### NEW FACES

Today marks the 1st of 24 games between the Shuckers and Biscuits in 2026, and the 1st of 12 at DABOS Park... The teams have met in the Southern League Division Series each of the last 2 seasons and have won each of the last 5 halves in the South Division.

☞ Career standouts against the Biscuits include **1B/3B/OF MIKE BOEVE** (30g, .306, .774 OPS, 5 2B) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (6g, .261, 2B, HR).

### MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

**SS/2B JESÚS MADE** enters today as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 2nd-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*... Made moved up 2 spots on May 5 with the graduations of **2B JJ WETHERHOLT** and **SS/3B KEVIN MCGONIGLE**... Made is set to become the first No. 1 overall prospect from the Brewers since **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023.

☞ Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (125 AB) reaches 130 AB.

### ALL YOU NEED IS ONE (OR TWO)

**1B BLAKE BURKE** enters today with 11 home runs and 24 RBI through 32 games... Burke is the fastest player to 10+ home runs (31g) and 20+ RBI (24g) in franchise history... Burke has 3 home runs over his last 4 games, including 1 in each game of Sunday's doubleheader.

☞ Burke is on pace for 24 home runs and 26 stolen bases in the first half... It would mark the 3rd 20/20 season in Shuckers franchise history, and the first since **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** (2023).

☞ Burke ranks among the Southern League leaders in home runs (1st, 11), extra-base hits (1st, 20), RBI (T-2nd, 24), doubles (3rd, 8), OPS (8th, .917) and stolen bases (T-8th, 12).

### SPEED? I AM SPEED

**1B BLAKE BURKE** enters today with 12 stolen bases, tied for the 8th-most in the Southern League... Burke is 1 of 7 primary first basemen in Minor League Baseball with at least 10 stolen bases this season... The Southern League record (since 2005) for a first baseman is 24, set by **1B JOEY VOTTO** in 2006 with the Chattanooga Lookouts.

☞ Burke is 1 of 3 players in MiLB with at least 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases this season.

### MATTHEW'S GRAND PERFORMANCE

**C MATTHEW WOOD** recorded his 2nd grand slam of the season in game one of Sunday's doubleheader, becoming the 1st player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) with multiple grand slams in the same series.

☞ Wood became the 2nd player in franchise history to record multiple grand slams in the same season, joining **1B BLAKE BURKE**, who achieved the feat in 2025.

### GARCIA'S GONE WILD

**3B/OF EDUARDO GARCIA** recorded his 3rd career multi-home run game on Thursday... The performance marked Garcia's first multi-home run game in Double-A and the first since May 6, 2025, at Peoria, with High-A Wisconsin.

☞ On Thursday, Garcia made his first appearance in centerfield since August 24, 2025, with the Shuckers... Garcia made 54 appearances in center during the 2025 season.

### RUNNING DOWN A DREAM

The Shuckers enter today with 81 stolen bases, the 3rd-most in Double-A and tied for the 8th-most in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers are on pace for 349 stolen bases, which would set a new league record... The MiLB record is 363, set by the Aberdeen IronBirds (BAL, A+), in 2024.

### CALLING ALL KIDS

The Shuckers enter today with the youngest pitching staff in the Southern League, with an average age of 22.9 y/o... The Shuckers staff is the youngest in the Southern League since the 2017 Mississippi Braves (22.3 y/o)... It marks the 8th pitching staff with an average age under 23 y/o in the Southern League since 2000.

### PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

☞ The 4 are: **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7, No. 96 overall), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

### BACK IN THE SADDLE

**MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 41 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,459 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**RHP JARON DEBERRY** (2-2, 7.25) is set to make his 7th start of the season and his 3rd career start against the Biscuits... In 2 starts against the Biscuits last season, DeBerry allowed 1 run over 9.2 innings with 11 strikeouts, including 5.0 shutout innings in Game 2 of the Southern League Division Series.
