RIDERS SHOCKED BY SOD POODLES:
After lead 11-2 in the eighth inning, the Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Amarillo Sod Poodles 13-12 in 11 innings from HODGETOWN on Thursday night. The RoughRiders (5-10, 43-40) struck first in the second when Ian Moller bashed a three-run homer. It was his fourth homer of the season and his second in the last three games, putting the Riders in front 3-0. After the Sod Poodles (9-6, 41-43) plated a pair of runs in the third and fourth innings, Frisco lengthened their lead in the fifth. Aaron Zavala lifted an RBI double off the left field wall before Sebastian Walcott hammered a two-run home run to push the lead to 6-2. In the seventh, Marcus Smith scored on a wild pitch, and the Riders scored four more in the eighth on a Keyber Rodriguez RBI single, a Smith two-run single and a Cam Cauley sacrifice fly, ballooning the lead to 11-2. Amarillo then scored five times in the bottom of the eighth on an RBI triple and error, a second throwing error and two balks, drawing to within 11-7. In the bottom of the ninth, the Sod Poodles plated a run on a Caleb Roberts bases-loaded walk before M.J. Melendez ripped a pinch-hit, two-run single to make it a one-run game. Gavin Conticello then pinch hit as well and tied the game at 11-11 with an RBI single to left. In the top of the 10th, Cauley lifted an RBI single into center to give the Riders the lead, but Amarillo tied the game again with a Ryan Waldschmidt sacrifice fly in the bottom of the inning, knotting the score at 12-12. The Riders went scoreless in the top of the 11th and, in the bottom of the inning, Kristian Robinson lined a walk-off RBI single up the middle against Gerardo Carrillo (1-2), scoring Jose Fernandez to win the game 13-12. Philip Abner (2-0) took home the win, allowing one unearned run for Amarillo. took home the win, allowing one unearned run for Amarillo.

ABIMELECTRIC IN AMARILLO:
Abimelec Ortiz homered again in Amarillo on Wednesday. Head-to-head against Amarillo, Ortiz has 11 home runs against the Sod Poodles while batting .271/.340/.556/.896 with 27 RBIs in 33 games. At HODGETOWN, he has been even better, hitting .306 (22-for-82)/.390/.625/1.015 with seven homer runs and 15 RBIs in 17 games. His seven homers are the most by a visiting player at Amarillo in the last two seasons and more than all but seven Amarillo players in HODGETOWN as well.

K-ROD ON FIRE: Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 17 games, he is hitting .403 (25-for-62)/479/.500/.979 with six doubles, five RBIs, eight walks, 10 runs scored and just six strikeouts. In July, he is batting .423 (11-for-26) over seven games, which is first in the Texas League. His overall .287 average is 10th in the league.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:
Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 52 games since May 7th, he is batting .282/.350/.487/.837 with 15 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 16 games, he is slashing .333/.392/.621/1.013 with five doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:
Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is second in the league in ERA (2.55) while leading the league with 91 strikeouts this season. He is also sixth in innings (74.0), first in WHIP (1.08), first in strikeout rate (30.5 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), second in left on base rate (83.1 percent) and first in swinging strike rate (14.0). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.58 is third in all of Minor League Baseball.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 15 of their last 16 games. Over those 16 games, they have stolen 29 total bases, which is third in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is tied for the league lead with eight steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is fourth with six. Overall this season, the Riders are tied for fifth in the league with 97 stolen bases.

<u>DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:</u>
After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 57. They also have just committed just 37 errors in their last 60 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 52 double plays turned since May 1st are also second in the league. Their 55 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Against the best stolen base team in the league in Arkansas, Frisco allowed seven stolen bases over the six games, below the Travelers' season-average of 11 per series.

he RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (eight) for the Riders, a mark that second in the Texas League. Their 26 saves are the second-most in Double-A. Their 4.29 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WCALD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239. but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 128 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).
