On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Hartford Yard Goats on Thursday night. It is the ninth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and the third-of-six in Hartford. Reading holds the season-series edge over the Yard Goats 5-3, after taking five-of-six from Hartford in early May. Reading won the season-series over Hartford 14-10 in 2023, which included a 9-3 record at Dunkin' Park.

Heartbreak in Hartford

The Fightin Phils had a 4-2 lead in the bottom of the ninth inning, but three runs from Hartford gave the Yard Goats a 5-4 victory on Wednesday night. Reading jumped out to a 4-2 lead, thanks to home runs from William Simoneit and Trevor Schwecke. Schwecke stayed hot with two RBI on the night. Casey Martin had the lone multi-hit game for Reading, going two-for-four. It was a bullpen game for Reading that Konnor Ash started. Carlos Francisco and Cristian Hernandez followed and were very strong. Tristan Garnett pitched a perfect eighth, but allowed three hits in the bottom of the ninth. With the score 4-3, Garnett was pulled and Tyler McKay entered. The lone batter McKay faced, Warming Bernabel, hit a double to left field to score two runs and give Hartford the walk off win. It was the second walk off against Reading this season. It was also Reading's first loss this season when leading after eight inning, as they were previously 15-0.

Home Run Merchants

After not hitting a single home run during its series at Richmond from May 14-19, Reading's offense has responded in a big way with 16 home runs since May 21, which leads the Eastern League over that span. With two home runs in Wednesday night's game, the Fightin Phils have not hit home runs in five-straight games, which is their longest such streak this season. The R-Phils rank fourth in the Eastern League with 42 home runs this season.

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been red-hot at the plate in May. After hitting just .176 in April, Rodriguez is slashing .364/.394/.576, with a .970 OPS in May. He's added six doubles, one triple, two homers, 10 RBI, 18 runs scored and is 7/8 in stolen base attempts in May. A key to Rodriguez' May success has been his lack of strikeouts. He has struck out just five times in 71 plate appearances, which is 7%. In three games last week, Rodriguez was 8-12 (.667), with six runs scored, two doubles, one home, one RBI, and just one strikeouts. Rodriguez had multiple hits in three-straight games (5/21-26) and had back-to-back three-hit games (5/25-26). Jose Rodriguez's .364 average in May ranks as second-best in the Eastern League.

Caleb Crushing It

Caleb Ricketts had a strong week against Binghamton and continued his hot streak with two more hits, a run and two RBI on Tuesday. Over his last six games, Ricketts is slashing .391/.481/.609, with a 1.090 OPS. He's also added five runs, two doubles, one homer and nine RBI. Ricketts is establishing himself as Reading's primary catcher, starting 5/6 games last week.Ricketts .299 average would lead all Eastern League catchers, but he does not quality.

Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang continued his hot month of May with three hits, two runs, one double and a RBI in Tuesday night's loss. Lee Sang just snapped a five-game hitting streak, where he hit .458 over that stretch. Lee Sang has two-plus hits in five-of-his-last-eight games, and three hits in two of those contests. After hitting just .197 in April, Lee Sang is hitting .308 in May and has his season average up to .255. Lee Sang's .308 average in May ranks 10th-best in the Eastern League.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 30, 2015: At Reading, top Phillies prospect J.P. Crawford goes 1-for-4 with an RBI in his Baseballtown debut. The Fightin Phils beat Richmond, 4-3, scoring the winning run on Gabriel Lino's sacrifice fly that plates Aaron Altherr in the bottom of the 8th.

Hey Hartford

Hartford enters today with a 24-22 record, which is third in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Yard Goats were at Portland and split an eight-game series, which featured two doubleheaders, after the teams had two games snowed-out in April. After this week, Hartford hits the road and heads to Somerset for a six-game series. Hartofrd's roster features 13 of the Rockies' top-30 prospects: Adael Amador (1), Yanquiel Fernandez (3), Sterlin Thompson (5), Zac Veen (6), Benny Montgomery (10), Ryan Ritter (12), Carson Palmquist (14), Gabriel Hughes (15), Warming Bernabel (16), Mason Albright (21), Angel Chivilli (24), Jaden Hill (26) and Connor Van Scoyoc (28).

Goat on the Bump

Righty Connor Van Scoyoc, Colorado's No. 28 Prospect, makes the start tonight for Hartford. This season, Van Scoyoc is 1-5, with an 8.73 ERA over eight starts (33 IP, 42 H, 23 BB, 22 SO). Van Socoyoc last pitched May 24 at Portland, suffering the loss, allowing five-earned runs over 3.1 innings. Van Scoyoc faced Reading on May 7 and suffered a loss, allowing six runs over four innings piched. Van Scoyoc split last season between the Angels and Rockies organizations, pitching for High-A Tri-City and Spokane, along with Hartford. In total, he went 7-6, with a 3.80 ERA over 23 starts. Van Scoyoc was traded from the Angels to Rockies on June 25, 2023, in exhange for Mike Moustakas. The Angels drafted Van Scoyoc in the 11th round of the 2018 draft out of Jefferson High School (IA).

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start of season Apr. 10 vs Portland and earned win over five-innings pitched. It was his first affiliated win since Aug. 11, 2019, while with Fort Myers. Lone run came on a solo home run. Placed on 7-day IL Apr. 16 and activated prior to start on Apr. 23. In first start off IL, went 4.2 IP and earned no decision. Struck out season-best to date six hitters, and allowed three runs on four hits, with 72 pitches. Matched season-best to date with five-innings pitched Apr. 28 vs SOM. Struck out a season-high eight batters. Both runs allowed were on solo home runs. Best start of season May 5 at Portland (first road start), where he threw six-shutout innings, but did not factor into the decision. Suffered first loss of season May 11 vs Hartford. Allowed season-high seven hits and matched season-high with three runs allowed. Suffered second-straight loss with three runs allowed May 16 at RIC. Struck out six and walked none in loss. Matched season-high with six innings pitched in no-decision vs BNG on May 24. Allowed one run on three hits and five strikeouts. Was second straight start with no walks and sixth-straight with one-or-fewer walks issued.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by Minnesota Twins as International Free Agent on November 21, 2014. Released by Minnesota Twins on February 9, 2022. Signed by Philadelphia Phillies as Minor League Free Agent on January 7, 2024.

2023: Made return to competitive baseball during winter of 2023-24 with Adelaide Giants of the Australian Baseball League. Made nine starts and was lockdown in the Giants rotation. Went 6-0 with a 0.94 ERA. Struck out 63 hitters across 47.2 innings pitched. Posted 11.9 strikeouts per nine innings and a 9.0 strikeout to walk ratio (63 SO, 7 BB). Collected multiple accolades for Adelaide and helped Giants to Australian Baseball League Championship. Strong season led him to sign with Phillies during the winter.

2021-22: Did not pitch.

2020: Spent 2020-21 season with Sydney Blue Sox of Australian Baseball League. Made just three appearances and went 1-0 with 1.08 ERA. Struck out 15 across 8.1 innings pitched, which was good for 16.2 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.
