FROM THE CROWS NEST

SCOUTING FIRST-PLACE LAKELAND: The Flying Tigers come to town for four games in three days as the two will make up the Mother's-Day postponement (May 10), marking the second twin-bill for Lakeland of the week after their Thursday twinbill with Tampa. They enter the weekend with a one-game lead over Clearwater for first place in the FSL West. Over 11 meetings, the Marauders are 6-5 against the Flying Tigers, including three of five at the beginning of the month. The two have played each other very tightly with five of the 11 matchups decided by two runs or less. Lakeland enters the weekend in first place in the FSL West and have taken 10 of their last 14 meetings – all against division opponents.

FORT MYERS RECAP: The Marauders secured their first series win since mid-May versus Lakeland, taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels. After dropping game one of the series, Bradenton roared back to take the final two games of the set, highlighted by big fifth and sixth innings on each of the nights respectively. In all three games, Bradenton's starters pitched five innings, and their bullpen in the last two nights combined for eight frames of two-run ball while fanning 11 hitters.

AGER DAY: Right hander Matt Ager is set to make his eigth start of the year tonight. Through 18.2 innings of work, he has posted a 4.82 ERA with 16 strikeouts. His last outing was on Saturday vs Clearwater when he allowed four runs (one earned) over 1.2 innings. He mixes in a four-seamer (89.5 mph), slider (81.5 mph), changeup (83.5 mph) and curveball (73.9 mph). His slider has generated a 40.6 whiff rate and has allowed just 3 hits (.214 BAA). Ager has struggled with command at times, walking 19 hitters over his 18.2 frames, including 10 in 6.2 innings over three starts.

SETTING THE TONE: Marauders starters have had a tremendous stretch of outings vs Clearwater and Fort Myers, combining for a 2.66 ERA over 35.2 innings of work (14 ER). Over that stretch, they've walked just 11 hitters and limited opponents to a .227 average. Between Wednesday 5/21, Bradenton has seen six starters pitching through five innings amongst seven total outings (**Carlos Castillo 2x, Clevari Tejada 2x** and **Victor Cabreja 2x**), a feat they had achieved just once entering the previous week. Over the six starts from the trio, they've combined to allow just 11 earned runs (3.30 ERA) and 21 hits (.202 BAA) over the 30 innings.

KG SAYS HELLO: 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin has led off in 40 of his 41 games started in 2025. In the first inning this year, he is slashing .282/.317/.487 with two home runs and four extra-base hits. Over the last two weeks, he has homered on the first pitch of the game's first frame twice, including last two weeks ago versus No.71 overall prospect Trey Yesavage. Moreover, while jumping on the first pitch in general this year, he is 13-for-26 (.500), with five of those hits coming in the first inning).

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK: The Marauders have been one of the best teams at controlling the running game this season. Their 40 stolen bases allowed entering the week are the fewest in Single-A. In the process, they've limited opponents to a .667 stolen base percentage, the lowest in the FSL and third best in Single-A. Marauders catcher **Derek Berg** has posted a 1.91 average poptime to second base this year, the quickest mark in the FSL (would rank 11th in MLB). As a result, he has thrown out 12 of 28 potential base stealers, the best rate of any qualified catcher in the FSL. In the month of May, he has cut down 6 of 12 potential base stealers, including 3 of 3 at Clearwater on May 4.

ROUND OF A.PLAZ: While Pirates No. 28 prospect Axiel Plaz is second on Bradenton in hitting (.289), and leads in RBI (30) and average exit velocity (92.5 mph), his increase in contact at the plate has turned heads. Through 41 games, his whiff rate is down four percent (28.4%) and his strikeout rate has dropped by 11 percent (18.6%) while maintaining elite batted-ball quality. This year he is battling .320 and slugging .600 on pitches in the zone. His 54.5 percent Hard-Hit rate is first among qualified FSL catchers. He is slashing .279/.352/.623 with six home runs in May. He is 14 hits away from matching his total from last year in 148 less plate appearances
