#### LAST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (May 15, 2021)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders could not pull off their third straight come-from-behind win against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs, falling 5-4 on Saturday afternoon at PNC Field.

In his Triple-A debut, Estevan Florial finished 1-for-4 with a triple, a walk and a run scored. The RailRiders bullpen combined for 5.0 scoreless innings, and has only allowed one run in its last 16.2 innings.

The IronPigs picked up two runs in the top of the first against Mike Montgomery on a two-run single from C.J. Chatham. They tacked on an additional run against the lefty in the third and two more in the fourth to open up a 5-0 lead.

In his third start of the season, Montgomery allowed five runs on eight hits, walking one and striking out two in 4.0 innings. Nick Nelson tossed 2.2 scoreless innings, striking out five, and Braden Bristo and Nick Goody combined to silence the Lehigh Valley bats afterward. Nelson, Bristo and Goody did not allow a hit and walked a combined two while registering eight strikeouts.

The RailRiders clawed back with a run in the bottom of the fourth against Adonis Medina on an RBI single from Ryan LaMarre. The outfielder finished the game 2-for-4 with a run scored and an RBI, his third straight game driving in a run. In the fifth, Chris Gittens connected on an opposite-field two-run home run to cut the deficit to 5-3. The blast was Gittens' third of the season, tying him with Luke Voit for most on the club in the young season. In the bottom of the sixth, SWB rallied for a run on an Armando Alvarez RBI single to get within one run of Lehigh Valley, but that was as close as the RailRiders would get. Iron Pigs pitchers retired 11 of the final 12 batters they faced after Alvarez's hit.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**LET'S GET IT STARTED (IN HERE):** After posting a 6.75 ERA (15 ER/20.0 IP) in the season-opening series at Syracuse, RailRiders starting pitchers have been much better at PNC Field through two games. Before **Mike Montgomery** allowed 5 ER in 4.0 IP on Saturday, SWB starting pitchers had combined for a 1.84 ERA (3 ER/14.2 IP) in the first four games of this series against Lehigh Valley. With a small sample size of 10 games played before Saturday, the previous four games had dropped RailRiders' starters ERA down to 4.63, while the overall staff ERA has fell from 6.24 entering Tuesday's home opener, to 4.31 entering Sunday. In 2019, SWB posted a 4.98 ERA at home in 71 games, and 4.94 overall.

**BULLS ON PARADE:** The RailRiders bullpen has emerged as one of the strengths of the team through the first 11 games of the season. After 5.0 hitless, scoreless innings against Lehigh Valley on Saturday, the pen has allowed only one run in its last 16.2 innings across three games, and three runs in 26.0 dating back to Sunday, May 9. As a 12-man unit, the bullpen has combined for 40 strikeouts and 12 walks in that time. Overall, the bullpen sports a 3.58 ERA (22 ER/55.1 IP) and is 5-for-6 in save opportunities.

**DINGER ALERT:** After shattering the SWB franchise record with 212 home runs in 2019 (previously 164 in 1998), the RailRiders are at it again, hitting 15 home runs in the team's first six games. However, the RailRiders did not hit a home run in their first two games at PNC Field this season, but **Robinson Chirinos'** 4th-inning blast off David Parkinson on Thursday night changed that. Nonetheless, the 18 round-trippers hit by SWB puts the club in a tie for second place in the Triple-A East League with Nashville and Gwinnett, trailing Durham (25). The RailRiders are tied for fourth in minor league baseball in home runs and are one of seven teams who have hit at least 18 long balls. Incredibly, the Lehigh Valley IronPigs only hit two home runs thus far, the fewest of any Triple-A team. Only one MiLB team (South Bend, A+, CHC, 0 HR) has hit fewer than the IronPigs.

**WALK-A-THON:** Through 11 games this season, the RailRiders have drawn an astonishing 66 walks, tied for the most in all of Triple-A baseball with Gwinnett. No other team in the minors' highest level has taken more than 56 bases on balls. Overall, the RailRiders are tied or fourth in all of minor league baseball in walks, with St. Lucie (Low-A, NYM) leading the way with 74 walks. SWB's team .380 OBP is second best in the Triple-A East League, trailing Gwinnett (.383), and ranks seventh across all levels of the minors.

**THREE DOZEN SIDES OF BACON:** The COVID-19 pandemic has created one of the most unusual season schedules in the history of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre franchise. With the season beginning a full month later than traditional, all teams in the Triple-A East League will play 120-game schedules. The RailRiders, along with the rest of the Northeast Division teams, will exclusively play teams within the division. This leads to a schedule where SWB plays the rival Lehigh Valley IronPigs an unprecedented 36 times. The RailRiders currently lead the 2021 IronRail Series 3-2.

**MARATHON MEN:** The RailRiders played their longest 9-inning game in franchise history on Thursday at Syracuse, clocking in at 4:09. That surpassed the previous record of 4:04, when the then-Red Barons locked horns with the Pawtucket Red Sox on Sept. 1, 2000. Thursday's game also featured 13 walks by SWB pitchers, three shy of the club record set against Tidewater in 1991. Early in the season, it stands as the longest game in Triple-A East League history, but wasn't even the longest 9-inning game in minor league baseball on May 6. That distinction belongs to the Lake County Captains (High-A, CLE) and Lansing Lugnuts (High-A, OAK) who completed a 7-6 Captains win in 4:18. Not to be out-done, the RailRiders and Mets game on Sunday, May 9 lasted 4:03, making it the third-longest game in franchise history.

**AIN'T NO PARTY LIKE A MOOSIC PARTY:** Tuesday's RailRiders home opener was Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's first game at PNC Field since Game 3 of the First Round of the IL Playoffs vs. Durham on Sept. 7, 2019. The span of 612 days between games at home in NEPA is the longest in franchise history, surpassing the 577-day streak from Sept. 5, 2011 - April 4, 2013 when SWB played the entire 2012 season away from Moosic owing to renovations at PNC Field. In 2019, the RailRiders were 45-26 (.634) at home, and are 214-143 (.599) at PNC Field since the beginning of the 2015 season, and sport an average season record of approximately 42-28.

**2021 PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Baseball America - NYY #2, MLB #49, MLB Pipeline - NYY #3, MLB #90, FanGraphs - NYY #2, MLB #60

**LAST TIME OUT:** García dazzled the PNC Field crowd in the 2021 Home Opener for the RailRiders, getting the win in a 6-0 SWB victory. After allowing a leadoff double in the first, he allowed only two more hits on the day, striking out a season-high seven and walking one in 5.0+ innings of work. García remains the only RailRiders starter to complete 5.0 innings this season, and has the only win of the year for the rotation.

**RECORD SETTING ROOKIE:** Deivi García made his big-league debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on 8/30/2020 against the New York Mets (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 6 K). He became just the 10th Yankee since 1935 and the first since 1992 to throw at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his MLB debut. García went on to become just the second pitcher in Yankees history with at least 6 K and no more than 2 BB in each of his first four big league appearances (Masahiro Tanaka, 2014). He did this while being the youngest pitcher (21 year, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes (21 years, 95 days in 2007), and the second-youngest player to start a game in the majors in 2020 (Luis Patiño, SD; 20 years, 329 days). The right-hander capped off the season by starting Game 2 of the ALDS against Tampa Bay, and became the youngest pitcher (21 years, 140 days) ever to start a postseason game for the Yankees (previous: Whitey Ford, 1950 World Series Game 4; 21 years, 351 days).

- Began the season at the Yankees Alternate Training Site, recalled by Yankees for a spot start on 4/26.
- Optioned to the Yankees Alternate Training Site on 4/27 and assigned to RailRiders Opening Day roster on 4/30.

### PERSONAL:

- Full name is Deivi Anderson García.
- Watches the same 5-minute clip of his idol Pedro Martinez from the 1999 All-Star Game before each of his starts.
- Credits his Father for a lot of his success, he was the first one to teach him a curveball and made countless sacrifices for him to attend tryouts. His mother was a doctor who gave up her career to focus on raising her children.
- Grew up wanting to play shortstop, began pitching when he went to tryouts as a 15-year-old and scouts had him work out on the mound.
- Younger brother, Andres Garcia, is a prospect in the Toronto Blue Jays organization. He most recently played for the DSL Blue Jays in 2019.
- Pitched in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland, and was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the first time after the game.
