Baseball in Education Day: Today's game marks the 18th annual Baseball in Education Day at Mirabito Stadium. Twelve local schools from around the Southern Tier will be represented at today's game with nearly 1,000 students in attendance. The Rumble Ponies will host another BIE Day on Tuesday, May 23 against Richmond.

JT Smoove: With his second home run of the series on Friday, **JT Schwartz** now leads the Eastern League with 15 RBIs this season. Schwartz is on a six-game hitting streak and has recorded four multi-hit games and three three-RBI games this year. The former fourth-round pick has 14 hits, seven extra base hits, five doubles, two home runs, seven runs, and five walks in 13 games this season.

Bullies in the Pen: The Rumble Ponies bullpen has been electric over the last four games. **Dedniel Núñez, Nate Lavender** (2 APP), **Sammy Tavaréz, Hunter Parsons, Marcel Rentería, William Woods, and Kolby Kubichek** have combined to throw 14 scoreless frames in relief with 14 strikeouts. Lavender has two saves in the series, including a seven-pitch ninth inning with two strikeouts in Friday's game at Hartford. Núñez, Tavaréz, and Kubichek all threw three scoreless innings with nine combined strikeouts in their outings.

Series Winners: Binghamton claimed its first series win of the season at Hartford last week, winning three out of five games with the series finale being postponed. The Rumble Ponies won their first series of 2022 in the final week of May.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.
