SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the series finale against the Somerset Patriots, 4-0. It was the first shutout loss of the year for Richmond. Flying Squirrels starter **Michael Plassmeyer** tossed 5.0 scoreless innings before surrendering two runs in the sixth. Matt Pita scored the first run of the game after stealing third base and scoring on an error. Oswald Peraza added an RBI single to give the Patriots a 2-0 lead. In the seventh, Somerset extended the lead to 4-0 with a two-run single by Luke Voit, who was playing with the Patriots on a rehab assignment from the New York Yankees while working back from an oblique strain. Richmond reliever **Jose Marte** worked a scoreless eighth inning with two strikeouts. Somerset starter Glenn Otto picked up his fourth win of the year after working 6.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's only trip to Dunkin Donuts Park this season and the final series between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season against the Yard Goats at The Diamond from May 4-9. In that series, the Yard Goats took a victory in the season opener on May 4, but the Flying Squirrels won the next five games by a combined score of 33-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost seven of the last nine games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 6.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .228 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.70 ERA for the season.

THE YARD GOATS have lost three straight games, all in their series at New Hampshire, after winning their previous four games. They currently sit in fifth place in the Double-A Northeast's Northeast Division, 14.5 games behind first-place Somerset. The Yard Goats batters are ranked tenth in the Double-A Northeast with a .223 batting average. The Hartford pitching staff is ranked last in the circuit with a 5.87 ERA. Hartford's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects, including 3B Elehous Montero (9), OF Jameson Hannah (13), RHP Karl Kauffmann (17), RHP Tommy Doyle (21) and RHP Ryan Feltner (22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his fifth Double-A start and first against the Yard Goats. He last pitched on Wednesday at Somerset, where he allowed a career-high three runs but set a Double-A high with nine strikeouts in a no-decision. In that outing, he matched his career high in innings pitched with 7.0 for the third time this year and the second time with Richmond. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander David Hill makes his third start of the season for the Yard Goats. Tonight marks his first outing at Dunkin Donuts Park. In his Double-A debut on June 10, he allowed five runs over 1.2 innings in a no-decision. He last pitched last Wednesday at New Hampshire, matching a season-high with seven strikeouts and allowing one run over 4.0 innings. Hill was drafted by the Rockies in the fourth round in 2015 out of the University of San Diego. He began this season with High-A Spokane, where he went 2-1 with a 2.66 ERA in six starts.

GETTING THEIR GOAT: The Flying Squirrels have won five consecutive games against the Yard Goats dating back to May 5. In that stretch, Richmond has outscored Hartford, 33-17. That stretch is the longest win streak the Flying Squirrels have ever posted against the Yard Goats, topping a four-game win streak from Aug. 18, 2018-April 6, 2019. It is also the longest win streak for either team in the history of their head-to-head match-ups.

TOASTY: Over his last 11 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .286 (12-for-42) with one homer and nine RBIs. He is now second on the team this season with 19 RBIs. He is now second among qualified Richmond batters with a .259 batting average on the year.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 13 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .368 (14-for-38) with one homer, five doubles and nine RBIs while scoring four runs. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .264.

TORRES ON A TEAR: In his last nine games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .333 (7-for-21) with one double and two RBIs. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher, second base and third base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

MO' TIME: Over his last 10 games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .303 (10-for-33) with a double and four RBIs. On the season, he is batting .371 (13-for-35) against left-handed pitchers compared to .209 (14-for-67) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 46 percent of his balls put in play, which is the second-highest rate in the Double-A Northeast behind Erie's John Valente (46.2 percent).

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .444 (8-for-18) with two homers and five RBIs over his last five games since last Wednesday. He picked up three hits last Wednesday night, tying a season high, and added a solo homer on Thursday. He went deep again on Friday to take the team home run (7) and RBI (21) lead.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 22-20 record is tied for the third-best start in team history through 42 games, even with the 2014 season, the last year the team reached the postseason. The only seasons with a better start through 42 games were a 23-19 start in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010 and a 23-19 record in 2018.

BLANKED: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels were shut out for the first time in 2021, ending a streak of scoring at least one game that spanned 50 straight games from August 25, 2019 to June 19, 2021, including all 41 games this year to that point. It was the losing active scoring streak in the Double-A Northeast.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .242 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

LEAVING THEM LOADED: Over the last 17 games since June 1, the Flying Squirrels have hit .191 (29-for-152) with runners in scoring position. For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .152 (5-for-33) with the bases loaded, which is last in the league. In those 30 at-bats with the bases loaded, the Flying Squirrels have combined to pick up 15 RBIs.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with six RBIs and four runs scored by pitchers at the plate. Richmond is also tied with Hartford, Reading and Harrisburg for first with three walks by pitchers batting. Flying Squirrels pitchers have seven hits this year, which is second in the league behind Reading (8). On the year, Richmond has gone 19-11 (.633) against National League affiliates, but have gone 3-9 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. After not using the designated hitter for last week's series against Somerset, pitchers return to the batter's box for the next two sets against Hartford and Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
