SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

BASEBALL IN THE MORNING: Today's game marks the final morning game in a stretch that has seen the Shuckers play a morning game on five straight Wednesdays... Over that span, the Shuckers are 2-2 during Wednesday morning games, including a 6-0 shutout last Wednesday against the Rocket City Trash Pandas... After today, the Shuckers will play their final morning game of the season on June 21, 2023 against the Chattanooga Lookouts.

BOMBS AWAY!: C Jeferson Quero tied the Shuckers single-game record with a career-high three home runs on Tuesday night against the Lookouts... It marked the first time a Shuckers player had smashed three in a game since Wes Clarke did so on September 10, 2022 against the Mississippi Braves, and the fifth time in franchise history (since 2015) that a Shuckers player had hit three in the game... The night was also Quero's first multi-home run game and set a new career high with five RBI... Quero's six home runs are now the second-most by any catcher in Double-A, trailing C Henry Davis of the Altoona Curve, who has eight.

SWIPER, YES, SWIPING: Entering today, the Shuckers are third in Double-A with 70 stolen bases this season, trailing the Portland Sea Dogs (BOS) and Somerset Patriots (NYY)... The Shuckers set the franchise record with 162 stolen bases in 2022, but are on pace to shatter the mark in 2023... As of today, the Shuckers are on pace to steal 284 bases, which would be the most by any team in the Southern League since at least 2005... INF Tyler Black also enters today with 19 stolen bases to lead the league.

BEST IN THE SYSTEM: With MLB Pipeline updating their prospect rankings this past weekend, the Shuckers' roster now includes nine of the Top 30 prospects in the Brewers system... The nine players are the most on any team in the Brewers system... The Shuckers roster includes four Top-10 prospect and six within the Top-20... OF Jackson Chourio currently ranks as the top overall prospect by Baseball America and the second-best by MLB Pipeline.

MOVING TOWARDS HISTORY: Shuckers manager Mike Guerrero enters today needing 10 more wins to reach 1,400 in his managerial career... Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero also led the Shuckers to a franchise-best 82 wins during the 2019 season, a year after he led the Shuckers to a then-record 81 wins.

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP ADAM SEMINARIS [2-3, 6.59]: LHP Adam Seminaris turned in the best start of his Shuckers career last time out against Rocket City... The left-handed arm limited the Trash Pandas to one run on one hit over five innings and struck out seven, a season-high... Despite making his seventh start, today is Seminaris' fourth start against a team that is not Rocket City.
