TODAY'S GAME: Looking to avoid a sweep at the hands of the Oklahoma City Comets, the Space Cowboys play their final road game of the 2026 regular season with an afternoon affair at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: LHP Josh Hendrickson delivered a quality start over 7.0 innings, but the Space Cowboys fell 3-2 on Saturday night to Oklahoma City... Sugar Land had runners on the corners in the first and then got a one-out double from Zach Cole in the second but left all three runners on base... Hendrickson retired the first eight batters he faced and allowed his only runs of the night in the third on a two-out double, single and two-run homer... Sugar Land pulled within a run in the fifth when a pair of walks and a hit by pitch loaded up the bases for Pascanel Ferreras, who knocked a two-out single to right... Hendrickson allowed just two more base runners over 7.0 innings, and Sugar Land put the tying run at third in the ninth, but a groundout ended the game and handed the Space Cowboys their fifth-straight defeat.

ROSTER MOVES: 9/12 - RHP Julio Rodriguez reinstated from the Development List... OF Jake Meyers placed on the IL... 9/11 - OF CJ Alexander reinstated from the IL... C Garret Guillemette placed on the Development List... 9/10 - OF Brice Matthews assigned to Sugar Land on ML Rehab... 9/7 - OF Jake Meyers optioned to Sugar Land... C Jason Schiavone promoted to Sugar Land... 9/5 - RHP Miguel Ullola recalled by Houston... RHP Kai-Wei Teng optioned to Sugar Land.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 11 players drafted by Houston, 4 players signed as free agents, 1 international free agents, 4 non-drafted free agents, 3 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 3 players selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features five of the Astros' Top 30 prospects, including C Jason Schiavone (#6), RHP Bryce Mayer (#8), OF Lucas Spence (#12), RHP Jackson Nezu (#16) and RHP Alimber Santa (#17).

COLE TRAIN: Despite having his six-game hitting streak and five game RBI streak snapped on Wednesday afternoon, OF Zach Cole has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 games, including recording an extra-base hits in eight of his last 13 contests and homering in four of his last eight start... Over his last 13 games (since August 28), Cole is slashing .280/.345/.620/.965 (14-for-50) with five doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, nine runs scored, five walks and two stolen bases.

EL PASCI: INF Pascanel Ferreras pushed his on-base streak to 10 games on Saturday night, going 1-for-4 with two RBI... Over his last 10 games, Ferreras is slashing .341/.400/.561/.961 (14-for-41) with three doubles, two home runs, four RBI, seven runs scored and three walks... Ferreras has hit safely in seven of his last 10 games, including multi-hit efforts in five of them.... Since his promotion to Sugar Land on June 2, Ferreras is tied for seventh among qualified hitters in the PCL in average (.317) and is third in doubles (22).

STREAKING SPENCE: OF Lucas Spence extended his on-base streak to 11 games on Saturday night, working a walk in the fifth inning... This came after Spence recorded his second multi-homer game of the season on Friday night, going 3-for-4 with two home runs and a career-high five RBI... The Astros' No. 12 prospect has homered in three of his last six games and drawn a walk in five of his nine September starts... Over his last 11 games, Spence is slashing .294/.429/.794/1.223 (10-for-34) with two doubles, five homers, 10 RBI, nine runs scored, two stolen bases and eight walks against eight strikeouts.

CENTURY MARK: INF/OF Cavan Biggio worked his 102nd and 103rd walk of the season on Friday, continuing to add to his new minor league career high in free passes (previous - 100, New Hampshire, 2018)... He is also just two walks shy of tying his career high of 105 between Triple-A Buffalo and Toronto in 2019... Biggio joined the Comets James Tibbs III (105) as the first players in the PCL to work at least 100 walks in a season since OF Joc Peterson with Albuquerque in 2014 (100).

SEEKING 30-30: Recently promoted C Jason Schiavone has 31 total home runs and 29 total stolen bases between High-A Asheville and Double-A Corpus Christi this season... The Astros' No. 6 prospect is looking to become the first player in Minor League Baseball this season to achieve a 30/30 season and just the ninth player since 2005 to reach 30/30 (last - Trey Cabbage and Weston Wilson, 2023)... The last Astros' prospect to reach a 30/30 season was OF Kyle Tucker in 2019 with Round Rock (34 HR / 30 SB), while OF George Springer also had a 30/30 season in 2013 (37 HR / 45 SB between Corpus Christi and Oklahoma City)... Per Baseball Reference, Schiavone would be just the second catcher since 1946 to have a 30/30 season, joining Willie Royster of the Charlotte O's in 1981 (31 HR / 53 SB).

PERTH POWER: LHP Josh Hendrickson fired 7.0 quality innings on Saturday night for Sugar Land, allowing three runs on five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts... It tied Hendrickson's career-high for innings pitched in a contest, and was the sixth time a Space Cowboys' starter has gone 7.0 frames this year (last - RHP Ryan Weiss, July 25 vs. Nashville)... Saturday was the first quality start for a Space Cowboys' starter since RHP Bryce Mayer fired 6.0 one-run innings on August 15 and was the first quality start for Hendrickson since July 21 vs. Nashville.

TRYING TO KEEP THE BROOMS IN THE CLOSET: Sugar Land is looking to avoid a series sweep on Sunday against OKC... The Space Cowboys have only been swept by OKC once, in a three-game series at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark from June 7 - 9, 2022... Sugar Land was last swept in a six-game series in Sacramento from August 5 - 10, 2025.

HISTORIC TENTH: In the 10th inning on 8/7 @ ABQ, Sugar Land erupted for 11 runs as part of an 18-10 victory... It marked just the second 10-plus-run inning in franchise history, joining a 17-run sixth inning against Oklahoma City on Aug. 19, 2022, while falling one run shy of the PCL record for runs in a single extra inning.

WHY NOT A WALK OFF?: Trenton Brooks delivered yet another walk-off victory for the Space Cowboys on 8/21, a 4-3 win in 10 innings over Oklahoma City... It was Sugar Land's 13th walk off of the season, tied for the second most walk offs in Minor League Baseball in 2026 (Charleston - 14) and the most in a single season in Space Cowboys history, surpassing the 10 Sugar Land collected in 2024.

STRIKKKKKKKKKKKKKE 'EM OUT: Space Cowboys hurlers struck out at least 13 batters in seven-consecutive games from 7/26 - 8/2, totaling 100 strikeouts in that stretch, the most in MiLB (next, Brooklyn - 86)... It is the first time in franchise history the Space Cowboys have struck out at least 13 batters in seven-straight contest (previous, 3G, 3X, last, 8/23 - 25/24) and the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 13 strikeouts in MiLB this season (previous, Inland Empire, 6G, 4/7 - 12).

EXTRA, EXTRA!: A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

LAST OUTING: Started on 9/8 @ OKC (Tuesday), spinning 3.1 innings while allowing five hits and two runs and striking out seven... Did not allow a run over his first 3.0 innings and gave up his only runs on a two-RBI single in the fourth... Took the loss in a 7-4 Space Cowboys defeat... His seven strikeouts are a season high and were his most in a game since May 18, 2021, when he struck out eight for Amarillo against Midland.

VS. OKC: Is slated to make his sixth appearance against the Comets of the season, going 0-2 with a 7.50 ERA in 12.0 IP with 7 walks and 18 strikeouts this year... Will be his 10th career outing against OKC, going 0-2 with a 7.13 ERA in his career across 17.2 IP with 11 walks and 24 strikeouts.

PICK 'EM UP: Threw in relief on 8/12 @ RR, entering in the third with the bases and two outs and left them stranded... Went on to fire 3.1 scoreless innings to earn the victory in a 10-2 Sugar Land win, the 600th of manager Mickey Storey's career.

HISTORIC START: Tossed the first complete game shutout in Space Cowboy history on 7/25 vs. NAS in game one of the double header...Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings only allowing one hit while walking and striking out three...Allowed the only hit of the night with two outs in the sixth inning... It was the first complete game shutout of Weiss' professional career.

WITH HOUSTON ('26): Made 9 outings, 2 starts, going 0-3, 7.62 ERA, 26.0 IP, 35 H, 24 R, 22 ER, 20 BB, 30 K

ACQUIRED: Signed by Houston as a Major League Free Agent on December 9, 2025.

2025: Pitched for the Hanwha Eagles of the KBO... Went 16-5, 2.87 ERA, 30 G, 30 GS, 178.2 IP, 127 H, 63 R, 57 ER, 56 BB, 207 K.
