

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 2-1 in the series finale at Hadlock Field on Sunday. Agustin Ruiz drove in the Ponies' only run with a sacrifice fly, while Jose Peroza and Brandon McIlwain had multi-hit games.

DOMinant: RHP Dom Hamel is coming off of one of his best outings at the Double-A level. Hamel struck out a career-high 11 batters over a season-high-tying six innings at Portland on Wednesday. He allowed just one run on three hits and one walk, while earning his fourth win of the season. Hamel has tossed a seasonhigh six innings in three-straight starts and in four of his last five starts. In those four respective starts, Hamel has struck out 36 batters over 24 innings. He currently ranks fourth in the Eastern League with 91 strikeouts.

Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan had a successful series at Hadlock Field against Portland before the All-Star break. Jordan hit .381 (8-for-21) with a 1.081 OPS in the six games. He had two doubles, a homer, four runs batted in, four runs scored, and four stolen bases. Jordan had a three-hit game and reached base five times in the series opener at Portland, while being a triple shy of the cycle.

Multi-Hit McIlwain: Outfielder Brandon McIlwain had his team-leading 20th multi-hit game of the season on Sunday afternoon in Portland. It was his thirdstraight multi-hit performance and fourth of the series at Hadlock. He is riding that streak of three-straight multi-hit performances. In his past three games, McIlwain is 6-for-12 (.500) with two doubles and an RBI. He hit .391 (9-for-23) in the series.

Welcome to Binghamton, Tyler Stuart and Dylan Tebrake: Right-handed starting pitcher Tyler Stuart and right-handed reliever Dylan Tebrake were promoted from High-A Brooklyn to Double-A Binghamton on July 14. In 14 starts for the Cyclones, Stuart pitched to a Minor League-leading 1.55 ERA. The 6-foot-9 right-hander was drafted by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Souther Miss and is in the middle of his first full season in the minors. Tebrake pitched to a 2.08 ERA in 14 appearances (13 relief appearances) for the Cyclones. The 24-year-old was drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Creighton and is also in the midst of his first full professional season.



Last Start: Hamel is coming off one of his strongest starts of the 2023 campaign. He struck out a career-high 11 batters over a season-high-tying six innings of work on Wednesday in Portland, while allowing just one run on three hits and one walk. Hamel has now gone a season-high six innings in three-straight starts and in four of his last five.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 6 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
