**NORTH LITTLE ROCK, AR** – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals drew four walks, but were unable to collect a hit, no-hit for the second time in franchise history by the Arkansas Travelers, 6-0 Friday night.

- Friday night marked the second time Northwest Arkansas had been no-hit, the first being May 17, 2016 by the Arkansas Travelers as well, though in that game the Naturals only drew one walk against *Jordan Kipper*.
- Right-hander *Prelander Berroa* struck out 11 Naturals over 5.0 innings and was followed by single innings from *Blake Weiman*, *Jake Haberer*, *Rob Kaminsky* and *Braden Shipley*.
- Left fielder *Tyler Gentry* drew two of the four walks, getting on base in the first and ninth innings. *Angelo Castellano* walked in the third, while *Robbie Glendinning* drew a base-on-balls in the seventh inning.
- Naturals starting pitcher *Dante Biasi* took his fourth loss of the season, allowing just two runs on two hits over 4.0 innings while walking four.
- Asa Lacy*, *Nate Webb* and *Kasey Kalich* combined for 4.0 innings of relief behind Biasi, allowing four runs on five hits with three walks.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 6-5 all-time when playing on August 13

On August 13, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the San Antonio Missions, 9-7 in 11 innings at Nelson Wolff Stadium. Second baseman **Corey Toups** opened up the game with a home run on the second pitch of the game, his second of three leadoff homers in 2016. **Mauricio Ramos** doubled in two and **Logan Moon** doubled in one to cap a four-run first inning, then the Naturals added three more runs in the second inning to jump out to a 7-0 lead. San Antonio scored runs in the fourth and sixth, then added five in the seventh to tie the game and force extra innings. Neither team scored in the 10th inning, then Ramos walked and **Zane Evans** singled to open the 11th. **Jack López** reached on a sacrifice bunt that scored pinch-runner **Humberto Arteaga** and Evans came around from second on an errant pickoff throw as a run of insurance in the win.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 4 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means and John Rave.**

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 34-8, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-53.
- The Naturals are 31-13 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-47.
- The Naturals are 41-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-47 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 28-20, whereas 15-40 when the opponent scores first.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 5-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 61 losses (27.86%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 20 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

**Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 105 games, the Naturals have stolen 136 bases in 169 attempts (average 1.30 steals/game, 80.47% success rate).

- 136 steals leads the Texas League, ranks sixth in Double-A and 28th in the Minors ... the team's collective 80.84% success rate ranks 27th among the 120 full-season MiLB teams.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 69 of 105 games this season (65.71%), including 34 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 17 times, meaning 34 of 136 steals this year (25.00%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- **Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fourth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks seventh in the league.

**TUCK(ER) AND ROLL**

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 74 of 90 games this season (82.22%) and reached base multiple times on 48 occasions, which ranks second on the Naturals behind Logan Porter's 49 ... he has hits in 64 of 90 games and has a team-best 28 multi-hit games, as well as 13 multi-run games and nine multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .306 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters, ranks seventh in the Texas League and third among Kansas City's minor league hitters ... his .389 on-base percentage also ranks third in the system, while 99 hits are tied third, 18 doubles are tied sixth, 57 runs scored and 144 total bases rank tied eighth and his .833 OPS is ninth,
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 22 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .315 hitter (28-for-89) with a .419 on-base percentage and .840 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .217 (27-for-85) with a .402 on-base percentage.

**TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)**

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- *Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks SIXTH in batting average (.328)* when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.328) and OPS (.974), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.425) and slugging percentage (.549) ... his 16 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied fifth in the system, while 61 runs batted in are sixth.
- Gentry has reached base in 39 of 44 games (88.64%) and has hits in 30 of his 44 games with the Naturals, with already 17 multi-hit games.
- In 44 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .321 (53-for-165) with nine doubles, 11 home runs and 38 runs batted in and a .993 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 20 of 42 games, with 10 multi-RBI games ... he leads the Naturals in nearly every category since then, with the highest average (.321), most total bases (95) and most runs batted in on the team (38) ... his 38 RBIs are tied for the most in the Texas League since then and the .993 OPS ranks third since his arrival in the circuit.
- Gentry's 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

**ALEXANDER THE GREAT**

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- Over 22 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .253 (23-for-91) with 10 extra-base hits (seven home runs) and 23 runs batted in, with 13 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 14 of 22 games with the Naturals, nine of which are two-hit performances, with hits in the first eight games this month ... he's driven in runs in 8 of 22, including already SIX multi-RBI games.
- In the month of August, Alexander is hitting .316 (12-for-38) with seven extra base hits (six home runs) and 15 runs batted in ... 31 total bases, 6 homers and 15 RBI all lead the Texas League this month
- In last week's series against Tulsa, CJ homered in four straight games, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.
- Alexander began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

**ROCKIN' ROBBIE**

After slumping for much of June, first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July into August.

- Glendinning's 65 runs batted in this season rank seventh in the Texas League ... his 64 runs scored are tied for the sixth-most in the Texas League, 160 total bases and 37 extra-base hits are tied 10th.
- He has reached base in 79 of 89 games he's played this season (88.76%), reaching multiple times in 41 games this season ... he has hits in 58 of 89 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
- Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he is third in the system with 37 extra-base hits and 64 runs scored and tied third in the system with 19 doubles, 17 home runs, 65 runs batted in, fourth with 160 total bases ... his .479 slugging percentage and .845 OPS rank as the seventh-best in the organization, while his .366 on-base percentage ranks ninth and .263 batting average is 10th.

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

**May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (3)**

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

## #24 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.



## DANNY ACCOLA • CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
