THREE IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: In their 8-3 victory over the Brooklyn Cyclones on Wednesday night, **Rafael Flores, Spencer Jones**, and **Aldenis Sanchez** each recorded a triple. The team's three triples are a single-game high this season for Hudson Valley and are tied for the most in the South Atlantic League this year. The Greensboro Grasshoppers tallied three triples in Winston Salem back on June 1st. Jones and Sanchez are tied for the team lead with four triples, the fourth-most in the SAL as well.

TWIN KILLINGS: The Hudson Valley Renegades used a season-high four double plays last Thursday night to circumvent traffic on the bases in a 5-4 victory over Rome. After the 'Gades pitching induced another double play ball versus Brooklyn on Wednesday, the 'Gades pitching staff has issued six double play balls on the ground since June 15th, the seventh-most in High-A

starts, striking out 30 batters in 19.2 innings. The 21-year-old starter owns a 2.39 ERA in this span and has held opponents to a .167 average. the Rome Braves 6.2 frames on Saturday night.

The 'Gades have also played 19 one-run games, and are 8-11 (.421)

HOW LOW CAN THEY GO: Over the course of the month of June, the Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff has been unhittable. They currently hold a 1.83 ERA, the lowest in MiLB. The Vancouver Canadians (TOR--A+) are a distant second at 2.49. The 'Gades have also struck out 231 batters in 177.0 innings, the second-highest mark as well. The Somerset Patriots (NYY--AA) sit right behind Hudson Valley with 223 K's in 185.0 innings. The Tampa Tarpons (NYY--A) are t-17th with 203 punchouts.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: With two hits on Tuesday, Eduardo **Torrealba** has tallied 120 career hits with the Renegades, good for third all-time. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125.

# ..... RENEGADES STARTING PITCHER......

# JUAN CARELA · RHP · 6'3" · 205 LBS · 21

LAST TIME OUT: Carela put together yet another dominating start together last Friday night against the Rome Braves, striking out 10 batters acros 7.0 innings of one-run ball. He scattered just three hits and two walks in the outing as he became the first-ever HV pitcher to strike out 10 batters in three consecutive starts. The right-hander has struck out 30 batters across 19.2 innings in his last three starts, and has een one of the best pitcher sin the South Atlantic League in the month of June with a 2.29 ERA and 40.0% strikeout rate.

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON CARELA: "Carela was always one of those guys we thought could develop into one of the biggest arms in our system. A really athletic kid, if you look at it in 2019 where he started in the Complex League, he struggled to throw strikes to now throwing strikes. Year over year he's continued to mature and develop. He's added a cutter from last year, and he's really taken ownership of that pitch. He's starting to get it more in the zone, and he's always had the slider that he developed last year which kind of set his career on fire and we are starting to see more of the velocity that we always thought was there. It's really exciting to see him start to put all of those pieces together and get a better idea of who this kid really is."

- Tied his career-high with nine strikeouts on April 15 against Aberdeen in 4.1 IP. Left with HV leading 1-0.

- Allowed 12 hits on 4/29 at Greenville, the most by a HV pitcher in a single-game since 2005. His nine runs allowed
- were the most by a Renegades pitcher since Frank De Los Santos allowed 10 runs on July 31, 2008 at Tri-City. Tied franchise record (since 2005) by hitting three batters on 5/19 vs Brooklyn, a record shared with eight others, most recently T.J. Sikkema on 7/3/2022.
- Threw 6.1 innings (0 ER) on 5/26 at Wilmington, tying his career high for innings pitched (6/16/22 @ St. Lucie).
- Became the first Renegates SP to complete 7.0 innings in a start in 2023 on 6/3/2023 vs Aberdeen. The last Renegades pitcher to complete 7.0-or-more innings was Richard Fitts on Aug. 27, 2022 vs Hickory (8.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 7 K).... It was the first time since 8/14/2021 that a Hudson Valley starter threw 7.0 innings and the team did not win (Randy Vásquez vs. Jersey Shore), and just the second occurrence since the start of the 2013 season.
- Became the second Renegades starter to strike out 10 batters in back-to-back starts when he did so on June 2 & 9, joining Chase Hampton, who did so on May 27 and June 3.
- Became the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10 batters in three straight starts in franchise history. Joined LHP Andrew Abbott (Louisville) as the only MiLB player to do so in 2023 (April 6, 13, & 19).
