#### RIDERS FALL IN FINALE TO HOOKS:

Sebastian Walcott stole home in the eighth inning to give the Frisco RoughRiders a 3-2 win over the San Antonio Missions on Tuesday night from Riders Field. Frisco (25-27, 63-57) jumped out in front first in the bottom of the second inning when Jax Biggers tripled in a run and Ian Moller then plated Biggers on an RBI groundout to make it 2-0. The Missions (19-33, 58-63) then tied the game in the top of the fourth on a two-run single by Marcos Castoñon, knotting it at 2-2. That score held until Walcott walked on a nine-pitch at-bat in the eighth, advanced to third on a Keith Jones II single and stole home when catcher Anthony Villar tried to back-pick him at third, pushing the Riders ahead 3-2. Gerardo Carrillo then locked down his sixth save of the season with a scoreless ninth inning. Emiliano Teodo (1-0) earned the win for the Riders with a scoreless eighth and Ethan Routzahn (1-4) was handed the loss, surrendering the run in the eighth.

#### CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS TO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:

The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from Cam Cauley against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on Wednesday, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742. He was placed on the 7-Day Injued List, retroactive to August 22nd.

#### WIN, WIN AND WIN SOME MORE:

The Riders have won 10 of their last 14 games and 13 of their last 18 games. During their last 14 games, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a 3.95 ERA as a staff allowing just four home runs. In the 18-game stretch, they are second in the league with a 3.34 ERA with a league-best 13-5 record.

#### THAT'S ZA-BALLGAME:

Aaron Zavala walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on August 15th for his first walk-off homer with Frisco and second walk-off hit. In his last 17 games, he is hitting .246 (16-for-65)/.315/.446/.761 with seven doubles, two home runs, 13 RBIs, five walks, 10 runs scored and two steals.

#### ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of Trey Supak and Ben Anderson and the trade of Mitch Bratt, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (Josh Stephan). In 22 August games, Frisco has a 3.30 ERA for starters which is second in the league. Jose Corniell (15.2 IP, 0 ER), Leandro Lopez (18.2 IP, 5 ER) and David Davalillo (43.0 IP, 11 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

#### THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.983) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (71). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .985 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They snapped a string of 10-straight games without an error on Friday (they were 8-2 in those games), the longest such streak in the Texas League this season.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by Guilder Rodriguez. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 32 steals over 123 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

#### **2025 SEASON**

-Dominated in May, going 1-2 over four starts with a 1.61 ERA. Over 22.1 IP, he allowed 15 hits while surrendering six runs (four earned) and walking four to 23 strikeouts.
