Lansing starter Jack Cushing earned the win with 5.1 shutout innings. Cushing, lefty Dalton Sawyer and right-handers Garrett Acton and Charles Hall limited the Captains to one run on six hits. Lake County's only run came on a **Micah Pries** solo homer in the eighth. The Captains went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today two games behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels and Great Lakes Loons for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, Great Lakes and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 2.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are nine games ahead of Cedar Rapids/Great Lakes. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

MOVING UP: Three of the Captains' most impactful position players have been called up to Double-A Akron in the last week. INF Brayan Rocchio (#7 CLE Prospect – MLB.com) and C Bryan Lavastida (#24 CLE Prospect – MLB.com) were promoted last Friday. OF Will Brennan was called up yesterday. Rocchio departed as the team leader in homers with nine. Lavastida exited as the team leader in batting average at .303 and fresh off a 22-game on-base streak from June 24 to July 24, during which he hit .395/.479/.684. Brennan was sixth among qualified High-A Central League hitters in average at .290 and exits at second in the league with 22 doubles.

JULY IN REVIEW: The Captains closed July with the second-best team ERA (4.00) in the High-A Central League during the month, despite allowing the second-most home runs (38). Offensively, the Captains were third in the league in on-base percentage (.347), fifth in slugging percentage (.405) and fourth in runs scored (149).

GETTING ON: Since July 1, the Captains are second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.345) and have worked the second-most walks (128). From May through June, the Captains were last in the league in walks (167) and third from the bottom in OBP (.320). George Valera leads Captains regulars with a .424 OBP and 26 walks since July 1. Victor Nova has a .382 OBP since July 1 after posting a .295 OBP in May-June. Since July 1, Aaron Bracho has posted a 14.1 BB% after a 9.9% mark in May-June.

STARTERS ON A ROLL: In the last eight games, no Captains starter has allowed more than three earned runs. The Captains rotation has produced three quality starts in that span and three separate outings without issuing a walk. Starters have a 3.16 ERA in that span.

TALE OF TWO SERIES: Two weeks ago, the Captains lost four of six games to the Great Lakes Loons at home. They surrendered 20 home runs and had a -29 run differential (20 R, 49 RA). Last week, the Captains won four of six at Dayton. They surrendered just three homers during the series (one of which was an inside-the-park home run) and had a +16 run differential (26 R, 20 RA).

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .280/.382/.547 (.929 OPS) since July 1. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: George Valera leads the Captains in homers (6) and walks (26) since July 1 and has more walks than strikeouts (24) in that span. His 22.0% BB% is up from 11.1% in May-June.

ALL OR NOTHING: In his last 11 games, José Tena does not have a single one-hit game. The Captains' shortstop has either delivered multiple hits or gone hitless since July 21. He is hitting .238/.333/.452 (.786 OPS) in that span.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-11 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.86 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.58 ERA on the

LAST TIME OUT: Coulter earned the win last Tuesday at Dayton. The right-hander allowed just one run – a Francisco Urbaez inside-the-park homer in the first inning – over five innings of work. Coulter surrendered four hits, three of which were singles. He struck out two and walked one. The Captains beat the Dragons at Day Air Ballpark, 4-1.

2019: Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

BEAR DOWN: Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

THREE SPORT STAR: While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
