ANOTHER WALKOFF The Portland Sea Dogs won their second straight walk off game 6-5 over the Chesapeake Baysox on Sunday afternoon. Chesapeake opened the scoring in the top of the fourth on a leadoff solo home run by Frederick Bencosme. Portland retaliated in the bottom of the fourth with a Blaze Jordan two-run single that gave the Sea Dogs a 2-1 lead. Drew Ehrhard hit a two-run double which increased the lead to 4-1. With one out, trailing by a run entering the top of the eighth, Jeremiah Jackson doubled and then scored the tying run on an RBI double from Max Wagner. Chesapeake took the lead in the top of the tenth inning with an RBI double by Silas Ardoin, 5-4. In the bottom of the tenth inning, Max Ferguson hit a leadoff single, moving Ahbram Liendo, runner placed at second base, to third. Jhostynxon Garcia then laced a two-run single down the left field line winning the game for Portland, 6-5.

GARCIA COMES THROUGH AGAIN After demolishing the walk off home run on Saturday night for Portland, Jhostynxon Garcia laced a two-run walk off hit on Sunday afternoon securing another win for the Sea Dogs in the bottom of the tenth inning.

SMOOTH OPERATOR Infielder Blaze Jordan has been solid at whatever infield position he has been at this year. Jordan has split time between first base and third base and has not committed an error in 26 games. In that time, he has 18 assists and zero errors in 147 total chances. Jordan also has turned 14 double plays and 129 putouts.

ON BRAND RHP Jonathan Brand has had a great start to the season for Portland. In seven appearances out of the bullpen, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA. He has tossed 10.0 innings allowing five hits while walking six and striking out 16. Brand has also recorded two saves.

WHERE DO WE STAND With the two wins over the weekend, the Sea Dogs are back in first place of the Northeast Division of the Eastern League. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies and Hartford Yard Goats are tied for second place, 0.5 game behind the Sea Dogs. The New Hampshire Fisher Cats are in fourth place, 5.0 behind Portland while the Somerset Patriots are in fifth place, 5.5 games out of first place. The Reading Fightin Phils are in last place, 9.0 games behind the Sea Dogs.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY May 13, 2003 – Jeremy Owens had a doubleheader to remember, going 5-for-7 with two home runs, two doubles, three runs scored and a franchise-record eight RBI as the Sea Dogs swept Trenton in a twinbill, 12-3 and 8-2. In consecutive doubleheaders against the Thunder, Owens would finish 7-for-11 with three home runs and 11 RBI.

ON THE MOUND RHP Jack Anderson will take the mound for the Sea Dogs tonight in Somerset. He has made one start for Portland this year on May 7th in game two of a doubleheader against Chesapeake. Anderson tossed 4.0 innings allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits while striking out five. He did not issue a walk.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Manager - Chad Epperson

Manager Chad Epperson will lead the team in his fourth season in Portland. In 2024, he led the Sea Dogs to a 78-60 record, the best record in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, and third best in the league. In his fourth season with the team, he is tied for the longest serving manager in Sea Dogs history with Arnie Beyeler who managed Portland for four seasons from 2007 to 2010. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator.

Pitching Coach - Sean Isaac

Sean Isaac will serve as Portland's pitching coach for a third season. Under his leadership, the Sea Dogs' pitching staff led Double-A in strikeouts (1,329) and were second in saves (40) in 2024. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously, Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera will join Sean Isaac as a second pitching coach with Portland. Rivera spent the last three seasons as Salem Red Sox' pitching coach and led the pitching staff to a 3.61 ERA, fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, he has been in the Red Sox organization since 2022 as a Development Coach with Salem.

Hitting Coach - Chris Hess

Chris Hess returns to Portland for his second year as the Sea Dogs' hitting coach after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. Last season, Portland's hitters led Double-A in runs (711), doubles (285), RBI (658), slugging (.412) and OPS (.753). They ranked second in average (.257), hits (1,221), and OBP (.348). He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. This year will mark Hess' fifth year in the Red Sox organization.

Assistant Hitting Coach - Johnny Reina

Johnny Reina will serve as Assistant Hitting Coach after working as a Hitting Trainer at Driveline Baseball in Seattle, Washington. Driveline Baseball's mission is to develop the future of baseball training by finding industry-leading insights, all while publishing those insights back to the baseball community.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala will be on staff for his second season in Portland after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record.

Athletic Trainer - Bobby Stachura

Stachura returns to Portland for his third season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch joins the staff for his first season in Portland, but his second year in the Red Sox organization. He was previously an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach. In that role, he assisted in the strength and conditioning for players returning to the field.
