FIRST HALF STANDINGS WATCH: The FredNats currently pace not only the North Division, but the entire Carolina League at 39-16 overall. The FredNats currently lead the North Division by 10 games over Wilson. The FredNats are yet to see the Warbirds this season, and will not see them until early in the second half on June 23. The magic number for the FredNats' first-half clinch is two.

BACK AT IT: The FredNats' was snapped Thursday at seven games, tying a season high. The FredNats now look to bounce back, with clinching possible with help from Salem.

CLINCHING SCENARIOS: With the FredNats' magic number down to two, they can now clinch with help tonight. With a win and a Wilson loss to Salem at home, the FredNats would clinch a first-half title in the Carolina League's North Division, securing a playoff spot in September and winning a first-half title for the first time since 2018.

WEEKEND WARRIORS: The FredNats continue to be one of the best teams in the Carolina League this season on weekends, with a 15-3 record on Saturdays and Sundays this year. The FredNats have closed series especially well over the most recent stretch, having not lost a weekend game since May 2 against Hickory.

DO I KNOW YOU?: The FredNats have are facing Hill City for a third series of the season this week, the most games against any opponent yet this year. Hill City is responsible for the FredNats only loss, taking the final three games of the first series at City Stadium to down the FredNats 4-2, before Fredericksburg reversed course with a 4-2 series win over Hill City in their second series with the newly-named Howlers. Frequent opponents throughout their history, Hill City (then Lynchburg) ended the FredNats season last year with a sweep.

A RECORD BREAKING FIRST HALF: This year's FredNat team has put together one of the most memorable first halves in team history. Picking up their 36th win last Saturday, the 2026 FredNats have now set the Franchise record for first half wins since moving to Fredericksburg, when the Carolina League changed to its current 132-game schedule. The overall record for the franchise across all previous stops is still within reach, as the Alexandria Dukes went 45-20 in 1982's first half. The FredNats now seek to win a first-half title for the first time since Potomac's first-half championship in 2018.

HEART POUNDING ACTION: Some of the FredNats' most exciting games of the season have come against Hill City. Overall, nine games have been tied or featured a lead change in the seventh inning or later, and the season series has featured six game winning ninth innings, including three walk-offs (two for Hill City, one for Fredericksburg).

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The FredNats have been the top team at home in the Carolina League this year, holding a 19-6 record in FXBG. The FredNats also got off to one of their best starts overall and at home this season, beginning the year 12-1 at home.

DAYLIGHT: After a 1-2 start during the day, the FredNats are currently riding an 11 game win streak in day games this season.

ABOUT LAST YEAR: The FredNats finished last season at 65-64 overall, winning the North division's second half title to advance to the playoffs for the second straight year. The FredNats' season ended in a 2-0 series loss to Hill City in the Division Series.

UP TO OUR ARMPITS IN PROSPECTS: The Fredericksburg roster is loaded with some of the top talent in the revamped Nationals organization, headlined by Washington's top prospect Eli Willits, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft. Willits is ranked as baseball's 9th-best prospect overall by MLB Pipeline. Overall, the FredNats opened the season with seven prospects ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 20 Nationals prospects.

FREDNATS BASEBALL NETWORK IS BACK: Once again, all 132 FredNat games this season will be broadcast live on the FredNats Baseball Network, with Luke West Poley and Adam Gotkin beginning their first seasons calling the action in Fredericksburg. Home games are broadcast on MiLB.tv and the Bally Sports Live App to go along with the audio-only stream at frednats.com/broadcast or the MiLB App. For road games, the radio broadcast is available at the same link. In addition, all FredNats games preceded by a 20 minute pregame show and postgame coverage following each night of action.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia... the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Potomac Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and winning the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. The franchise has appeared in the Carolina League playoffs in three out of the last four seasons.

Chris O'Neill - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Hitting Coach/Recruiting Coordinator, Virginia Commonwealth University

O'Neill, 36, joins the Nationals organization after two seasons (2024-25) as a hitting coach/recruiting coordinator at Virginia Commonwealth University. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at George Washington from 2022-24.

O'Neill is credited with helping fuel major offensive surges at both VCU and George Washington, as both schools set offensive records and contended for Atlantic 10 championships under his watch. O'Neill spent the 2021 season as the director of operations at Duke University and prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at Bucknell University (2020), Marshall University (2018-19) and the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore (2017).

This season will be O'Neill's first time managing since he led the Grand Lake Mariners (Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League) in the summers of 2016 and 2017. A Pennsylvania native, he received his Bachelor's degree in Education from King's College in 2012. O'Neill and his wife Kate have two boys, Easton and Callum.



Luke Dziados - PITCHING COACH

1st Season | Previously: Pitching Trainer - Driveline Baseball (Tampa, Fla.)

Dziados (D-Zay-Dis), 27, comes to the Nationals organization after spending the last two years as a pitching trainer at Driveline Baseball in Tampa, Fla. He capped his college pitching career at Villanova University in 2023 after pitching at Binghamton University from 2018-20. Dziados earned his Bachelor's degree from Binghamton in 2021 and also earned a Graduate Certificate in Leadership from Villanova in 2023.



Jake Scheiner - HITTING COACH

Scheiner, 30, played seven seasons (2017-23) in the Phillies and Mariners organizations. He appeared in 658 Minor League games before signing in 2024 with Hiroshima Toyo Carp of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan. A native of San Mateo, Calif., Scheiner was drafted in the fourth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Houston.

Villanueva, 24, was a performance coach at LAVR Performance where he designed and led throwing programs to improve overall pitching performance for more than 50 athletes prior to joining Washington's coaching ranks. Anthony Ray - DEFENSIVE COACH

FredNats Career:

Jacob Young played for the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2021 and 2022. The FredNats were his first stint in professional baseball, after being drafted by the Washington Nationals in the 7th round in 2021 out of the University of Florida. In his two seasons, Young slashed .253/.347/.320. In 2022, the centerfielder led the FredNats in hits, runs scored, and stolen bases. His 2022 year filled the record books. Young played in 115 games, accumulating 122 hits, both Frednats single-season records. He also scored 118 runs that season, which were the most in Single-A and tied for the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

Current Success:

Young, now in his fourth year in the big leagues, is having the best start of his career. On top of being one of the top defensive outfielders in Major League Baseball, the 26-year-old has hit for record power. After just five home runs across his first three years in the Majors, Young has already hit eight home runs this year, in less than 60 games. His OPS has risen by almost 100 points, making Young a near average MLB hitter. With his incredible fielding prowess, Young has become one of the most relied upon players for the Washington Nationals

- Robert Liam Sullivan...returns for fourth year in Fredericksburg after being assigned from High-A Wilmington on April 20. Selected in the 13th round, 375th overall by Washington in the 2023 MLB Draft from the University of Georgia.
- Made two starts for High-A Wilmington to start the season, allow 4 ER in 6 IP (6.00 ERA), allowed 2 HR.
- Started seven games for the FredNats last season, 3.23 ERA and a 1.11 WHIP, also started seven games and made one bullpen appearance in the FCL, starting with a 1.35 ERA and 1.05 WHIP.
- Started two games for Fredericksburg in 2024 before going on the full-season injured list. Also pitched six times post-draft in 2023 with the FredNats and once in the FCL, carrying a 4.96 ERA across both levels.
- Played three seasons at Georgia, putting up a career-best 3.99 ERA as a true freshman. Also starred for the Harwich Mariners of the Cape Cod League in 2022, holding a 2.17 ERA in eight appearances with five starts.
- Brother Patrick played four seasons as a first baseman at Georgia and later spent time on Kansas State's baseball staff.
- Product of the Marist School in Atlanta, the same high school as Inside the NBA's Ernie Johnson and Los Angeles Rams Head Coach Sean McVay.
