diving catch in right field and threw a baserunner out at home plate. Rowdey Jordan and Jose Peroza had multi-hit games and Agustin Ruiz crushed a two-run homer, his third home run of the season. Dariel Gomez had an RBI double.

Masterful Mike: RHP **Mike Vasil** tossed seven scoreless frames last night in New Hampshire. He allowed three hits and two walks, and struckout five batters. Vasil lowered his season ERA to 2.19. The 23-year-old ranks first in the Eastern League and second in all of MiLB in WHIP (0.70). He also ranks first in the Eastern League in opponent batting average (.154), second in strikeouts (46), third in ERA (2.19), and fourth in innings pitched (37.0). Vasil has an outstanding 46-to-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio on the season through seven starts. He earned the first win of his Double-A career last night.

Rudickulous: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** totaled four runs batted in last night, which was his second four-RBI game this season (other was Opening Night at POR). Rudick slugged a three-run homer to get the scoring started and later had an RBI walk. He also made a diving catch and threw a runner out trying to score at home plate. The 24-year-old ranks top five in the Eastern League in seven offensive categories: 2nd in OBP (.450), 3rd in AVG (.308), 3rd in OPS (.988), T-5th in runs (23), T-5th in BB (24), T-5th in RBIs (21), T-5th in doubles (9).

Ponies are Hit Streaking: **Matt Rudick** has upped his hitting streak to six games and has 10 hits in that span with three doubles and two homers. With a multi-hit game yesterday, outfielder **Rowdey Jordan** now has a four-game hitting streak with six hits and two homers in that span. With an RBI double last night, first baseman **Dariel Gomez** extended his hitting streak to four games. He has two doubles and a homer in that span. With a two-run homer last night, outfielder **Agustin Ruiz** extended his hitting streak to three games.

Last Start: Chacin tossed a season-high six innings in his last start against the Yard Goats. He allowed three earned runs on three hits and had four strikeouts with zero walks. He left the start with the Ponies up 7-4. He threw a season-high 75 pitches and 57 strikes.

2022: Began the season with Brooklyn (A+) and made four starts before being assigned to Binghamton (AA) on May 2. Chacin had a strong Double-A debut last year on May 4 at Hartford. He went seven innings and struck-out three batters, while allowing two runs on four hits. Chacin led the Rumble Ponies in innings pitched (101.2) and starts (20) in 2022. He finished third in strikeouts (94) for Binghamton. Chacin pitched to a 4-9 record with a 5.67 ERA at the Double-A level in 23 appearances.

Ponies Field Staff

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization.
