Last Night: **Dragons 5, Lugnuts 4.** **Cameron Masterman** ended a 3-for-31 slump with a solo home run and a ninth-inning RBI triple, sparking a last-ditch rally, but Dayton held on for the Saturday night victory.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Midwest League off day before the South Bend Cubs arrive in Michigan's state capital Tuesday for the start of a six-game series.

Streak Snapped: 1B **Will Simpson** went 0-for-4 last night, ending his 17-game on-base streak. Simpson leads the Midwest League in walks (18) and tops the Lugnuts in hits (21), batting average (.350), RBIs (18, 3rd in the league), OBP (.500, 3rd), slugging (.550) and OPS (1.050, 5th). **Jonny Butler** now has the longest current streak on the team at 13 consecutive games; Butler had the day off yesterday.

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: **Colby Halter's** 17 walks place him 2nd in the league behind teammate Simpson. **Brayan Buevas** is 2nd in runs scored (18) and tied for 6th with **Henry Bolte** in stolen bases (8); Bolte is tied for 5th in runs scored (15); reliever **Garrett Irvin** is tied for 3rd in appearances (7).

Lighting Up the Scoreboard: The Lugnuts are second in the Midwest League in runs scored with 111, trailing only the Great Lakes Loons' 115 runs scored.

Putting the Home in Home Run: Yesterday's **Cam Masterman** roundtripper was only Lansing's second home run at Jackson Field this year, compared to nine home runs on the road.

Dayton Draws First Blood: The Dragons have scored first in all five games of this series, tallying in the first inning in the first four games and in the second inning last night.

Action on the Bases: In their eight meetings, Lansing (18-for-22) and Dayton (9-for-11) have combined to swipe 27 bases.

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman **Will Simpson** crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: The Lugnuts' first debuting Major Leaguer this year is 2021 super utilityman **Max Schuemann**, who made his Major League debut on April 12 as a pinch-runner for the Oakland Athletics, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th, and followed up on April 20 with a solo home run for his first MLB hit (in a 6-3 A's loss at Cleveland).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: Brad Mills struck out 11 Quad Cities River Bandits in just 4 2/3 innings, but Justin Roberson capped a two-run rally in the bottom of the 9th with a game-winning RBI single, pushing the Bandits to a 4-3 victory. It was the second straight game that the Lugnuts had been walked off. The game was played at Veteran Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids due to flooding in Davenport, with the next two games held in Clinton and Iowa City.

2011: During warm-ups before the start of the third inning in Game 2 of a doubleheader, Lugnuts 3B Bryson Namba, while taking grounders, got into a fight with Whitecaps pitcher Bruce Rondon, who standing at the rail of the West Michigan dugout. Both players were ejected. The Lugnuts swept the doubleheader, 4-0 and 4-2.

Setting the Tone: Dominated as the Lugnuts' Opening Night starter, April 5 at Dayton, needing only 51 pitches (40 strikes) to toss five scoreless innings... retired first 12 batters, allowed leadoff single to Cam Collier in the 5th, then mowed through final three batters... finished with six strikeouts... Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson completed the four-hit shutout in a 1-0 victory, the only run supplied by a Cameron Masterman RBI double in the sixth inning.

Third Time's a Charm: Career stats in Lansing: 3 yrs., 3.79, 12 G, 6 GS, 40.1 IP, 18 BB, 45 K - 2023: promoted from Stockton on August 15, to replace the promoted Brady Basso, and impressed in four appearances to conclude the year.
 - 2022: five appearances from April 14-May 10, transferred to Stockton for the rest of the year.

The Bigger Picture: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... in 2023, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation, before he was called up to the Midwest League.

Changing Things Up: Former Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels, who broke out last season, earning a trip to the Arizona Fall League and a spot in Double-A to begin this season, credits James for teaching him his change-up grip last year while with Stockton.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team in 2023... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out... the best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
