Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (2-4) vs. Durham Bulls (3-3)

SEVEN-RUN DURHAM SIXTH SINKS SHRIMP

Three Jumbo Shrimp homered on Thursday, but the Bulls scored seven runs in the sixth to run by Jacksonville 11-7. Durham scored two in their first at-bats before Jacksonville got on the board in the bottom of the first with an **Austin Allen** RBI ground out. After a huge offensive explosion, down 11-1, **Peyton Burdick** and **Brian Miller** went back-to-back for home runs in a five-run bottom of the sixth. A **C.J. Hinojsa** long ball in the eighth put the margin at 11-7, but the Shrimp could get no closer in their third straight defeat.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

For the sixth game in a row to start the season, Jacksonville got their leadoff man on to begin their first at-bats when Xavier Edwards singled on the first pitch of the bottom of the first inning from Durham starter Taj Bradley. Of those six leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch, with the lone exception being a single on an 0-1 pitch to Garrett Hampson on March 31 at Gwinnett. Five of those six leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; Brian Miller reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers.

JUST WIN, BABY

The Jumbo Shrimp have earned back-to-back winning marks for the first time since 2013-14. After going 75-55 (.577) in 2021, they finished 80-69 (.537) in 2022. Jacksonville's 155 wins over the last two seasons are the club's most in consecutive campaigns since the 163 victories piled up by the 2009-10 squads. In particular the last two years, Jacksonville has excelled on the road, with winning records in each campaign. Prior to 2021, the club's last winning record away from home was in 2014, finishing with a 42-28 road record.

RAGING BULLS

Durham, who won the 2022 Triple-A Championship, was the team that Jacksonville struggled the most with during the 2022 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp were just 9-15 (.375) against the Bulls despite getting outscored by just one run, 117-116, during the season series. Of those 24 contests, 13 were decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville finished just 4-9 in those closley-decided affairs against their adversaries from the Bull City.

THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

No team in the IL has scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first five games. Despite their leagueleading 43 runs, the Jumbo Shrimp rank 15th in average (.210), 17th in on-base percentage (.263), 11th in slugging percentage (.390) and 16th in OPS (.653). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line jumps up to .267/.318/.493/.811, figures that rank third, 12th, third and fifth, respectively.

ON THE OTHER SIDE THOUGH ...

While the Jumbo Shrimp are tied for the league lead in runs, they also have ceded the most runs in the IL by a huge margin. Jacksonville has yielded 57 runs, an average of 9.5 per game. The 19th-place clubs in the 20-team league entering play on Friday, Syracuse, has surrendered 37 tallies (6.2 per game) and are closer to 14th place than to Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have issued the most walks (33) in the circuit, while 18th in batting average against (.291) and 20th in hits allowed (66). The club has surrendered at least five runs in every game so far.

HOMEFIELD (DIS)ADVANTAGE

Despite having a 38-37 record at home in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled at 121 Financial Ballpark. The team ranked T-6th lowest OPS at home last year and are 0-3 in their first three home games in 2023, owning the fourthlowest OPS in the IL at home (.653). In 2022, Jacksonville posted a .728 OPS at home, far below their road mark of .790.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Despite owning a home record of 38-37 (.507) in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp were world beaters on the road, posting a 42-32 (.568) record away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Of those 42 road wins, Jacksonville had 19 wins on the road against IL West opponents like Gwinnett. In 2022 contests away from 121 Financial Ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .263/.337/.453. Jacksonville's .263 batting average on the road ranked third in the IL and their .790 OPS placed second in the circuit. In comparison, the club hit .250/.330/.398 at home. Of the 744 runs the Jumbo Shrimp scored in 2022, 409 came on the road (55.0 percent).

ABOUT BRYAN								

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

2023 SEASON

-Made first appearance of the season, coming out of the bullpen against Gwinnett. He tossed three innings, allowing just one run on five hits with four punch outs.

2022 SEASON

-Made MLB debut on 8/20/22 against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.38) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

2021 SEASON

-There, Hoening made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

2019 SEASON

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoening was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Indiana and Georgia Tech.

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
