YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their second straight game to the Harrisburg Senators, 6-3. In the top of the second, **Kyle Mottice** hit an RBI double to open the scoring. Harrisburg took the lead in the second on a two-run homer by K.J. Harrison and added a run to open a 3-1 lead in the third with an RBI single by Ian Sagdal. In the fifth, Osvaldo Duarte scored on a wild pitch. The Senators pulled ahead, 6-1, in the eighth with a bases-loaded walk by Aldrem Corredor and a run-scoring groundout by Cole Freeman. In the ninth, **Vince Fernandez** cut the deficit to three with a two-run homer, his second of the season and second in this series. **Tristan Beck** was charged with his second loss of the season after allowing four runs in 4.1 innings with a season-high five strikeouts. **Matt Seelinger** pitched 1.2 innings and struck out four of the five batters he faced. **Raffi Vizcaino** worked around a pair of walks in the seventh to toss a scoreless inning. **Luis Amaya** surrendered two unearned runs in the bottom of the eighth. Harrisburg starter Tim Cate picked up his first Double-A win after striking out six batters over 5.0 innings and allowing one run. The Flying Squirrels outit the Senators, 12-8, but went 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position and left 11 runners on base.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels wrap up the first road series of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island in the finale of six games. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' lone trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June 8-13.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 8-3 record through the first ten games of the season matches their start in 2018 for the best record through 11 games. The team's best start through 12 games was a 9-3 record, also in 2018.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in second place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, a half-game behind Bowie. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE SENATORS have won two straight games after losing the previous six. The Senators are batting .146 as a team, which is the worst team average of the 120 teams in the minors. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of *Baseball America's* top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jackson Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling to the Bowie Baysox in the divisional round of the playoffs.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Sam Long** makes his third start of the season and his second against the Senators. He faced Harrisburg on Tuesday and allowed one run over 4.0 innings on three hits. In his Double-A debut on May 5, he worked three innings and allowed three runs against Hartford at The Diamond. He has picked up five strikeouts in both of his starts this season. Long signed with San Francisco as a free agent on November 17, 2020. Long was originally drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 18th round in 2016 out of Sacramento State, where he was the Preseason WAC Pitcher of the Year. He climbed high as the Single-A level with Tampa before being released at the beginning of spring training in 2018. In 2019, Long signed as a free agent with the Chicago White Sox and spent the season with the Single-A Kannapolis Intimidators, where he split time between the starting rotation and the bullpen. Long signed with the Giants on November 17, 2020. **For more on Long, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Mario Sanchez makes his third start of the season and his second against Richmond. On Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels, Sanchez allowed four runs over 5.0 innings in his second straight loss. In his first outing on May 5 at Somerset, Sanchez was hit with a loss after pitching into the fifth inning and allowing three runs (two earned) with no walks and four strikeouts. Sanchez is in his third season at the Double-A level. In 2019, he made 23 appearances (19 starts), going 10-5 with a 2.85 ERA en route to being named an MiLB.com Nationals Organizational All-Star. He also pitched for the Reading Fightin Phils in 2016, going 5-0 with a 3.46 ERA in 19 outings (seven starts). Sanchez was originally signed by the Nationals in 2012 before being traded to the Phillies in December 2016. He signed with the Nationals again prior to the 2019 season.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last eight games since May 8, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff has combined for a 2.45 (18 ER/66.0 IP), which is the best in the Double-A Northeast during that span and second-best in all of Double-A. The Richmond pitchers also have the best BAA (.181) in the Double-A Northeast in that stretch and the best WHIP (1.08).

MO TIME: **Kyle Mottice** is batting .344 in his 10 games played this year, which is ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast. He has picked up at least one hit in eight of his ten games played this year. He has also added three two-hit games, including a 2-for-3 outing on Saturday night at Harrisburg.

POWER SURGE: **David Villar** has homered three times in the first 11 games of the 2021 season, which is tied for fourth in the league. He hit 13 home runs in 2018 in short-season with Salem-Keizer and clubbed 13 home runs again in 2019 with A-Adv. San Jose. Villar is also ranked tied for fifth in the league with nine RBIs and tied for fifth with 23 total bases.

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** leads the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for first in games pitched (5). On Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise.

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
