- Dunedin clinched a series victory behind a 4-RBI night from Cristian Feliz, downing Clearwater 6-5 on Friday night at TD Ballpark.
- Feliz went 3-4 with a first inning 3-run homer that traveled 454 feet to right center field - tying the longest home run in the league this season.
- Clearwater responded with two unearned runs with two outs against Jays starter Grant Rogers in the second. Rogers recovered to retire nine of the final 10 batters he faced, striking out five batters in five innings to earn the victory.
- Nic Deschamps homered in the second inning - his third long ball of the season.
- Dahian Santos delivered two scoreless innings with five strikeouts.
- JJ Sanchez recovered from two eighth inning runs to finish the two inning save with a scoreless ninth, stranding the tying run on third base in both innings.
- Dunedin won despite stranding 11 men on base and going 3-13 with runners in scoring position.

## SERIES SUCCESS

With last night's series clinching win, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in seven of their last eight sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series).

## FELIZ'S FANTASTIC WEEK

With last night's three-run home run, Blue Jays first baseman Cristian Feliz has hit a home run in three of his last four games. His 454 foot shot last night ties Axiel Plaz for the longest home run in the FSL this season (May 18 at Tampa). Feliz's home run on Tuesday jumped off the bat at 116 MPH - the hardest hit ball in the league this season. Feliz is hitting .500 this week (8-16) with 8 RBIs. His 1.663 OPS is the highest in the circuit this week.

## FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

## BLUE JAYS BATS ARE BOPPIN'

The Blue Jays have tallied at least nine hits in all five games this week against Clearwater, hitting .309 (55-178) on the week - the highest mark in the FSL.

## LEAVING 'EM STRANDED

Dunedin pitching has limited Clearwater hitters to 10-53 (.188) with runners in scoring position this week, including a 1-11 mark last night.

## ANOTHER CLOSE ONE

After four of the team's last five games were decided by five or more, Dunedin played its 28th one-run game this season last night - tied for second most in the FSL. The Jays are 13-15 in those contests. 53 of the Blue Jays 79 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 27-26 record in those games.

## HITTERS PARK

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 69 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 74, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 38 home runs allowed at home.

## NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In five games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 10-27 (.370) with six extra base hits. Nimmala was placed on Dunedin's development list on May 14, and then was assigned to the FCL Blue Jays on June 3. Nimmala was the Blue Jays first round draft pick last season, and is the organization's third-ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

## JOEY VOTTO STILL BANGS

After opening his minor league rehab assignment 0-12, Joey Votto has reached base in four straight games, including a three-hit performance on Tuesday at Clearwater. Votto stole a base on Monday, his first stolen base since June 18, 2021.

- Signed by the Blue Jays as an international free agent out of Nicaragua in July 2022.
- Native of Rivas, Nicaragua - located in southwestern Nicaragua. Also the hometown of MLB reliever Erasmo Ramirez (currently with Tampa Bay).
- Is a consensus top-30 Toronto prospect due to impressive command of strike zone... often described as "polished."
- Boasts best control in the Blue Jays' system, according to Baseball America's 2024 Best Tools list.
- Arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, changeup, curveball, and slider.

- Will represent the Blue Jays at the All-Star Futures Game in Arlington, Texas on July 13... first active member of the D-Jays to be selected since 2016.
- Posted 2.86 ERA in 4 starts in June with 0.91 WHIP.
