COMEBACK FALLS SHORT IN 6-5 DEFEAT

The Jumbo Shrimp's eighth-inning rally came up short on Thursday in a 6-5 loss to the Stripers. Jacksonville opened up the scoring on a **Jacob Berry** RBI single and **Johnny Olmstead** sacrifice fly in the fourth. Gwinnett rallied to tie the game in the sixth on an **Aaron Schunk** RBI double and **Brett Wisely** sacrifice fly. The Stripers grabbed the lead in the seventh when **Jim Jarvis** lashed an RBI single and **Rowdy Tellez** added a three-run home run to make it 6-2. In the eighth, **Andrew Pinter**'s two-run single and **Jesús Bastidas**' RBI double pulled the Jumbo Shrimp to within 6-5, but they could get no closer.

SNELLING BEE

After **Robby Snelling** surrendered three runs in his April 3 start against Sugar Land - still the only time in 16 career Triple-A starts he has ceded more than two runs - the southpaw has been on a tear. Snelling has struck out 21 against only five walks and four hits in 11.0 shutout innings over his last two starts, posting a .111 opponents' batting average. The Reno, Nev., native now has six career scoreless outings in Triple-A out of those 16 starts.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the third-fewest runs (89) in Triple-A while posting the level's third-best ERA (3.53). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (278), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville leads Triple-A by turning 75.2 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only 12 clubs have recorded a rate of at least 70 percent this season.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Twelve of Jacksonville's last 13 games, and 19 of their 24 (79.2 percent) on the season, have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 9-10 (.474) thus far in 2026 in these narrowly-decided matchups. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp tied Indianapolis for the most one-run victories (29) in MiLB. Those 29 one-run wins were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014 Suns won 35 such games.

STARTER FLUID

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded two runs or fewer in 15 of the last 17 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 24 runs, 22 earned, on 46 hits (4.9 H/9) in 84.0 innings for a 2.36 ERA, totaling 33 walks (3.5 BB/9) against 97 strikeouts (10.4 K/9). On the season, Jacksonville starters collectively lead Triple-A in batting average against (.172) and WHIP (1.04) while ranking second in innings pitched (110.2) and strikeouts (129), third in ERA (3.09), fewest hits allowed (67) and GO/AO (1.31) and tied for fifth in fewest runs allowed (40). Of the club's 24 games this season, Jumbo Shrimp starters have surrendered more than three runs just three times.

SPILED INK

Jacksonville's bullpen came into Sunday's matchup vs. Charlotte with a 1.41 ERA in their previous 15 games (64.0 IP, 27 H, 3.8 H/9, 11 R, 10 ER, 32 BB, 4.5 BB/9, 94 K, 13.2 K/9). However, since Sunday, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have surrendered 16 runs, 15 earned in just 14.0 innings for a 9.64 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville relief pitchers have combined to yield 16 hits (10.3 H/9) while walking seven (4.5 BB/9) against 17 strikeouts (10.9 K/9).

A TOUGH START TO THE WEEK

Jacksonville's series at Gwinnett began on Tuesday with **Braxton Garrett** tossing a no-hitter, but the Jumbo Shrimp losing 2-0. On Wednesday, Jacksonville held a pair of five-run leads - 5-0 in the second and 9-4 in the sixth - only for Gwinnett to rally and go on to win 11-9. Thus, Wednesday's defeat was the largest lead the Shrimp have surrendered in a loss since August 10, 2024, when they blew a 7-2 advantage in an 8-7 10-inning loss at Toledo. Jacksonville has already surrendered leads of at least four runs in two defeats this season after doing so just once in 2025. They followed Wednesday's game by blowing a late 2-0 lead in a 6-5 defeat on Thursday.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's five-game skid is their longest since also losing five straight from August 12-18 of last season. The club has not lost six in a row since getting swept by Durham in a six-game set from April 29-May 4 of last season... The Jumbo Shrimp are 8-for-23 w/RISP over the last two games.

ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

-MLB Pipeline ranks Snelling as the No. 39 prospect in baseball entering 2026.

-On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON
