LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn rallied to earn its 5th walk-off win of the season in a 5-4 victory vs. Asheville in 10 innings on Sunday...SS Boston Baro delivered the game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th...The Cyclones tied the game in the 9th on a CF Carson Benge RBI ground out to 2nd and 3B Jesús Báez's game-tying single to center with 2 outs and 2 strikes...Down 4-2, Brooklyn turned a 4-3-5 triple play to end the top of the 9th...The Cyclones started the 10th with a double play when 1B Oliver Carrillo flied out to left and SS Drew Vogel was thrown out trying to tag-up to 3rd base...LHP Sean Manaea made a Major League rehab start and allowed 4 runs on 5 hits in 2.1 ninings...RHP Brian Metoyer (0.2 IP), RHP R.J. Gordon (4.2), LHP Ryan Ammons (0.1), and RHP Ben Simon (2.0) combined for 7.2 innings of 4-hit shutout relief, striking out 11.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are in a 2-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds a 0.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division with 3 games remaining in the first half...Hudson Valley was eliminated with their loss and Brooklyn's win on Sunday...The Cyclones' magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 3...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half... Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

GIRT 'ER DONE: After tossing 5.0 perfect innings in Saturday's 1-0 win vs. Asheville, RHP Brendan Girton was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for Week 12 (June 10-15)...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to receive a weekly honor this year and the first to win Pitcher of the Week since LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home the award for May 20-26, 2024...Girton is the first Cyclones' right-hander to earn the honor since RHP Luis Moreno won For July 25-31, 2022...Girton did not receive a decision on Saturday, but retired all 15 batters he faced, striking out 6...He, RHP Joel Diaz (3.0 IP), and RHP Raimon Gómez (1.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout...Since May 1, the Gage, Okla., native leads the South Atlantic League in batting average against (169) and is 4th in ERA (2.36) and WHIP (0.96)...Among pitchers with 45.0 or more innings, Girton is tied for 8th in the SAL in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.68) and 9th in ERA (2.91).

THRICE IS NICE: The Cyclones completed the 2nd triple play in franchise history in the top of the 9th inning in Sunday's comeback win vs. Asheville...Tourists SS Drew Vogel hit into a 4-3-5 triple play...2B Marco Vargas fielded the ball behind second, stepped on the bag, and threw to 1B Jacob Reimer for a double play...Reimer then threw across the diamond where 3B Jesús Báez tagged out CF Lucas Spence, who over slid the bag, for the triple play...It marked Brooklyn's first triple-killing since July 10, 2016, on a 2-6-4 triple play from C Dan Rizzie, to SS Colby Woodmansee, to 2B Nick Sergaskis...1B Pete Alonso was on the field for the 1st triple play in franchise history...Brooklyn then turned a double play to start the 10th inning, as 1B Oliver Carrillo flied out to left and Vogel was tagged out trying to advance to 3rd...RHP Ben Simon recorded 6 outs by facing only 3 batters...It is the only known occurrence of a reliever recording at least 6 outs and facing 3 or fewer batters in MLB's StatCast Era (2015-present).

ROSTER MOVES: On Monday, the Cyclones made a series of roster moves...RHPs Brett and Hoss Brewer joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie...In a corresponding move, RHP Vega was transferred to Single-A St. Lucie...Brooklyn's active roster is at a full 30 players.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: SS Boston Baro delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off win of the season with a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in a 5-4 win vs. Asheville on Sunday...It marked the 3rd straight Sunday home game that ended with a walk-off win...C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in a 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen on June 1...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On May 18, DH Ronald Hernandez came through with an RBI fielder's choice to walk-off Winston-Salem, 7-6, in 10 innings.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn's pitching staff collected its 7th shutout of the season with a 1-0 win vs. Asheville on Saturday...The 1-0 triumph was the Cyclones' 2nd since last Thursday, doing the same on June 5 at Wilmington...Entering Tuesday, Brooklyn is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in shutouts with New York-AL's Hudson Valley...The 7 shutouts are tied for 2nd most at High-A and the 8th most in Minor League Baseball...Kansas City's High-A Quad Cities (9) leads the level, and Detroit's Double-A Erie, Milwaukee's Triple-A Nashville, and Toronto's Double-A New Hampshire (10) are tied for the Mil.B leads...Brooklyn's single-season record for shutouts is 14, set in 2024.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 5 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision on June 4 at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.72 ERA (2 ER in 25.0 IP) with 13 hits allowed, 9 walks, and 26 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in Tuesday's win over Asheville...The southpaw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs last Tuesday vs. Asheville...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.72) and batting average against (.149), is tied for 1st in wins (4), and 3rd in WHIP (0.88).

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save last Thursday night in Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Tuesday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.56) and 8th in batting average against (.211).

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez is tied for the South Atlantic League in RBI (29) with OF Carson Benge...He is also 4th in on-base percentage (.401) and OPS (.876), and 9th in slugging percentage (.475)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history.

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn has been a model of consistency at Maimonides Park this year.. Thursday's defeat vs. Asheville marked the end of the Cyclones' 15-game home winning streak.. Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 26-7 (.788)...Greenville is second best (21-13)...The 26 home wins are the 3rd most home wins in all of Mil.B...The Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas leads the minors (28)...Brooklyn's .786 home winning percentage is the best in Mil.B...Pittsburgh's Triple-A Indianapolis (.750) is 2nd.

vs. ABERDEEN: After taking 4-of-6 at home against Asheville, Brooklyn hits the road for the final 3 games of the first half and the opening 3 games of the second half...Aberdeen dropping 3-of-5 from Jersey Shore...Sunday's series finale was canceled due to unplayable field conditions...The IronBirds are 10-17 at Ripken Stadium this season...Brooklyn took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in Maryland from April 15-20 and lead the season series, 10-2...The IronBirds boast X of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Vance Honeycutt (4), INF Griff O'Ferrall (6), RHP Michael Forret (7), LHP Luis De León (13), INF Aron Estrada (16), C Ethan Anderson (17), INF Leandro Arias (21), and OF Austin Overn (30)...Anderson is currently on the injured list...In 275 meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 147-128 (.535)...Brooklyn is 69-57 (.548) against the IronBirds in 126 games at Ripken Stadium.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Saúl García has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering Sunday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP Jack Snyder for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 17.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.41)...That total is also the best mark in all of High-A...It is also the 6th-best in Minor League Baseball...Los Angeles-NL's High-A Great Lakes RHP Alex Makarewich (18.45) is 1st...Following that same qualifier, García is also 2nd in the SAL in hits-per-9-innings (3.18) and batting average against (.111), and is tied for 9th in ERA (1.59).

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 63 games of the 2025 season with Sunday's walk-off win vs. Asheville, earning the series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 11 series of the year, the Cyclones hold an 8-0-3 record... In home series, Brooklyn is 5-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 10-0-3 in a series of any length...Additionally, the Cyclones' 43-20 record is the franchise's best record through 63 games since their inaugural season in 2001...The 43 wins are tied for the 3rd most in Minor League Baseball and are 3 behind Philadelphia's Triple-A Lehigh Valley (46) for 1st.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer has had a fabulous start to the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Reimer leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (48) and is tied for the lead in doubles (17)...The Yucapia, Callif, native is 2nd in slugging percentage (.529) and doubles (17), tied for 2nd in triples (4) and extra-base hits (29), 3rd in total bases (110), OPS (925), and hits (60), 4th in RBI (39), 6th in batting average (.293), and Dits (101) in on-base percentage (.396)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday leading the South Atlantic League in doubles (18)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (46) and hits (62), tied for 2nd in triples (4), 4th in batting average (.304), OPS (.906), and extra-base hits (26), 5th in on-base percentage (.416), total bases (100), and slugging percentage (.490), tied for 5th in walks (36), and tied for 6th in RBI (37)...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on Milb.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (45), tied for 3rd in triples (7), and 8th in on-base percentage (.447)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (31), registering 7 more than anyone else...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.420), tied for 3rd in triples (3), and 4th in batting average (.308), walks (27), and hits (45)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in OPS (.838)...The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen base...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-66, 2024.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 143 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (156)...The 143 steals are 7th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MilB (185)...Brooklyn already has 6 players with 10-or-more steals on the season and 9 players with 5-plus...The 143 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 63 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 48 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 95...The Cyclones are 38 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 17, 2014, RHP Corey Oswalt tossed 6.0 innings of 3-hit shutout ball, earning the win, in Brooklyn's 5-1 win vs. Hudson Valley...In 2016, the Cyclones and Staten Island Yankees play a 20-inning marathon on Opening Day ending with Staten Island holding on for a 3-2 victory...The game on Coney Island lasts 5 hours and 39 minutes...In 2018, LF Wagner Lagrange delivered the go-ahead RBI single in the 8th, as Brooklyn won 4-2 at Staten Island...In 2023, RHP Blade Tidwell twirled 7.0 innings of 3-hit ball, not allowing a run, in the Cyclones' 5-0 win at Aberdeen...RHP Dylan Tebrake posts 2.0 innings of scoreless relief to complete th 4-hit shutout...C Drake Osborn powered a pair of home runs in the win.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (11), INF Boston Baro (12), INF Marco Vargas (13), INF Jacob Reimer (17), RHP Nate Dohm (18), C Chris Suero (20), OF Eli Serrano III (21) and C Ronald Hernández (25), OF A.J. Ewing (26), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

PROSPECT RADAR: Santucci is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 12 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 18 by *Baseball America* in 2025...He is also ranked the Mets' No. 15 farmhand by SNY's **Joe DeMayo...**Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

SPRING BREAKOUT: Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** during the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.
