## ORTIZ'S HOMER FUELS THRILLING 3-2 WIN OVER WIND SURGE:

The Frisco RoughRiders prevailed 3-2 over the Wichita Wind Surge on Friday night from Riders Field in front of a season-high 8,042 fans. Frisco's lone extra-base hit proved to be the difference. In the bottom of the third, **Abimelec Ortiz** smashed a two-run homer, his third of the season, to put the Riders (15-10) up 2-0. Wichita (15-10) then answered in the top of the fourth when Noah Cardenas roped an RBI single. In the bottom of the fifth, **Alejandro Osuna** rolled an RBI groundout to lift the Riders in front 3-1. In the next half inning, Wichita loaded the bases with one out. Jake Rucker hit an RBI single, but Frisco reliever Travis MacGregor induced a line drive double play turned by **Frainyer Chavez** and **Cam Cauley**, preserving a 3-2 Riders lead. Riders reliever **Bryan Magdaleno** entered in the top of the eighth and allowed two baserunners with one out. He then retired two batters and pitched a scoreless ninth to earn his first save of the season. Frisco starter **Ben Anderson** (1-3) earned the victory, allowing two runs across a season-high 5.1 innings. Wichita starter Connor Prielipp went 2.2 innings, allowing the Ortiz homer.

## THE ROAD IS WHERE MY HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season, going 8-4 away from Riders Field. **Alejandro Osuna** (17), **Josh Hatcher** (16) and **Keyber Rodriguez** (15) are first, second and third, respectively, in road hits in the Texas League. Hatcher has hit all of his four home runs on the road. The Riders have averaging 5.7 runs per game on the road vs. 4.2 runs per game at home.

### BROKEN BATS

Frisco has faltered on offense recently. In their last 16 games, Frisco is just hitting .222/.306/.325/.631 while scoring 3.9 runs per game (7th in the league). This series against Wichita, Frisco has scored just nine runs over four games, batting .213/.254/.283/.537. Of their 27 hits, just four of them have been for extra bases with **Alejandro Osuna** collecting two of them (triple and home run) and **Abimelec Ortiz** cracked a two-run shot on Friday.

## **STRIKING UP STRIKEOUTS:**

Frisco's pitching staff has whiffed 112 batters through their last 10 games (11.2 per game). That is the best in the Texas League and second in Minor League Baseball among teams' last 10 games. Over the last 10 games, the Riders 3.38 ERA is fourth in the Texas League. Frisco's bullpen has thrown 12.1 consecutive scoreless innings over the last three games.

## SCORE, SCORE, SCORE SOME MORE:

Outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 21 runs scored are tied for the second most in franchise history through 25 games played (**Ryan Cordell**, 2016, 22). Osuna's 21 runs scored are also the most in the Texas League this season. The outfielder is currently on an 15-game hitting streak, batting .386 (22-for-57)./448/.544/.992 with 11 runs scored in the 15 games with five walks to five strikeouts. His hitting streak is the longest active streak in Double-A and the fourth-longest among Minor League Baseball.

## **KEYBERRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:**

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 19 games this season, he is hitting .313 (21-for-67)/.377/.388/.765. In his last 11 games, he is slashing .350 (14-for-40)/.395/.450/.845 with one double, a home run, six RBIs, two runs scored, three walks and four stolen bases. Over the season, he has four multi-hit games.

## I GOT THE POWER

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been great on offense during their first 25 games. Frisco's 23 home runs through 25 games are fourth in the Texas League.

## HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 15 of 20 games he's played in, batting .299 (26-for-87)/.308/.494/.802 with five doubles, four home runs, 19 RBIs, a stolen base and 12 runs scored. Hatcher already has eight multi-hit games and is 7-for-14 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. His .289 career batting average with the RoughRiders is second in franchise history (min. 700 PA), trailing only Craig Gentry (.292)

## VERSUS THE WIND SURGE:

The Riders have gone 18-21 against Wichita in the Wind Surge's five seasons in the Texas League. Last season, Frisco went 7-5 against the Twins affiliate, owning a 3.33 ERA as a team. In 12 games, Frisco allowed just five home runs. The Riders took down the Wind Surge in the 2022 Texas League Championship Series, sweeping them in two games.

- -After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.
- -Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.
- -Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

## **2025 SEASON**

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-Tied a career high with nine strikeouts against Corpus Christi on April 26th in quality start.

## **2024 SEASON**

- -Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.
